After the judge put some of his thoughts on the record, regarding this issue, he stated that he is going to think about it this week and make his ruling in the courtroom on October 9th, 2007. While Feinberg was making his argument, he supplied me with two more clues about the person that possibly confessed to the Oakland County Child r and his attorney (Jane Burgess). Garry Gray (MSP) began to make some calls to the different MSP locations where old polygraph records might be stored. 11-21-07: I spoke with Garry Gray this morning and gave him the name Ralph Cabot as possibly our MSP examiner that polygraphed ε I the possible OCCK suspect 30 years ago. Garry was going to call some of the older MSP examiners and run the name, "Cabot" by them.

11-21-07: We had a meeting today at the MSP Metro North Post, to discuss the new information that has been developed in the past couple of weeks, regarding the polygraph examiner and the connection between Ted Lamborgine & Ted Miller. Present at the meeting, along with me, were Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) and John Ouelett & Jason Bolinger (FBI). Garry started the meeting by stating that he has confirmed that Ralph Cabot was in fact a polygraph examiner for the Michigan State Police in the 1970's, worked out of the Flint, Michigan post. Garry said that Cabot retired from MSP in 1980. This matches what told us yesterday about the examiner from MSP. This should assist us in narrowing down the identity of the suspect who confessed to Garry said that he learned that all the old polygraph files from the OCCK case have been kept and they are stored at the MSP post in Northville. Garry also stated that there are over 500 polygraph files and in no particular order. We discussed the fact that there is a possibility that this person could be connected to Lamborgine.

11-26-07: I talked to Garry Gray (MSP) today about going thru the old MSP polygraph files to search for the suspect that confessed to Garry is in the process of trying to locate examiner Ralph Cabot's old files. His files could possibly be at the MSP Flint post, where he (Cabot) was assigned and conducted polygraph in the 1970's.

11-27-07: Garry located Cabot's old files at the Flint MSP post today. He and Dave & I are driving there, tommorow to go through them. This file contains all the open homicide polygraph files that Cabot conducted in the 1970's and 80's before he retired.

11-28-07: *** (Flint MSP Post today to review Cabot's old polygraph files) *** Garry Gray, Dave Robertson (MSP) & I went to the MSP Flint Post today to look thru the old polygraph files from homicide cases that MSP Examiner, Ralph Cabot had done in the late 1970's – early 1980's. We went thru approximately 45-50 files of polygraphs Cabot did relating to homicide cases during those years, but only 2 file jackets related to the Oakland County Child Killings. The first file jacket was a subject that Cabot polygraphed for the Task Force in regards to the child killings, on 10-9-1979, named I 2. This polygraph file showed (to be a pedophile that divorced in 1975, had been married, with two young boys. This polygraph file showed that! worked as a childrens bus driver for a Baptist church in Genesee County in 1977 and was involved in multiple CSC's in that county in 1977. A report in the polygraph file stated that I (was from the Detroit area, had lived in Rochester and attended Calvary Baptist Church in Hazel Park. was polygraphed by Cabot in regards to the child killings,

When we arrived back at the MSP Metro North Post, we pulled tip# 17153 on from the tip files. There was no indication, that I nad been arrested and/or officially charged with any CSC in 1977-78 timeframe, like I had indicated about the subject that confessed to him about the killings, nor was there any indication this subject was deceased. This tip file did state that liked young boys and young girls. This tip was stamped CLOSED by the Task Force after

The other Cabot polygraph file we found at the Flint post that was related to the Oakland County Child Killing's contained 2 polygraphs, both of which were requested by Detective Lourn Doan from

Southfield Police Department. The first polygraph was administered on a subject named Busch, Examiner, Cabot administered this polygraph on 1-28-Christopher Brian, 1977 in regards to the Stebbins abduction/ murder. Cabot's report indicated that based on the . The date and analysis of the examination, F r had indicated about the possible suspect, taking results of this test, matches what a State Police Polygraph in regards to the OCCK case, at the "height" of the investigation. In Cabot's pre-test notes from the interview of Busch, it states that he (Busch) had discussed with his associate (Greg Greene) fantasies he has about "liking tying up some kid." Busch admitted to Cabot that he has had "affairs" with young boys and that he has a sexual problem, but denied having any involvement in the Stebbins case. Busch also told Cabot that he has a poor relationship with his father and that he can talk easier to his mother. Busch told Cabot, that he flew back from England to Metro Airport and arrived February 14th, 1976. Busch went on to say that he didn't remember where he was for a few days after he returned from England, but believed he had stayed a few days at his parents home in Birmingham, Michigan before going back up north. The notes indicate that he went up to the Hillman, Sanford area of northern Michigan.

The second polygraph contained in the Busch polygraph file, was that of Busch's associate, Greene, Gregory Woodard, . The test on this subject was administered 2-1-1977 in regards to the Stebbins abduction/murder. Cabot's report indicated that based on the analysis of the examination, (Cabot's notes from the pre-test interview indicated that Greene had just recently returned to Michigan (2-14-1976),

Cabot's notes showed that Greene had been arrested for CSC, 1st degree. When Cabot asked Greene, what kind of person would have done this to Stebbins, Greene stated, "someone that knew the kid and killed him to keep it quiet," then stated "or it was a one time thing." Cabot asked Greene, what should happen to the person that committed this crime, if he is caught, to which Greene stated," that it depends on the person." Greene also indicated to Cabot that he had hurt 2 boys in California in the past while threatening them not to say anything after he molested them.

While back at the MSP Metro North Post, we also pulled the tips on Busch & Greene. Busch had tip#'s 369 & 1035 called into the task force on him in 1976-77. Greene had 3 tips called in on him in 1976-77. Tip #'s 370, 9368 & 14753. A few of these tips called in on Busch & Greene are very early on in the original investigation considering the over 20,000 tips called in during that time.

We were unable to locate tip #369 for Busch, but found tip #1035. This tip had a note that stated that Busch was currently under indictment for sexual misconduct charges. This tip was called in on 3-20-1977. On the second page of this tip, was a note that stated Busch was cleared on tip#369, . Another note stated that Busch was deceased after committing suicide on November 20th, 1978, stating that the home was checked, but it does not say what home or what location. Both of these entries match what had told me about the

say what home or what location. Both of these entries match what had fold me about the person that confessed to him being charged with CSC at the "height of the investigation" and was now deceased. Another tip was called in on Busch on August 13th, 1977, from a Sheriff in Presque Isle County, Michigan. Sheriff Duane Badder gave the following information to the task force, but it appears that a tip number was not issued on this info. It showed Busch to have an address at A note on this tip stated that Busch was being held in

Presque Isle County on 3rd Degree sexual offense charges and was picked up at his cottage on Ess Lake in Montmorency County, Michigan. Busch's Parole Officer gave info that Busch is supposedly involved in a pornography ring.

We found 3 tips that were called into the task force on Greg Greene during the original investigation in the 1970's, which were tip #'s 370, 9368 & 14753. We were unable to locate tip# 370, but did find tip#'s 9368 & 14753. The front of #9368 had only the name Gregory Woodard Greene, with an address at a This tip also showed a brown 1974

This may also be the county he was in when he committed suicide. I requested any and all paperwork they could find on Busch to be faxed to me at LPD.

12-06-07: I received a packet of faxed information today from Montmorency County Sheriff's Dept. regarding Christopher Busch. The Dispatcher that faxed it to me (Amanda), called me and stated that she checked the basement at their department, but could only locate the "booking packet" on Busch. In this packet was a "Jail Inmate Record" that showed that Busch was arrested by their agency on 3-3-1977 for 1st Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct. It showed that the crime took place in Atlanta, Michigan. Busch gave the following information to the "booking" Officer: Christopher Brian in Pontiac, Michigan, with a current address at :

shows that Busch is the manager of a restaurant in Alma called the "Scotsman," which is located at 315 E. Superior St. Alma, Michigan. This matches what Busch told Polygraph Examiner Cabot (MSP) in January 1977 during the pre-polygraph interview of Busch. During that interview with Cabot, 2 months earlier, when Busch was polygraphed about Stebbins, Busch told Cabot that he had an associate's degree from Northwood Institute in hotel restaurant management and currently managed the "Scotsman" restaurant in Alma, Michigan.

This packet of documents from Montmorency County Sheriff's, indicate that Busch was arrested 3-3-1977, case # 0695-77 and that he was issued Montmorency County inmate # M-00027. It shows that Busch had two previous arrests in Ithica County & Genesee County, Michigan. This matches his CCH that shows

It appears that Busch was arraigned the following day, March 4th 1977 in the 88th District Court, Atlanta, Michigan, in front of a magistrate, on 1st Degree CSC, who set a \$10,000.00 bond. Paperwork in this packet indicates that Busch was released on March 4th, 1977, after his arraignment. **His father**, i posted a cash bond for Christopher's release.

**** (Found the supplemental report on Busch being at Ess Lake with two minors, March 19th, 1977. Tim King was missing at this time) *** While I was going thru this information from Montmorency County, I found a supplemental report written by a Sheriff's Department employee, named Charlotte Pelham, on March 24th 1977. In this report, Pelham writes that she received an anonymous phone call at the sheriff's dept. on March 19th, 1977. A woman caller (middle-aged) was asking to speak to a person that I determined later was a detective at that time in Montmorency named Junior Brandenburg. Pelham told this woman she would take a message. The woman caller stated, "No. by then it would be too late and that she had to talk to Junior. Pelham indicated that anything she told her would be kept confidential at which time, the woman spoke with someone in the background and agreed to give Pelham the information. The woman said they did not want to get involved and would not leave her name or number. This woman caller then told Pelham that Christopher Busch was in town with two minors. Pelham asked the woman where she had seen them? The caller spoke to someone in the background again and said that she could not tell Pelham that. Pelham told the caller how important this would be to enable the Sheriff's Dept. to find him. Pelham could here the caller talking to the person in the background, saying, "Why did you have me call them at all, if I can't tell them enough to help them?" She then told Pelham in an angry voice, "I am sorry I can't tell you more, but I would if I could!" Pelham then told the caller that if she changed her mind, to call right away. The woman caller then said, "All I can say is go to his place

The day this call was received by Montmorency County Sheriff's, Timothy King was still missing. There was no indication in this report, or the file they faxed me on Busch, whether or not anyone followed up on this call or went to Ess Lake to check on this. It appears Busch was out on bond at this time. Timothy King was taken from Maple Rd (15 Mile) near Woodward Ave. on March 16th, 1977 and found in Livonia on March 22, 1977. Busch's parents lived on near Maple Rd. (15 Mile & Cranbrook) at that time, just 2 miles from where King was abducted.

I also found a newspaper obituary in this packet from Montmorency County Sheriff's, about Christopher Busch's death and the funeral arrangements. This obituary stated that Christopher Brian Busch, died November 19th, 1978. It said that he was the son of brother of .

The funeral was at The Bell Chapel of the William

Hamilton Funeral home on Maple Rd. in Birmingham, Michigan.

There were 2 Circuit Court Probation orders contained in this packet of info about Christopher Busch. The first one was signed by Judge David Dewitt, from Midland County in reference to Busch's arrest there on 3-4-77 for CSC 3rd Degree. Busch received 3 years probation, fines & costs. The second order was from Judge Phillip Glennie from Montmorency County; reference to Busch's arrest on 3-3-77 for CSC 1st Degree. It appears that this charge was reduced to a CSC 3rd Degree and Busch received 3 years probation. This judge added a seventh condition to Busch's probation order which included him not be able to associate with any individuals under the age of 16. This order was signed September 8, 1978. Busch committed suicide November 1978.

**** It is interesting that when Busch & Greene were brought in to be polygraphed by MSP on Stebbins, during the pre-polygraph interview, they both independently tell Cabot that they don't really remember all the details of what they did or where they went after arriving back in Michigan, but they both state they arrived in Michigan February 14th, 1976. The newspapers had originally reported Stebbins was abducted on February 13th, 1976, but later corrected the date to February 15th, 1976. Busch told Cabot that he arrived back in Detroit from a trip to England, Feb. 14th, 1976. He said that he thinks he may have stayed a day or two at his parents in Birmingham, before going up north to Hillman or Sanford. Hillman is where the cottage is on Ess Lake in Montmorency County. Greene told Cabot that he was released from the mental institution in California in January of 1976 and arrived back in Flint, Michigan on February 14th, 1976. It appears as if they may have been trying to get there story straight for their alibi on when they both arrived in Michigan, but might have screwed it up because the media reported the abduction of Stebbins on the wrong date. They are listed in the original tips as associates, they told Cabot they are associates, they were polygraphed together, but I have not made the connection yet and there is nothing that indicates anywhere, how they knew each other or met each other. Both Busch & Greene both told Cabot that they arrived in Michigan 2-.14-1976, even though one supposedly came from California after 5 years and the other had arrived after being in England.

Also during this interview, Busch admitted to Cabot that he has a sexual problem that he is not proud of and when Cabot asked him if he knew why he was there that day to be polygraphed by MSP, Busch indicated that it was to determine whether or not he picked up that boy from Ferndale and killed him. Busch added that he was also there because Greg Greene told police about their discussion, when Busch told Greene he had fantasies about liking tying up some kid.

12-07-07: I met with Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) today and explained to them what I had found in regards to Christopher Busch and the possibility that he may have been out on bond at the time of the King abduction and could have possibly been involved in this. We also discussed the possibility that Busch & Greene may have been involved in the earlier abduction of Mark Stebbins. I gave them copies of the "Mapquest" results I found for "Ess" Lake in the Hillman/Atlanta, Michigan area. They are going to have MSP in Lewiston, Michigan check and see if the cottage on Ess Lake still exists and if so, who the owner is now.

Christopher Busch was 27 years old when he killed himself. The death took place at Busch's parents home at

Busch's brother (was notified of the death. In the occupation section of the death certificate, it says Franklin Club Apartments. Busch possibly was the "maintenance guy" there or possibly was involved in managing a kitchen there? In the section that states the type of business the subject was in, it says Food Service Manager. This death certificate indicates that Christopher Busch was cremated and lists the cemetery or crematory as Evergreen, Detroit, Michigan. I forwarded this information to Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) via e-mail.

12-12-07: I received an e-mail from Dave Robertson today. He forwarded me a copy of the request to MSP in Lewiston, for them to search the county records in Montmorency County, in an attempt to locate the cottage Busch lived at and was seen at on 3-19-1977 with two minors. This cottage was located on Ess Lake near Hillman, Michigan in Montmorency County.

She attempted to locate a police report on the suicide of Christopher Busch. The only record of a report they had for Christopher Busch, was when he was arrested in 1977 on a felony warrant for another jurisdiction (probably the warrant from MSP Pontiac on the CSC's). They have no record of a death report for Busch.

12-17-07: I called Genesee County Sheriff's Dept. Today and spoke to a woman in records (Donna) who is going to try to locate the arrest report on Christopher Busch from 1-28-1977, when he was arrested for sexual assault.

Donna indicated to me that it would probably take her several days to locate this report, if she can find it at all.

12-20-07: I received a call today from Donna at the Genesee County Sheriff's, who stated that Christopher Busch's arrest, was actually made by Flint PD on 1-14-1977, and thought that I might be able to get a copy of an arrest report from them. She stated that her records showed that Busch was housed at the Genesee County Jail until he posted bond on 1-31-1977. The phone number for Flint PD records, fax, is 810-237-6169. 2-4-08: I received two letters today from I In these letters described in more detail, his relationship with Christopher Busch & Greg Green. He also talked a little more about Ted Lamborgine, including the story of how he met and was molested by Ted Lamborgine, while hitchhiking in Ohio in 1977. He is going to have to explain this relationship to us further. It's just too coincidental that he gets picked-up by Lamborgine in Ohio and later he says that Lamborgine is connected with Busch & Green. Is either not being truthful, and trying to make his own connections, or simply holding back on the entire story right now.

about Stebbins. As I uncovered information about Busch & Green, after the investigative subpoena of polygraph examiner Wasser in 2007, it began to appear that our current investigation was mirroring what Doan was doing 30 years earlier in 1977. It appears that he felt strongly about these two as suspects during the original investigation, but did not have all the information then that we have today about these guys, nor did he know about Ted Lamborgine and his possible connection with Busch & Green.

- 2-8-08: Garry (MSP) e-mailed Lourn Doan today to try-to set up a meeting or a conference call with him for the beginning of next week. We are waiting to hear back from him.
- 2-8-08: We are still waiting for all of the police reports from Flint PD on Busch, Green Dave Robertson sent a formal request last week from the State Police, for archived records on these guys.
 - 2-8-08: I noticed in the Michigan State Police report from their CSC investigation into Christopher Busch & Greg Green in 1977, that Southfield Detective Lourn Doan & MSP Detective Dyer had gone to Busch's parent's home on ' to arrest Busch on the Criminal Sexual assaults he had committed against The Detectives made contact at this

home with Christopher Busch's father, who stated that Chris was in "Whitehall" and he would call Chris to have him turn himself in. Detectives instead, had Whitehall Police go to Busch's home in Whitehall to arrest him. Busch had left Whitehall and a statewide B.O.L. was entered in the law enforcement computer. Busch was taken into custedy in Ionia Michigan.

I thought at first that Whitehall, Michigan was a small town near Ess Lake, where supposedly Busch spent time at a cottage and was seen there with juveniles on March 19th, 1977 (While King was missing). I performed a check thru "Mapquest" and determined that Whitehall, Michigan is actually on the west side of the state in Muskegon County, no where near Ess Lake, which is located near Hillman, Michigan in Montmorency County. I performed some computer checks thru the "Lexis-Nexis" system and found that Christopher Busch's parents owned a property in Whitehall at that time, that they were buying on a land contract. It appears that the Busch's had relatives in the area. There were several "Busch" families listed with property in the Whitehall area. The property that was owned by Christopher Busch's parent's, was eventually "Quick Claim Deeded" to

2-11-08: We still have not heard from Lourn Doan, so we are going to go ahead and interview on Wednesday this week. We will interview Doan about this case whenever we can make contact with him.

2-11-08: *** (Located reports from Montmorency & Identified the cottage on Ess Lake, near Hillman, Michigan.) *** I called Montmorency County Sheriffs office today and spoke to a dispatcher named Mike Juricz who told me that Junior Brandenburg and Charlotte Pelham are both retired, but still live in the area. Brandenburg was the Montmorency Detective that investigated Christopher Busch in the CSC case when Busch was arrested and charged with in their county in 1977. Charlotte Pelham was the Sheriffs Dept employee who took the anonymous call from a woman on March 19th, 1977, that stated that she saw Chris Busch in the area with two minor boys. Juricz made contact with Charlotte Pelham who agreed to talk to me and gave Juricz her phone number for me. I called and spoke to her about the report she wrote on the anonymous phone call she took on March 19th, 1977. I read her report to her over the phone and she stated that she does not specifically remember that incident, but the part about Christopher Busch being in town with two minors, "rang a bell" with her. Pelham stated that Juinor Brandenburg would probably know who the anonymous caller was and where the cottage was at, stating that he (Junior) still lives in the area near Ess Lake in Hillman, Michigan. Juricz the dispatcher called me back and stated that Brandenburg's phone was busy, that he would keep trying to call him to either call me or give me his phone number.

During this conversation, Juricz stated that a Deputy Shaw, who is trying to help out, found the Busch file and has info if I wanted to talk to him about it. I spoke to Shaw who stated that in Detective Brandenburgs notes, it says that the woman who called on March 19th, 1977 was a "Suzie" from the "A frame" party store. Shaw stated that he is familiar with that store and can call over to the new owners and get "Suzie's" name. Shaw called me back and stated that "Suzie" is who is now deceased, but her widower is! who currently owns the Grand Lake Lodge bar near Alpena, with a phone number of Shaw stated that in Det. Brandenburg's report of the follow-up on these calls, it states that "Suzie" stated that the boys with Busch were approximately 16 & 18 years old. Brandenburg also interviewed who had called after seeing Busch with 3 young boys at the IGA on March 19th, 1977. These callers stated that the 3 boys were approximately 13, 14 & 15 years old that were with Christopher Busch. These witnesses all gave statements indicating that they only ever saw Christopher with young boys when he was up north.

Deputy Shaw then faxed me a copy of a letter in the file from Detective Waldren at Flint PD to the Chief of the Alma Police Department, March 9th, 1977. In this letter, Waldren tells the Alma Chief hat Busch has CSC cases pending in Genesee County, Oakland County, Montmorency County and

Midland County. Waldren stated that the strongest cases against Busch are in Oakland and Genesee County, stating that he has hired the best legal counsel to represent him (Jane Burgess). Waldren also wrote in this letter on March 9th, 1977 (7 days before King was abducted), that Busch is currently free on bond on all charges. I asked Deputy Shaw if he knows who the victim was in the Montmorency case and if he was from that area, to which he stated he did not, but would call the prosecutors office to see if they have the court file on Busch from their cases.

Busch told Brandenburg that he knew Gregory Green, but at no time did he ever bring Green to Ess Lake. Busch stated that Green was violent and tried to strangle a boy in Flint that he believes was

2-20-08: Cathy King sent me an e-mail today, stating that she ran the Busch name by retired Birmingham Detective Jack Kalbfliesch and asked if he remembers the name, stating that Busch committed suicide in Birmingham in the late 70's and was a suspect in the child killings. I expressed concerns with Cathy talking to someone outside the Task Force & Law Enforcement, about what we are working on, and she re-assured me that we could trust him. She stated that he has known about this since _ y and _ a year ago and hasn't said anything and she was very vague with him about what she was looking for. Anyways, Kalbfleisch told her that he did remember a suspect in the child killings that killed himself with a shotgun at a home near Maple & Lahser in the late 70's, and the reason he remembers this is because they found a pencil drawing in Busch's room of a boy "screaming" that looked like the Stebbins boy.

2-21-08: The Task Force met at the MSP Metro North post today and we had retired Southfield Detective Lourn Doan there to interview him about his investigation, back in 1976 & 77, into Christopher Busch & Gregory Green. We gave Lourn a few general facts about the case, as to "jog" his memory, but really wanted him to "fill in the gaps" on his own, without us leading him. Lourn remembered the investigation and remembered Christopher Busch when we showed him the picture. Being that it is such an old investigation, Lourn was struggling a bit, trying to remember details of the case. We showed him the original tips he wrote up on Busch & Green in 1976 and also the tip he wrote on these guys again in 1978. Detective Doan & Detective Roy Itami (Berkley PD) were working together on the Timothy King Homicide, as part of the Oakland County Child Killing investigation.

Doan continued to investigate these subjects as suspects. He remembered Busch killing himself at his home in 1978, but stated he thought he hung himself, but stating he did not remember for sure. We called Detective Roy Itami, who agreed to come to the meeting. Doan & Itami looked over the tips they wrote up and began talking about when they took Busch & Green to the polygraph with MSP in Flint. Doan stated that they, along with the "Task Force" were so convinced that these two suspects were involved in the killings that Deputy Oakland County Prosecutor Dick Thompson went along and was present during the polygraph,

Doan stated that Thompson also thought they would be issuing charges on these subjects. Both Doan & Itami stated that during the hundreds of polygraphs conducted on suspects during this massive investigation, this was the only time a prosecutor, especially the Deputy Oakiand County Prosecutor attended a polygraph. I asked Doan, if he remembers I

We then told Doan & Itami that we have recently, based on 'statements to y about Busch's confession to him and our recent investigation, shown Busch & Green's polygraph charts to two independent examiners, one of which is a very experienced MSP examiner. We told Doan & Itami that both examiners were in agreement, independent of each other,

Both stated:
Shaking their heads stating this could have been solved 30 years ago. Both Detectives asked where

their reports were. All we have is the tip sheets they wrote up and what was attached to the tips.

Doan stated that he knows he wrote lengthy reports on this lead. Itami stated that he remembers the amount of writing Doan did at that time on this lead and stated that there should be a large file on these guys. We are going to check further in the state police files for these. Doan stated that if we call Chris Helgert at Southfield PD, he may have a copy of his (Doan's), indicating that he thinks he gave a copy of everything to his agency.

2-22-08: I was reviewing Polygraph Examiner Cabot's pre-polygraph interview of Gregory Green today, and noticed that Cabot asked Green if there were anyone he wished were dead? Green mentioned his father, a couple of other names and ' 3. It's interesting that Green wants dead. It's possible that _ had information about Green and he (Green) was afraid would tell someone. We are going to take this report with us when we interview (in prison in a couple of weeks.

2-25-08: We went to Southfield PD today and talked to Chris Helgert about Lourn Doan's old reports involving an investigation Doan conducted at the time of the child killings, regarding two subjects, Christopher Busch & Gregory Green. Helgert had already pulled all of Southfield PD's reports that they had from the child killing investigation. In these reports, we found two tips written up by Detective Doan on Busch & Green in January of 1977. This file from Southfield PD also contained several typed reports by Doan about this investigation into Busch & Green. The following is a short "Time-Line" of the, "one-week" investigation in January 1977 when Greene was arrested for multiple CSC's in Flint and told the police Chris Busch killed Mark Stebbins. This short time-line includes some highlights of interviews and when & why they were cleared and the case was closed:

1-25-1977: OCCK Task Force contacted by Det. Waldren from Flint PD. They have arrested a
 subject named Gregory Green for CSC 1st Degree, who says that Chris Busch killed Mark Stebbins.

1-25-1977: Doan & Lt. Simmons went to Flint PD and interviewed Greene about this information. Greene, according to Doan's report supplies Detectives with all the information about Busch's involvement in the Stebbins abduction/murder. Doan notes that Green is looking more like a suspect in the homicides than an informant.

1-26-1977:

1 (the victim in this case) was interviewed. _____ said that he was afraid when Greene & Busch took him into the woods to molest him that they were going to kill him. Greene had choked him unconscious in the past when trying to anally molest him. Greene had told prior to this that Chris Busch had killed a kid before.

1 told the police that Greene had asked him a few months ago, to help him kidnap and kill a boy.

1 went on to say that when Greene anally molested him in the past, Greene used force, would not stop.

1-26-1977: Flint PD polygraphs Green about his info about Busch Killing Stebbins. Flint PD polygraphed Green about whether he knows for sure who killed Stebbins.

1-26-1977: Green was interviewed today by Dick Thompson (Oak.County Pros.), Gary Hawkins and Lt. Simmons (Southfield PD).

1-27-1977: Warrant obtained today for Christopher Busch, by Flint PD for a CSC 3rd Degree.

1-28-1977: Detective Doan, Det. Cattel (Ferndale PD), Sgt. Rivard (MSP) & Det. Waldren (Flint PD) went to the "Scotsman" restaurant today in Alma, Michigan and arrested Christopher Busch on Flint PD's CSC charge.

1-28-1977: Detectives conduct a consent search of Busch's home at Detectives find 2 shotguns, ½ - 1lb. Of Marijuana and 2 suitcases. 1 suitcase contained ropes and

the other contained child pornography, including child porn films and scrapbooks. The 2 suitcases found in Busch's home in Alma, were confiscated by Flint PD as evidence in their CSC case. 1-28-1977: Doan, Cattel, Waldren & Rivard (MSP) interviewed Busch about his possible 4567.89 involvement in the Oakland County Child Killings. Busch denies involvement in the Stebbins case. but told Detectives about fantasies that he and Green have discussed. Busch said that they have talked about wanting to kidnap a boy, tving him up and sexually abusing him. Busch stated that either he or Green would work at night and the other during the day, so one of them would always be with the boy. When Busch was asked what they would do with the boy when they were done with him, he couldn't answer. While Busch was talking to Investigators about being a pedophile and 10 locations he picked up and dropped off boys in the past, he named the following locations in chronological order: 9 Mile & Woodward in Ferndale, 13 Mile & Woodward in Royal Oak, & the "7-11 11" store on 12 Mile in Berkley. These are the first three abduction sites, in order. The King 12 13 abduction had not occurred yet. 14 1-28-1977: Busch was polygraphed today by Ralph Cabot, at MSP in Flint. Busch was asked 15 about his involvement in the Stebbins abduction/murder and/or his knowledge of it. 16 17 2-1-1977: Green was polygraphed today by Ralph Cabot, at MSP in Flint. Green was asked about his involvement in the Stebbins abduction/murder and/or his knowledge of it. ' 18 19 20 .. An article in the Daily Tribune 2-1-1977: ' was in this file that stated on the headline that Task Force finds no link between Flint case and child 21 killings in Oakland County. The article stated that two men arrested in Flint were polygraphed about 22 their possible involvement in the child murders in Oakland County, but both were cleared. *** This 23 24 case was closed. *** 2-26-08: We went to Flint PD today to try to get any reports or notes their Detectives might have 26 done on Green's info about Busch, and also copies of the polygraphs Flint PD did on Green. Newspapers from Friday thru Monday were found on the porch of the home. The Thursday edition of the paper was found in the the entertaint of the second o 5 . 6 . 7 Investigators spoke with the manager of the Franklin Club Apartments, 28301 Franklin Rd. in Southfield, Michigan, where Chris worked as an administrative Chef until he resigned on November 4th, 1978, to pursue a new job at the Franklin Terrace Apartments. . 8 During an interview of Christopher Busch's father, 1 , on November 27th, 1978, he stated that Christopher was due to start his new job on November 20th, the day he was found 9 10 deceased. Christopher Busch was found lying on his side in his bed facing the wall. Pinned to the wall was a 11 12 hand-sketched pencil drawing of a boy screaming. The boy was wearing a coat in the drawing that matched the coat Mark Stebbins was wearing when he was abducted and killed. The coat was a 13 "snorkel" type coat with fur around the edge of the hood. Mark was found at Ten Mile & Greenfield 14 wearing that coat with the hood pulled up around his face and zipped up, just like in the drawing 15 Busch had.
