Medical Examiner:

Dr. Spitz, the Wayne County Medical Examiner, was contacted and arrived at the scene at approximately 1:15 AM. Before the body was removed from the scene, it was disrobed and the clothing protected for trace evidence by Mr. Schoonover.

The body was removed at approximately 3:00 AM by Tyrone Cook, Felix Humprey and Edward Hawkins of the Medical Examiner's office.

Scene:

When Laboratory personnel arrived at the scene the area had been sealed off by the Livonia Police Department.

The body was located at the west edge of Gill Road, 359' - 8" south of the center of Eight Mile Road. The body was located by the following measurements:

99' - 9"	head to south power pole
114' - 8"	head to north power pole
12' - 2"	head to skateboard
24' - 2"	head to power line
21' - 7"	head to approximate center of Gill Road

The body was fully clothed in a red jacket, green trousers, blue shirt, shorts, white socks, and red, white and blue tennis shoes.

Gill Road runs north from Seven Mile Road and is gravel between Seven Mile and Eight Mile Roads where the body was located. The property on each side of the road where the victim was located is vacant.



Results:

Fibers removed from the victim's clothing (Items #1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6); from the victim's body, (Item #8, 9 and 10) and from the sheet under the victim's body (Item #12) were compared with known fibers from the home of Timothy King with a number of eliminations being made. The remaining fibers were compared with fibers from the following items with negative results: Items #28, 29, 31, 32, 68, 69, 72, 73, 74, 75, 78, 79, 80, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 96, and 97.

Human hairs removed from the victim's body and clothing were compared with hairs from the following items with negative results: (Items #26, #27, and #70).

Some animal hairs from the victim's clothing appear similar to cat hairs from Item #30. The animal hairs from the victim's clothing are different from dog hairs in Items #82 and #95.

Examination of the victim's orange skateboard revealed a minute quantity of greyish colored powder which was insufficient for comparison with mortar in Item #81.

The fragment of wood in Item #11 appeared to have originated from the ditch where the body was found.

Examination of the oral and rectal swabs of the victim failed to reveal the presence of any spermatozoa or other indications of semen. Examination of the fingernail scrapings of the victim (Items #15 and 16) failed to reveal anything of significance. The victim's blood was grouped and found to be group B, Rh(o) +.

Results: (Continued)

Examination of the victim's right foot revealed a circular ring of orange-colored material. Elemental comparison of this orange substance with the elemental content of the liquids in Items #22, 23, 24, 66 and 67 failed to indicate possible common origins.

The tire (Item #25) was compared to photographs of numerous tire impressions at the scene with negative results. The tire was returned to Detective Brancheau, Lincoln Park Police Department on June 15, 1977.
