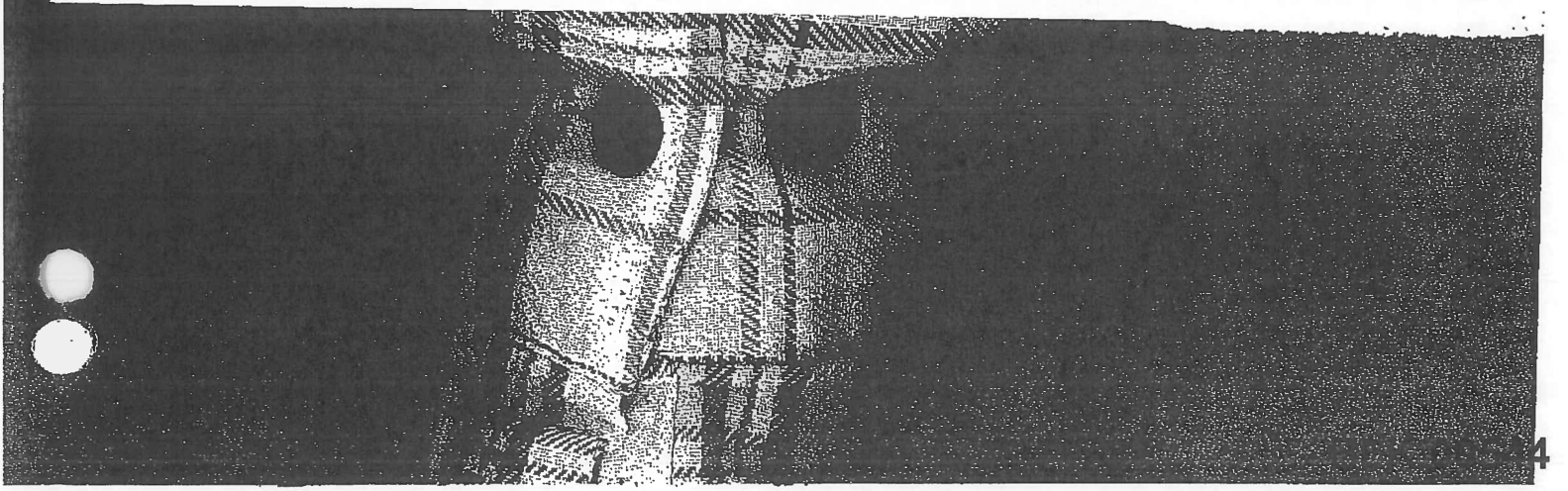

I checked with Officer Waldro who was in Charge of our C.S.C. case for which Greene was sent to prison. He stated Greene was involved in approx. 50 Sexual Abuse charges in California - Huntington Beach before that time. All of these charges involved children & Greene spent less than a year in some Forensic Center for same.

After release from the Forensic Center he came to Michigan & was placed on probation. David Ritter was Greene's p.o. and has the exact^(?) dates & times of Greene's whereabouts between this time & our arrests. You can contact him at Mon-Fri between 8am & 5pm.

January 25, 1977 Greene was arrested on our charges (3-C.S.C. 1st Deg. and lodged in our City Jail with \$75,000 Bond. Greene could not
(over)

make bond & was sent to Geneva
County Jail 2/3/77. Greene
remained there until 4/16/77
when it was sent to prison. I
double checked with the County
Jail - Greene was not bonded out
or put on any kind of work release
during that period. Only time
Greene was out was for court purposes
or with a police officer present
all the time.

HISTORY OF CASE:

On November 9, 1976, Officer Tom Waldron was contacted by Mr. _____ who is the principal of Donovan North Middle School, 530 W. Pierson Road. _____ related to Officer Waldron that he had been contacted this date by _____ the mother of _____ M/W/12, at which time, _____ related _____ had run away and that _____ had made Runaway Complaint #34476 with the Flint Police Department. _____ further related Mrs. _____ felt her son might be with the defendant in this matter, one Gregory Woodard Green M/W/27 of _____ and that Mrs. _____ had received information that Gregory Green was a homosexual.

At approximately 11:00 AM, November 9, 1976, Officer Waldron and _____ went to the residence of Gregory Green. Officer Waldron questioned Mr. Green as to the possible whereabouts of _____ to which Mr. Green related he had no knowledge of _____ presence nor had he seen him in two or three days.

On November 10, 1976, _____ then again contacted Officer Waldron and related _____ had returned home, but would not tell his parents where he had spent the night.

On November 15, 1976, _____ again contacted Officer Waldron and related _____ had admitted to his parents that he had spent the night at Gregory Green's house, hidden in the attic while Gregory Green was at work. The runaway complaint was considered exceptionally cleared by Policewoman Dawn Skidmore upon the return of _____ to his home.

On January 19, 1977, _____ once again contacted Officer Waldron. _____ related Gregory Green had been seen waiting by the walkway from Granville Street to Donovan School on three occasions and that Gregory Green had been seen with _____ the morning of January 17, 1977. At 11:30 AM, Officer Waldron and _____ went to the area of the walkway on Granville and parked in a private drive in _____'s personal automobile. From 11:35 AM until 12:10 PM, both Officer Waldron and _____ observed Gregory Green to be waiting for someone near the walkway, but after being checked by a Flint Police surveillance officer, James Hamilton, he left the area on foot.

After Officer Waldron had received the information regarding the contact of Gregory Green with _____ he contacted _____ and made an appointment for _____ to be interviewed by Sgt. Frances Miller of the Flint Police Department Moral Squad.

On January 20, 1977, at 2:30 PM, Sgt. Frances Miller conducted an interview _____ with _____ at the Juvenile Bureau of the Flint Police Department, with the consent of Mr. & Mrs. _____ related that the defendant, Gregory Green, asked _____ to come to the Green residence sometime during July, 1976. _____ stated he did go to Gregory Green's house on a rainy afternoon in July, sometime before their baseball play offs and was alone in the house with the defendant, who asked him to come into

bedroom as he was going to give some keys. followed the defendant to the bedroom where the defendant unzipped pants, removed his penis and "put his mouth" on penis for about 20 seconds. He then stopped and stated "That's enough for the first time." then stated "That's the last time." then zipped his pants up and started to leave, telling the defendant he was going to tell his mother. The defendant told him not to tell and he would not do it again.

Further related that prior to this incident, the defendant had fondled his privates on the outside of his clothing three different times at the defendant's home and once on the motorcycle trail they always used. He stated the defendant told him in California, he choked a boy who was going to tell on him; that he then brought him back to life and took him to a hospital and got caught. He said for this reason, he was afraid not to submit to the defendant and was also afraid to tell on him. stated he had slept in a hidden room in the attic of Gregory Green's house while he was a runaway, and on that occasion, Gregory Green had asked him to do the same thing. He further stated on a weekend afternoon toward the end of September, 1976, he had gone to Gregory Green's home. At this time, the defendant told him to come into the bedroom to look at some wooden cars. The defendant asked him if he wanted one of them and at this time started trying to unzip pants kept fighting him off and the defendant succeeded in unzipping his pants, took his penis from his pants and placed it in his mouth for about 20 seconds. stated he pulled it out and zipped up his pants because he didn't want him to do it. The defendant asked him to do the same for him. He refused and went home.

Further stated that the defendant keeps waiting for him on corners near his home and at school and motions for him to come with him. He again stated he is afraid of the defendant. also related some of the other members of the baseball team, ely, z and had been physically involved with Gregory Green.

On January 21, 1977, at 11:00 AM, Officer Tom Waldron conducted an interview with M/W/10, in the presence of his mother, in the Juvenile Section of the Flint Police Department. related he had met Gregory Green in June of 1976, as Gregory was the manager of their baseball team. Sometime during the earlier part of July, Gregory Green purchased a small mini-motorcycle and started giving the boys in the neighborhood rides behind Northwestern High School. related he went behind Northwestern High School on many occasions with Gregory Green, and P. While at the rear of Northwestern, Gregory Green placed his mouth on penis on approximately 10 different occasions. also related Gregory Green would have the boys hold onto his penis and have touch each others penis. further related Gregory would have place their mouths on Gregory Green and other times, he would "jack off and sperm" in front of them. In further questioning he denied ever placing his mouth on Gregory Green's penis or allowing Gregory Green to place his penis in anus as Gregory often requested. further related he observed Gregory Green "sperm" in mouth on one occasion to the rear of Northwestern High School. further related he felt some of the things they were doing was "wrong" and that he quit being around Gregory Green about the 1st of September. This interview was then terminated and left with Mrs.

On January 24, 1977, at 10:00 AM, was interviewed in the Juvenile Section of the Flint Police Department by Officer Tom Waldron. related he had met Gregory Green in the late part of June, as Gregory was the manager of the baseball team. Near the end of June, was alone in Gregory Green's house when Gregory Green related he would give an old motorcycle if he, Gregory, could feel him. Gregory Green then had open his pants and placed his mouth on penis. also related he had been in the field behind Northwestern High School about seven times,

and on each occasion, Gregory Greene had oral copulation with [redacted] penis. [redacted] also stated he was present the occasion Gregory Greene was being copulated by [redacted] at which times, Gregory had a climax in [redacted] mouth. [redacted] related on one occasion, Gregory Greene took himself, [redacted] a boy named [redacted] and to a drive-in movie on Corunna Road. While at the movie, Gregory Greene had oral contact with the penis of [redacted] After completing this act, Gregory Greene covered his penis with vaseline and had anal intercourse with the same three boys. [redacted] stated around Thanksgiving he quit having any further contact with Gregory Greene. This interview was then terminated.

On January 24, 1977, at 11:00 AM, a second interview was conducted with [redacted] in the presence of his mother, [redacted] in the Juvenile Bureau by Officer Tom Waldron. During this interview, [redacted] related much of the earlier information given in the interview with Sgt. Miller, but also added that Gregory Greene orally copulated [redacted] penis on 5 or 6 occasions while on the motorcycle trail behind Northwestern High School and on some occasions, had [redacted] and himself place their penis in each other's mouth. On one occasion, while [redacted] had his mouth on Gregory Greene's penis, Gregory Greene had a climax. [redacted] also related Greg had bragged to him about having sexual relations with over 100 young boys. [redacted] also stated on one occasion, the defendant, often putting vaseline on his penis, inserted it into [redacted] anus, but it hurt so much that he, [redacted] would not let Gregory do it again. [redacted] further stated he was very frightened by Gregory as Gregory had taken nude Polaroid photographs of [redacted] of the boys and had threatened to show them if any of the complainants told their parents what had occurred. This interview was then terminated.

SUPPLEMENT TO CIRCUIT COURT HISTORY

DEFENDANT: GREGORY GREENE,
Compl. #: #1892
CHARGE: Criminal Sexual Conduct 1st Degree

On January 25, 1977, Officer Tom Waldron of the Flint Police Department presented Assistant Prosecutor Lenore Ferber with the prepared Circuit Court History. After reviewing the court history, Ms. Ferber issued the Order for Warrant charging Gregory W. Greene with 3 counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct 1st Degree on Complaints #1571, #1891, #1892.

On January 25, 1977, at approximately 2:00 PM, the complainants on these aforementioned complaints, being _____, met Officer Waldron at Judge Shaker's courtroom. At this time, Judge Shaker swore the complainants and signed the warrants against Gregory Greene.

At approximately 3:00 PM, Tuesday, January 25, 1977, Sgt. Frances Miller and Officer Tom Waldron proceeded to the area of the _____ and arrested Gregory W. Greene with the warrants charging him with 3 counts of Criminal Sexual Conduct 1st Degree. The vehicle owned by this subject, a brown 1974 Chevrolet van bearing 1976 license _____ which Greene was arrested from, was searched by Officer Waldron and subsequently tied up by Officer Gary Jennings. The defendant was then transported to the Morals Squad Office of the Flint Police Department where he was advised of the charges against him and of his constitutional rights by Officer Tom Waldron, in the presence of Sgt. Miller, which he stated he understood and waived. The defendant stated that he had returned to Flint, Michigan, approximately February 14, 1976, after spending approximately 5 years in the State of California. He stated that while living in Orange County, California, he had been arrested on a marijuana charge and also for Criminal Sexual Conduct charges, approximately 45 counts, and after pleading guilty to one count, had spent 6 months in the Orange County Jail and one year in the Patton State Mental Hospital in Patton, California; being released from that institution on or about January 15, 1976. He further stated he is currently serving a 5 year probationary period for that offense and David Whitter, Genesee County Adult Probation, is currently his probation officer. In the middle of May, 1976, he obtained employment at the K-Mart Store on Belsay Road as a third shift custodian, but has since been discharged from that place of employment. In June of 1976, he became involved as the manager of a Little League baseball team in the area of his home at _____. He stated in June of 1976, he purchased a 125cc Yamaha from the Yamaha dealer in Flushing, which he financed through Citizens Bank. In August or September, he purchased a 1974 Chevrolet van from Al Serra Chevrolet, which was also financed through Citizens Bank. He further stated that since May of 1976, he has seen his counselor, _____, of the Genesee County Mental Health Department, approximately twice a week; this being a mandatory part of his California probation. The defendant, Gregory Greene, stated he became acquainted with the complainant, _____ M/W/12 (Compl. #1571) through the Little League baseball team in June. He stated he became sexually involved with him in July and had approximately 5 to 10 different sexual involvements with this boy. The last time being somewhere in November. He stated the sexual involvement consisted of mutual oral _____

copulation and that he had attempted anal intercourse, but that ^{was} found to be too small. He further stated he engaged in mutual oral copulation with ^{was} during the months of July and August, but did not know on how many occasions. Mr. Greene related that most of these offenses had occurred in his home at ; more specifically in his bedroom, but then on occasion, some of these acts had occurred on the bike trail behind Northwestern High School where he took the boys for rides on his motorcycle and some of the acts had occurred in his van. He stated that he had mutual oral copulation with /W/12 (Compl. #1892) at least 10 times during the period from June until through the Christmas vacation of 1976. Upon completing this interview with Gregory W. Greene, he was lodged in the Flint City Jail by Officer Tom Waldron.

A western hunting knife, which was located above the visor in Mr. Greene's van, and a envelope with the inscription "You can fool your brothers by pretending you're going into the school by the cafeteria. Put your hood up and walk over to the church," which was taken from Mr. Greene's person was turned in by Officer Waldron on Property Receipt #64680. Mr. Greene related he had written this note with the intention of getting it to

On January 26, 1977, Wednesday, Gregory W. Greene appeared before Judge Shaker, at which time, bond was set at \$25,000 on each count, bringing the total bond to \$75,000.
