<u>INFORMATION:</u>			
<p>This post received a copy of <u>station #23's</u> complaint reference a FRANK SHELDON, L. SHELDON has been involved in immoral acts with minor children in the Port Huron area and also at his address in Ann Arbor. Station #23 learned through a GERALD RICHARDS who was involved with SHELDON in these immoral acts that SHELDON has a large quantity of pornographic literature and also photographs and other materials depicting these immoral acts in his home in Ann Arbor.</p> <p>RICHARDS, who lives in Port Huron, has been arrested by station #23 and has agreed to assist in the investigation of FRANK SHELDON. Undersigned officer talked to D/Sgt. Gorzen of station #23 and it was decided that a search warrant should be sought for FRANK SHELDON's home in Ann Arbor and an attempt to obtain the beforementioned materials depicting the immoral acts.</p>			
<u>PROSECUTOR CONTACTED:</u>			
<p>Undersigned officer contacted Assistant Washtenaw County Prosecutor John Stanowski this date. Prosecutor Stanowski was brought up to date on station #23's investigation and reviewed the complaint. Mr. Stanowski advised that there was a basis for a search warrant but that he would like GERALD RICHARDS to sign the search warrant as the affiant.</p> <p>At this time arrangements were made through Trooper David Lambourn of station #23 to bring RICHARDS to Ypsilanti to meet with the prosecutor.</p> <p>Trooper Lambourn and RICHARDS arrived in Ypsilanti about 7:00 P.M. date. A meeting was held at the prosecutor's office with Mr. Stanowski and RICHARDS was interviewed by the Assistant Prosecutor. After the interview with RICHARDS the search warrant was authorized by Mr. Stanowski.</p>

<p>The search warrant was issued by Judge S. J. Elden, 15th District Court Ann Arbor at 11:45 P.M. this date. GERALD RICHARDS signed the search warrant as the affiant.</p>

CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT FIRST DEGREE - YOUNG BOYS BEING DEBAUCHED BY MALE ADULTS

SEARCH WARRANT EXECUTED:

The search warrant was executed at about 12:20 A.M. on 7-29-76. This was at _____ There was no one home at the residence and several attempts were made to obtain a key to the residence but all attempts failed. Officers broke out a lower window on the front of the building to gain excess to the residence.

RICHARDS had previously advised the officers that the materials we were looking for would be located in three metal type cabinets located in the office of SHELDON's residence which is located on the lower level. Officer's found the metal cabinets, however, found no pornographic material in them. One of the cabinets did contain different correspondence, etc., however, nothing of a pornographic nature. The other two metal filing cabinets were empty. Officers checked the remainder of the office and the remainder of the lower level of SHELDON's residence and found no incriminating evidence.

REMARKS:

It is the decision of the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's office not to authorize any warrants against SHELDON at this time. The officer was advised that they will wait and see the results of the charges that are going to be brought against SHELDON in St. Clair county. 

Undersigned officer made a check at the Ann Arbor airport and subsequently contacted the Gordon Aviation Agency. It was learned from Gordon Aviation that SHELDON had been in the Ann Arbor area on 7-26-76. At this time SHELDON advised the people at Gordon Aviation that he was flying to the state of Oregon.

It is the undersigned officer's opinion that upon SHELDON hearing that RICHARDS had been arrested on 7-26-76 that he did make a trip to the Ann Arbor area to his residence to remove or destroy any incriminating evidence that might have been there. It was learned from RICHARDS that SHELDON had been staying in Aspen, Colorado.

RECONTACT GERALD RICHARDS: Undersigned was contacted by RICHARDS on Tues, 7-27-76, at approximately 3:00pm. RICHARDS requested to speak with d/sgt Gorzen, however, it was explained to him that he was presently on vacation, and that undersigned officer was assisting on the case.			
RICHARDS advised that he had further information and wanted to speak with one of the officers concerned. D/Sgt Gorzen was contacted, and he advised that undersigned could pursue the information.			
On Weds, 7-28-76, at approximately 10:00am, undersigned contacted RICHARDS at the Port Huron General Hospital, psychiatric ward, and interviewed him in his room.			
RICHARDS advised that he wished to cooperate in any way he could with further information on the other suspect FRANK SHELDON. RICHARDS would ramble on with superfluous information but did advise that he remembers FRANK coming to Port Huron, sometime in May 1976, and that he and FRANK, and met at the clinic on Water street, and performed sexual actions at that location. What made the visit somewhat unusual was the fact that FRANK drove to town this date, and normally he flew into St. Clair County airport. The exact date could be confirmed by a receipt RICHARDS has from an aquarium motor, which was purchased by FRANK during the visit.			
RICHARDS reiterated that he observed a large quantity of pornographic material at the SHELDON home in Ann Arbor, Mich., and that he had last been at the house on Friday, 7/23/76. The items included transcripts of FRANKS writings (pedophilic in nature), photographs, slides movies...all of which are homosexual and pedophilic in nature. RICHARDS advised that he has the key to the apartment, and to the files, and would be willing to take officers to the location for the confiscation of same.			
The interview ended at approximately 10:45am this date.			
CONTACT PETER DEEGAN: Undersigned contacted the prosecutor, DEEGAN, and advised him of the interview with RICHARDS and the acquisition of the new information. DEEGAN was also advised of the fact that the Washtenaw County authorities (Ypsilanti Post) desired to obtain a search warrant for the SHELDON residence in Ann Arbor, Mich., but that it would entail bringing RICHARDS down to that jurisdiction for the purpose of being an affiant on a search warrant.			
DEEGAN expressed the desire to wait and settle the circuit court appearance of RICHARDS first, and then execute the necessary search warrant in Ann Arbor. Undersigned advised him that one to RICHARDS having contact with SHELDON, and advising him that the "heat" was on, that it would be essential to expedite the obtaining of the search warrant. DEEGAN concurred.

CONTACT WITH YPSILANTI STATE POLICE:

Undersigned was contacted by D/Sgt Richard Todd, of the Ypsilanti post, who advised that they had attempted to obtain a search warrant for the Ann Arbor residence of SHELDON, however, due to the time lapse, no warrant would be issued.

TODD advised that if RICHARDS could be brought down to Washtenaw County, that then the prosecutor would consider issuance of a search warrant. Undersigned advised Sgt. Todd that the necessary, concerned parties would be contacted for a decision.

CONTACT PROSECUTOR:

As mentioned prior, DEEGAN advised that he concurred with the fact that it might be essential to expedite the issuance of a search warrant due to SHELDON being aware of what had transpired between RICHARDS. However, he was recontacted at 4:20pm for confirmation.

He further advised that RICHARDS had signed an agreement stating that he would cooperate with further investigation, and that this had been witnessed by his attorney, Jerry Edson, who was at present out of town. DEEGAN advised this officer to go ahead with the investigation.

CONTACT DR. KATZ, PSYCHIATRIST:

Undersigned contacted DR. KATZ, who was handling the treatment of RICHARDS, at Port Huron General Hospital. Dr. Katz advised that it would be satisfactory to take RICHARDS to the Washtenaw County area, as long as he (RICHARDS) agreed to go, and only under that circumstances.

CONTACT GERALD RICHARDS:

Undersigned contacted RICHARDS, who advised that he would go with this officer to Ann Arbor, and that he had spoken with his father, and he concurred that he should cooperate with the investigation. Undersigned picked up RICHARDS at the hospital at approximately 5:00pm this date, for transportation to Ypsilanti State Police Post.

OBTAINING SEARCH WARRANT:

Undersigned and RICHARDS, met with D/Sgt Todd at the Ypsilanti post, and from there, proceeded to the Washtenaw County Prosecutors sub-office, and there met with assistant prosecutor John Stanowski. A search warrant was composed and typed by Stanowski, and from there, the 2nd District Judge contacted, Judge ELDON, signed the search warrant in the city of Ann Arbor, Michigan.

SERVICE OF SEARCH WARRANT:

Officers from the Ypsilanti post, undersigned, RICHARDS, S/Todd, A-Pros. Stanowski, proceeded to the location of the SHELDON residence,

Due to the late hour, and the concern for the health of RICHARDS, this officer cleared the scene with RICHARDS, prior to entry into the residence, and proceeded back to Port Huron General hospital.

D/Sgt. Todd advised that he would send a copy of his report, as to the search of the house and also a copy of the search warrant.

 On 08-03-76, Tuesday, at approximately 10:00am, undersigned contacted [Redacted] and [Redacted] for the purpose of getting a tape recorded statement of what had transpired between [Redacted] and FRANK SHELDON and GERALD RICHARDS.
 In short, [Redacted] advised that he had sexual relations with SHELDON approximately 4-5 times, once on Fox Island, once in Fort Huron, at Jerry Richards clinic, and about three times at SHELDON's home in Ann Arbor, Michigan. The relations consisted of hand and mouth contact with [Redacted] genitals, and reciprocation by [Redacted].
 [Redacted] was very subdued in his interview, making a few of the things he said, difficult to comprehend and/or hear.

TRAVERSE CITY PGST:
 A copy of the tape was made by undersigned and sent to MSP#71, attention D/Sgt. Don Chappell, for use in any prosecution by the Leelanau County authorities.

RE-INTERVIEW

IN dob [redacted] interviewed again on 8-17-76 in presence of his mother (new)

[redacted] advised that there had been a misunderstanding on first interview with him by undersigned. He had participated with [redacted] with FRANK SHELDEN, however no anal sex (this was with RICHARDS). [redacted] were advised of difficulties to anticipate as a witness. [redacted] has difficulty, however he is able to adequately convey an understandable recount as would be expected in court.

[redacted] said he went to ANN ARBOR with JERRY RICHARDS & [redacted] in an early weekend in January 1976 ([redacted] believes it was Friday 1-8-76 because he left school early & it was just after X-mas vacation) They went to SHELDEN's home & went in & waited for him until SHELDEN came home. They had supper & then JERRY & [redacted] took a shower together & after that [redacted] & SHELDEN took a shower together. While in the Shower, they played with each other's penis for about 15 minutes. After this he & SHELDEN went to bed together & committed FELLATIO on each other. [redacted] said he knows SHELDEN had a climax because he had [redacted] time to use to catch "white stuff" that came out of his penis. Next morning [redacted] posed for pictures in the nude by "pretending" various sex acts. RICHARDS had brought along his photographic equipment to take these pictures.

NORTH FOX ISLAND Gave same story as when first interviewed on 7-15-76.

PORT HURON: [redacted] & JERRY RICHARDS had mutual Oral sex while at RICHARD's clinic one evening just before X-mas 1975. While they were doing this in one room, [redacted] knows that SHELDEN was in the next room doing the same with [redacted]

RE-CONTACT GERALD RICHARDS:

RICHARDS was re-interviewed on 8-23-76 by undersigned & Det. L. EVERITT, HHPD. He gave officers an envelope with 20 B&W photos of a young boy participating with 2 older w/ms in acts of oral & anal perversion. [redacted] is a resident of [redacted]

He got this series of photos a couple of months ago from a Boy Lover he knows [redacted] w/m 49, a single shoe salesman from EDMONS, WASHINGTON. [redacted] sent him a roll of 35 MM film to be developed along with \$10. RICHARDS developed one film & sent th [redacted] lives & prints to [redacted] is ordered, however he kept a copy of each for himself. [redacted] is a [redacted] BI-PEL who tried to get into the Montclair [redacted] but was refused admittance. [redacted] then gave a donation to help "support" [redacted] and got the full of film in exchange. He knew RICHARDS had equipment to develop the film & could be trusted as a fellow Bi-ped, hence the request to develop the film.

INTERVIEW RICHARDS: (continued)

RICHARDS has pled guilty to Criminal Sex conduct in 1st Degree. Is awaiting sentence. His wife is divorcing him since his arrest & he is living with parents

Ref: Offense in ANN ARBOR: Gave same story as [redacted]. He knows [redacted] & SHELDEN [redacted] in other room. had sex, however did not witness it. Was with [redacted]

Ref: Offense at NORTH FOX ISLAND Gave same info as reported. He did not see SHELDEN actually engaged in sex act with any boy at any time, however does know that SHELDEN slept with [redacted] on 7-12-76 & 7-13-76 (when he was supposed to have taken indecent liberties with [redacted]). RICHARDS has seen SHELDEN & [redacted] perform mutual sex perversion on each other a couple of times & will so testify.

Ref: Offense in PORT HURON On a Saturday Evening (Believed 12-20-75) just before X-mas, RICHARDS picked up [redacted] and took them to his Naturology CLINIC at 310 WATER ST., (suite #8) PORT HURON. They met FRANK SHELDEN there (he had come up to help RICHARDS with business books). During evening, after 7:30 PM, RICHARDS had mutual oral sex with [redacted]. This occurred in one of the rooms of 2 room suite. RICHARDS opened the door to the other room & saw SHELDEN & [redacted] going "69". Both were partially undressed & laying on a couch. SHELDEN had [redacted] penis in his mouth & [redacted] had SHELDEN's in his hand & had just taken it out of his mouth to look up at RICHARDS. RICHARDS then closed door. RICHARDS has also seen both subjects do the same thing in a Battle Creek Hotel about 1 1/2 Years ago. This was also witnessed by [redacted] who was doing same thing with RICHARDS in another bed.

SEP 8 1976

INTERVIEW

[redacted] w/m dob [redacted] 2 was interviewed again by undersigned & EVERITT on 8-23-76. He now agrees to talk to officers & will co-operate in prosecuting other persons as he feels it may help GERALD RICHARDS receive a lighter sentence.

He verified all stories as told by [redacted] & GERALD RICHARDS. He & SHELDEN went "69" and gave each other a "B.J." at the Clinic & in Battle Creek as described above.

INFO ON INCIDENT AT MOTEL:

[redacted] told officer he was taken to HOWARD JOHNSON's MOTEL in Port Huron last summer by RICHARDS and had sex with a man he recalls was named GROSSMAN. RICHARDS gave further info on this subj. Said that DYER GROSSMAN is an acquaintance of his thru Bi-Ped activities. He came to Port Huron to help RICHARDS draw up articles for incorporating a Boy's Mission camp. He stayed in a lower level south-center-room at H.J.'s around last of July or 1st of August 1975 when offense occurred. GROSSMAN gave RICHARDS 2 photos of [redacted] with clothes on with motel scenes in background. GROSSMAN is avid photographer & has expensive equipment. RICHARDS gave these photos of [redacted] to undersigned. They will be held with Post complaint with others.

CHECK MOTEL: Officer checked with HOWARD JOHNSON's manager ROBERT VANNORMAN & learned that DYER GROSSMAN stayed in Room 46 from 8-1-75 thru 8-3-75. He had a 75 Ford with Mich. Lic. (reg to HERTZ', Metro A/P) Room 46 is a lower-south-center unit.

Check METRO A/P. HERTZ's Co. lists DYER GROSSMAN as having above car on 8-1-75/8-3-75 with NY Ops [redacted] & employed by HARVEY SCHOOL, KATONAH, N.Y 10336.

N.Y. Ops check: DYER GROSSMAN, w/m dob

Letter from Suspect GROSSMAN: RICHARDS gave officer a letter he had received that was postmarked July 19, 1976 in Oakland, Calif. from GROSSMAN. The envelope was pre-printed with return address OCEAN VIEWING (LIVING) INSTITUTE 22 RIVER RD., ARLINGTON, NEW JERSEY, 07032. Typed under this was

Letter read: Dear Jerry- just a note to say that I now have a "Little brother" age 12, and very affectionate although quite innocent. Some camping trips may cure that. I have met several BL (boy lover) friends in this area, and also looked into foster care here. The CNR (Church of New Revelation) has recently received permanent IRS CLEARANCE for another FOUNDATION, the EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION FOR YOUTH. Meanwhile I have been looking into Foster home possibilities in this area. The state pays foster parents \$180./child/month. Some homes which take problem kids get as high as \$400./month and the Federal Government pays as much as \$700./month for kids in a runaway home. Al in all it looks like a good deal, and I hope we will eventually set something up here. Meanwhile we have acquired some property as a donation in Oregon. It is not suitable as a campsite, but it is worth about \$15,000, much of which can eventually go to help set up the camp, home, etc. Anyhow keep in touch and let me know who things are going for you. Best, Dyer

Proof of crime at Howard Johnsons Motel: Victim advised about crime. RICHARDS advised that he witnessed GROSSMAN "go down" on _____ & saw them both naked in bed. _____ also advised that GROSSMAN was back in the area in late August or September 1975 & stayed in Room #2 at the HOLIDAY INN in Fort Huren. (He was on his way to the West Coast). He was alone with GROSSMAN in the room & they both performed mutual Oral Sex "69". (Officer has contacted Holiday Inn, (Sharon) at 984-2661 & the info as to registration is filed away. Clerk will look it up & advise). Subj was observed driving his car in Port Huron by Det. Amon. He was ordered into the St. Clair Sheriff Dept. where he was arrested & lodged. He also said this group had received a \$15,000 donation in Property in Oregon. Also advised that he had a "Little Brother" age 12 & mentioned the lucrative foster-parent set up by both California State & Federal authorities. (copy of letter attached.)

The St. Clair Prosecutor was contacted with request for warrant for GROSSMAN for Sex crime last summer. He has not authorized as yet due to work load. If/when warrant is issued, the information will be relayed to same authority the above info will be referred to.

Request that the COMMUNITY SERVICES DIV forward the above info to Youth Services Agencies in Oakland, California area or the California Attny General for proper assignment. Unknown if any of the Agencies that GROSSMAN represents are legitimate. In any event, his "Little Brother" status should be investigated.

FEDERAL AGENCIES:

Officer called IRS agent LEON GOSSAGE at Detroit 226-7266 & gave him info as to IRS Clearances. He advised that their Intelligence Unit & Tax Exemption Division would check the Tax returns for possible fraud. In talking to Federal Employees, officer was advised that perhaps the DEPT.
