SHELLEN'S ATTORNEY:
 Attny L. BENNETT YOUNG of Birmingham, Mich. tx 642-5555 called officer requesting info as to investigation. He represents the SHELLEN family & none of family has seen FRANCIS SHELLEN since search warrant was served at his home on 7-28-76. An acquaintance found the search warrant return & initiated investigation thru attorney to determine what info the police have regarding SHELLEN & alleged criminal sexual acts stated on search warrant. MR. YOUNG was given limited info & assured that if/when a warrant is issued, he would be notified. If possible he would produce SHELLEN to answer charges.

REFERRAL TO COMMUNITY SERVICES DIV.
 Officers feel that info pertaining to subjects involved in this complaint should be referred to responsible agencies in Tennessee & California. In checking with HQ, officer was advised to refer the info to Sgt. CHARLES MOYES at the Comm. Serv Div.

 Informant GERALD RICHARDS w/m dob (Arrested & Now in jail for Sex crime involving 10 yr old boy) advised officer that he has learned of an organization catering to PEDOPHILIA inclined sex deviates. He first heard of this operation thru magazines that portray this type of activity. (Better Life & Herme's). RICHARDS believes a man can go to a place called FATHER BUD'S BOYS FARM at MONTEAGLE, TENNESSEE & with proper credentials, pay for a vacation-type visit there & be furnished with a young boy to be sexually abused. One of RICHARDS' friends w/ from Edmons, Wash- ington) went there, however was refused admittance to the farm. did make a monetary donation to the farm for the "support" of a boy named In return received a film roll depicting involved in sex acts with 2 males. then sent this film roll of 35 MM photos to RICHARDS to be developed. RICHARDS developed the roll & sent the prints back to around June/July 1976 shortly after he received them. He made extra copies of the prints for himself & then gave them to undersigned officer on 8-23-76.

Subject is supposed to be a MINISTER with the CHURCH OF THE NEW REVELATION in New Jersey & is affiliated with the OCEAN LIVING INSTITUTE, 23 RIVER RD., NORTH ARLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, 07032. Subj used envelope with that return address crossed out on 7-19-76. Used address at that time of _____

GROSSMAN wrote RICHARDS a letter postmarked Oakland, California on 7-19-76 stating that the CNR (CHURCH OF NEW REVELATION) has recently received permanent IRS CLEARANCE for another FOUNDATION, the EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR YOUTH. He also said this group had received a \$15,000 donation in Property in Oregon. Also advised that he had a "Little Brother" age 12 & mentioned the lucrative foster-parent set up by both California State & Federal authorities. (copy of letter attached.)

The St. Clair Prosecutor was contacted with request for warrant for GROSSMAN for Sex crime last summer. He has not authorized as yet due to work load. If/when warrant is issued, the information will be relayed to same authority the above info will be referred to.

Request that the COMMUNITY SERVICES DIV forward the above info to Youth Services Agencies in Oakland, California area or the California Attny General for proper assignment. Unknown if any of the Agencies that GROSSMAN represents are legitimate. In any event, his "Little Brother" status should be investigated.

FEDERAL AGENCIES:

Officer called IRS agent LEON GOSSAGE at Detroit 226-7266 & gave him info as to IRS Clearances. He advised that their Intelligence Unit & Tax Exemption Division would check the Tax returns for possible fraud. In talking to Federal Employees, officer was advised that perhaps the DEPT. OF COMMERCE (OFFICE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS, NATIONAL OCEANIC & ATMOSPHERIC ADMINISTRATION, DEPT. OF COMMERCE, ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND 20852) should be advised in event of Fraudulent Federal GRANTS TO AGENCIES REPRESENTED BY GROSSMAN.

In addition, a Detroit News article dated 9-9-76 stated that the US GENERAL ACCOUNTING OFFICE was investigating similar fraud/abuse of children in New Jersey & California.

BOLDEN stated that he had been working for a year on the supposed FATHER BUD'S BOYS CAMP. The camp is actually just a house run by a Bud VERMILLE, an ex Episcopal priest.

VERMILLE had written to several foundations to receive funds to operate the "Camp", and applied to the probate court officials to have delinquent boys sent to the "Camp" as a source of rehabilitation. Several boys had been sent to the "Camp" but have been taken out because of various reasons.

BOLDEN stated that he would be very interested in seeing the pictures given, and an interview with GERALD RICHARDS.

BOLDEN will be contacting D/SGT. JOEL GORZEN of station 23 to make arrangements to fly to Michigan.

Mr. stated that Francis "Frank" Sheldon was a member of the board of directors of the facility, and was elected to that post in January of 1976. Since that time Mr. SHELDEN has attended three meetings held by the board. Two were at the University Club in Detroit, the third was at the facility located at 28000 W. Nine Mile Road, Farmington.

During the past year none of the boys from the facility went anywhere with SHELDEN, and SHELDEN did not ever attempt to have anyone from the facility participate in any type of activity with him.

In the event any information is received by MR. on the possible whereabouts of SHELDEN Sgt. Richard Scheonberger, Second District Coordinator, Community Services Section will be advised.

FURTHER:

Information received from the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation about possible contributors to the Father Buds Farm is being turned over to Detectives from the First, Second, and Fifth Districts for follow up. SMITH.

CHURCH OF THE NEW REVELATION: Richard's said he first heard of this Church thru it's advertising in HARD CORE PORNO such as "BETTER LIFE MONTHLY" (Boys Pedophilia magazine) He learned that they set up Boy's Homes, Camps gave Legal Assistance, acted as Incorporator's of Boy's Camps, etc. A person known as _____ is one of the director's. After he wrote this Church, DYER GROSSMAN came to Fort Huron to set up the Brother Paul's Mission Camp for him. The follow-up investigation by the agents at West Palm Beach indicated that _____ who was a former Michigan resident is now living in West Palm Beach, and he is marrying a girl who has the name _____. He denied knowing FRANCIS SHELDEN, the wanted subject; however, after some lengthy interview by the agents, it was determined that he had met him 5 years ago and his wife, _____ apparently was some distant relative of the wanted subject. AGENT FARMER indicated that the agents who made the investigation in Florida were satisfied that the wanted subject was not with _____. However, it would appear that the coincidence of the persons and names involved would bear further scrutiny.

AGENT FARMER advised that he has received information from a source that believes that FRANCIS SHELDEN is currently at the Mill Reef Club in Antigua Island. This information had been passed to the local police department on that Island; however, no response was ever received from the F.B.I. office. This information is to be followed-up by an F.B.I. agent to determine if, in fact, FRANCIS SHELDEN is on Antigua.

On or about May 22, 1978, the Seventh District Commander CAPTAIN JOHN COSGROVE received information from Grand Traverse County Sheriff RICHARD WEILER that an association known as the Manitou Island Association and the William Angel Foundation were holding meetings in Lansing reference activity on North Manitou Island. Sheriff WEILER felt that it should be investigated to determine if the association or the William Angel Foundation was connected with the activities on North Fox Island. Attached is an intelligence report from MSP, Lansing, completed by D/Sgt. SOELTNER in which information was gathered reference the meeting held at the Hospitality Inn in Lansing, Michigan. A copy of that report will be attached to the post copy of this complaint.

INVESTIGATION:

On 5-24-78 undersigned officer interviewed Leelanau County Undersheriff DAVID GILL. He advised that the Manitou Island Association has been in existence a long time and that it was backed by big corporations. To his knowledge it was a non-profit organization, that the money was donated to colleges and the upkeep of North Manitou Island. He knew nothing of the William Angel Foundation, but stated that he had heard of it.

This date undersigned officer interviewed JACK BARRATT, Magistrate, 86th District Court and long-time resident of Leelanau County. He advised that in the 1930s he was stationed on Manitou Island as a member of the Coast Guard, and at that time the Manitou Island Association existed; that it was in fact a non-profit organization of very wealthy individuals dedicated to the upkeep of North Manitou Island, and felt that it had been an association for the last forty years. He advised that William Angel was either chairman of the board or president of the Continental Motors Corporation of Michigan; that Mr. Angel died in the early '50s, he believed 1953, and that the association donates all their proceeds to hospitals or colleges in the state of Michigan and that in no way was it connected with North Fox Island or activities involving young people. He advised further that a lot of wealthy and influential persons hunt on North Manitou Island.

INTERVIEW PETE JURICA:

PETE JURICA, Mr. JURICA is owner/operator of Lake Michigan Hardwood Corporation and has been lumbering North Manitou Island for the past 22 years. He stated that the Manitou Island Association was an association of influential people and advised about the same information that JACK




I checked with St. Clair County Asst. Pros. FRANK FORSYTHE who is in charge of case. (313) 985-2400

He advised that we can not extradite SHELDON from HOLLAND where he is a citizen.

Prior to 1983 we had no extradition treaty with Holland. At around same time, SHELDON applied for Holland citizenship & it was granted to him. (He married a prostitute in France & also has immunity there) He apparently lied on citizenship application & swore that there were no outstanding warrants for him. (apparently doesn't matter).

When St. Clair County tried to extradite him from HOLLAND, the US STATE DEPT. declined to authorize, saying we "Missed the window of opportunity". The US & HOLLAND entered into an extradition treaty after 1983. Treaty was made to include Sheldon

SHELDON is entered on wanted computer thru INTERPOLE & is arrestable in 108 countries if he travels. For present time he is home free. The St. Clair County Prosecutor WILL EXTRADITE if subj is caught in area where he can be returned.
