OTHER DETAILS:

At approx. 0100 hours, this date, U/S received a radio call to respond to Huntington Inter-Community Hospital, reference a medical aid. U/S contacted Dr. LUI at Huntington Inter-Community Hospital and was advised that the above juvenile was brought into the hospital after being dropped off in the front and was in a violent stuporous condition.

U/S, while at the hospital, was handed a telephone which was answered by Sgt. PRICE, who indicated that it was the subject who dropped the victim off in front of the hospital. U/S spoke to this subject, who had a male voice and sounded to be approx. 20 to 25 years of age. This subject stated to the U/S, "I found the kid at Beach and Ellis, at the northeast corner. I never saw him before. He was in extremely bad shape, possibly under the influence of alcohol or something and I picked him up, I was going to take him to the hospital. On the way, he passed out. I took him over to the front of the hospital and let him out of the car, then drove to a telephone and called the hospital and advised them that he was out front. I don't want to get involved." U/S pressed for the identification of the caller, however, he belligerently refused, stating, "I don't want to get involved, but I just want to make sure that he is getting adequate medical treatment. I found him out there, I don't want to be any further involved. I did my duty, I brought him to the hospital." At this time the U/S hung up the telephone.

U/S contacted a registered nurse, Pat WILSON, the night supervisor at Huntington Inter-Community Hospital. She advised the U/S that the victim was given 50 milligrams of Thorazine, which had positive results and was a drug used to counteract hallucinogenic mental disorders. Mrs. WILSON stated further that the drug had a positive effect, which would indicate that the victim was possibly under the influence of a hallucinogenic drug, such as LSD, etc.

U/S then contacted a Mrs. NORMAN, who received the phone call and found the victim in front of the hospital. Mrs. NORMAN stated that she received the telephone call at Huntington Inter Community Hospital and was advised by the above indicated unknown subject that he took the victim over and deposited him in front of the hospital and he wanted the hospital staff to go out there and take him inside and give him treatment. He stated further that he wanted to remain anonymous and just wanted to see to it that the victim received medical treatment and hung up the telephone.

U/S was unable to determine who the juvenile was, therefore, a booking report for 601 WIC, ENDANGERING, was filed, listing the subject as John DOE, birth date unknown, approx. 14 years, M/W/approx. 5'4"/100/bln/hzl.

Dr. LUI advised the U/S that he would have Huntington Ambulance respond to HIH to pickup the victim and have him transported to Orange County Medical Center for further treatment. U/S followed up the ambulance to Orange County Medical Center.

U/S contacted Dr. FREDERICKS who further treated the victim at Orange County Medical Center. Dr. FREDERICKS stated that he was going to keep the victim at that location at the Medical Ward. He stated further that if the juvenile is revived and they could possibly ascertain who he was, this information would be related to the Huntington Beach Police Department; or if the juvenile should be listed as a missing person, his identification could possibly be ascertained by this method.

U/S requests that a follow-up be done by the Juvenile Authorities on this subject, due to his extreme lack of parental control and the fact that he was found in this stuporous condition. U/S left the juvenile in the custody of Orange County Medical Center authorities.

U/S, while at Huntington Inter-Community Hospital, observed the victim's condition to be total unconsciousness. U/S noted that they physical restraints on the victim and U/S was told by the hospital staff that the victim, when brought into the hospital, was in a raving stuporous condition and restraints were needed to restrain his arm flailing and kicking activity.

U/S scrutinized the condition of the victim and observed that under the chin and the frontal neck portion of his body to be extremely red and abraded. It appeared as if he had been choked or someone had attempted to strangle him. U/S further observed that the victim had what appeared to be cigarette burns around the navel area, approx. three (3) spots, where it appeared that someone had taken a cigarette and pushed it point-blank into his flesh.

U/S further observed that the victim was covered with dirt and leaves, which indicated that he may have been rolling in the dirt or was pushed down into a dirty, leafy area.

States while they were at the Warner drive-in, must have had at least 5 beers, and he had 5 beers. At this time I was getting pretty high. He suddenly sat up, knocked my glasses off, poked me in the eye with his finger, scratched me (U/s noted scratch on right inner forearm) and I went like that." GREENE at this time moved his left arm in a straight horizontal type motion, fingers extended, palm down. He stated at this time he believed he hit in the throat. "want into some- type of convulsion. He started screaming. "I put my hand over his mouth, and he calmed down. I was scared, I didn't know what to do. I pulled his pants up, slapped his face, shook his head, but he wouldn't wake up. "and called the hospital, told them there was a kid outside who needed help. I got in my car, drove back across the street and through the parking lot to see if they had found him. They hadn't. I drove back to the phone and called them again. They found him this time. The two times that I called I talked to a nurse. I then drove back to the residence. I was sitting in bed and couldn't go to sleep, so I got up, called the hospital to see how "Key" was. I was told they couldn't do anything for him 'cause they didn't know what was wrong. I told them that he had just drank too much. This time I talked to a police officer and said I was simply a citizen and found the boy at Beach and Ellis and didn't want to get involved. You know about that of course. In the morning I went back to the house. I had half the intentions to see if mother had been there. If she had, I was going to stay and get it over with. If she had not been there, I was going to tell _____ not to say anything because as far as I knew, he was the only one that saw us leave the night before. In response to questioning, suspect stated that at no time during the entire incident was anybody else in the car with _____ and him. He went on to explain that after _____ had passed out, he lit a cigarette and placed it up to _____ nose to see if it would awaken him. It didn't seem to phase him at all. He then stated that he accidentally dropped the cigarette on _____ stomach and he moved. He did it twice again to see if it would awaken him. It didn't work.

U/s then asked him, "Did you at any time try to choke him?" He replied that he may have grabbed him around the neck when he tried to shake him awake. U/s then advised the suspect that I was aware he was a little league coach in Fountain Valley. U/s inquired of him "how many boys on your team did you have sexual contact with?" He stated that he did not prefer to talk about that because he did not want their parents to know about it. He was advised the parents already know about it, and that is how I knew about it. He replied, "No." He feels that he hurt "Key" and he didn't want to do that, and he really felt bad about it. He then stated, "Look, I want you to understand this. I never had to force anyone of these boys. They were all willing or eager to do it. Some of them even wanted it or demanded it. If anyone indicated to me that they didn't want to do it or there was any indication that I would have to force them, I would leave them alone." He further indicated there was a lot of sexual contact with young male juveniles that he merely picked up, especially down at the Huntington Beach Pier. He indicated there was no problem whatsoever picking up young male juveniles for sexual contact. He indicated he could do it any night with 96% success.

U/s asked GREENE if he had sexual activities with older men, and he replied, "I don't know if you'll understand this, but I like any kid that looks good to me. I don't dig doing it with older men. I have done it, but only because they paid me." He was asked specifically if he had done it with He replied "Yes" and that always took him out for dinner, bought him booze, gave him money to fix his car,

gave him money to fly to Michigan and back. He stated that one time that Ed told him he did it with his own son. He would guess this happened approximately 8 years ago, and that at one time _____ led to get him to go to Mexico and pick up on the young boys down there. He said he wouldn't go because the kids down there were too dirty. He was asked if he had ever had relations or even thought of having relations with a woman. GREENE replied that he had tried and he'd thought about it, but he can't get a "hard-on" with a woman.

When asked about where he usually conducted his sexual activity with the young males, he stated that they usually occur at the residence in which he is residing at the time, i.e., the _____ residence or usually at the Warner Drive-in, the Fountain Valley Drive-in, the Highway 39 drive-in, or the Harbor Drive-in.

U/s asked him if there was anything he felt that was significant that he should add at this present time, and he replied that he could not think of anything at this present moment. He did specifically state that he felt he had a problem and he knew he needed help, and asked if it was possible he was going to get some. U/s advised him that he would undoubtedly receive a psychiatric evaluation.

At this time, U/s asked him where he was originally from, and he replied he is from Flint, Michigan, and stated he left Flint, Michigan because he was in the same kind of trouble back there. He stated he specifically came to the Southern California area because he felt that the opportunities for picking up young male juveniles was greater. He specifically stated he wanted to pick up young, male, juvenile T.V. or movie stars.

He further stated he had a strong fear of going to Orange County Jail because he's been there before and has seen how child molesters are sodomized half to death. He expressed a strong desire to be sent back to this jail after arraignment.

U/s has personal knowledge that subject GREENE has worked for this Department on an undercover, confidential informant status in narcotics investigations. It would be hazardous to his safety to be placed in Orange County Jail. U/s feels it would be advantageous to have the subject detained at the Huntington Beach City Jail for future investigation by this Department and other surrounding agencies.

U/s contacted victim in the HEPD Detective Bureau. A picture of suspect GREENE, Gregory Woodard, ^{was shown} victim stated the subject in the picture was the same GREENE, Gregory Woodard that he had been with on the night of the crime. Stated there was no doubt as to the identification, as he was very familiar with arrestee.

During the ensuing interview, victim stated that he had gone to his friend's house and had met the suspect who was at the location playing pool. During this period of time, suspect asked victim specifically if he wanted to go to the show. The victim agreed, and they departed the location a short time later. While enroute to the show, the suspect stopped at the liquor store located at Talbert and Magnolia, Fountain Valley, where he purchased two six-packs of beer and a newspaper. After reading the movie section of the newspaper, the suspect advised the victim they would go to the Warner Drive-In. Upon arrival at the Warner Drive-In, it was necessary to wait for approximately 10 minutes for the movie to start. During this period of time the suspect and victim engaged in general conversation regarding surfboards, surfing, etc.

Shortly after the movie started, GREENE stated, "Me and _____ play this little game. I tell him something to do and he does it, no matter what it is." Victim asked "What kind of questions do you ask?" Arrestee then stated, "Any kind of question." victim then stated, "No, I don't want to play." The arrestee persisted for a period of time in his effort to get the victim to participate in the "game," but was unsuccessful.

After the above conversation, the arrestee and the victim remained at the movie for approximately 30 more minutes, and the arrestee then asked if the victim was hungry. They then responded to the Pizza Burger where they shared a large pizza.

After finishing the pizza, the victim and suspect departed towards the City of Fountain Valley. Victim stated that he believed the suspect was taking him home, however he drove past victim's street and continued into Fountain Valley. Shortly thereafter, arrestee stated that he had stashed a 10-speed bicycle at a baseball field where he coached. Arrestee said he had stashed it there earlier in the morning. Advised the victim they were going to the baseball field to pick up the bicycle.

Upon arrival at the baseball field, located near the Fountain Valley Police Pistol Range, suspect parked his car in the south parking lot, east of the announcers booth. Suspect and victim then walked into the grass area between the baseball diamonds at the location. They continued through the grass area
