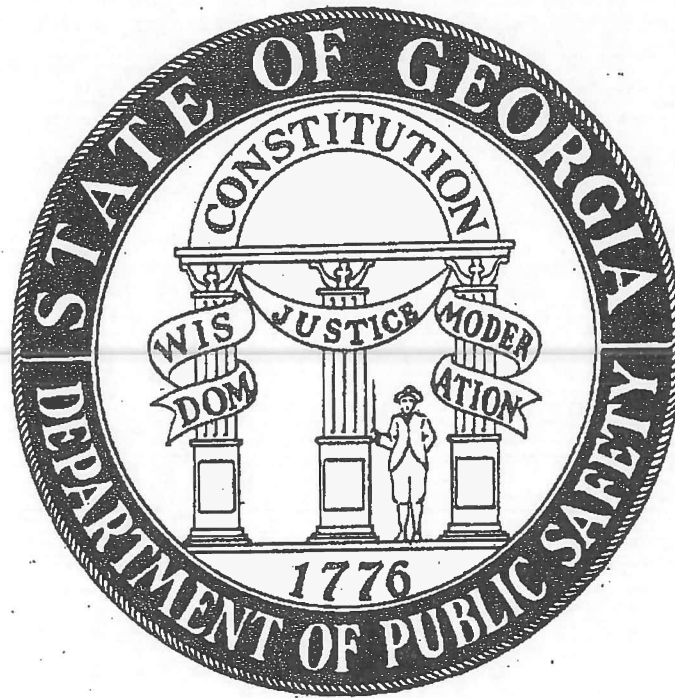

Mrs. Jarvis advised that several months ago, she received an unexpected call from Detective Sergeant Williams regarding the current Busch lead. She advised that they talked about how her father personally knew Berkley Police Officer, Lee Williams, (father of Cory Williams), and what was involved on the day of her daughters disappearance. She advised that it seem to be such a unique coincidence, (IE) knowing the relationship with the case and Lee Williams. She further advised that she had only spoken with Cory the one time, and that he told her that he was going to send her some photographs, (In particular, Christopher Busch's photo) to view, to see if she recognizes any of them from the times she used to work at the Hartfield Lanes Bowling alley/bar, back in the days of the investigation.

Debbie was then shown a number of photographs, (Busch and Greene,), as well as sketches from that time period on the suspect. Debbie closely examined all, especially the Busch photographs with nil results. Debbie stated that Busch looked like anyone from that time period and she had no recollection of his photo, whatsoever. The same applied to the sketches and other suspects involved in the current lead.

Erica then asked if Busch's suicide could have been a homicide. Both were advised that detectives look at all angles of investigations, especially after this long of a time period, and nothing is ruled out, however, as of this date, there has been no evidence or information which would suggest anything other than a suicide that was investigated in back in 1978.

After viewing the suspect photo's, both were then taken to the Child Killer case file room where a complete list of suspects were listed, to see if she recognized any of the names on the suspect board. Both Erica and Debbie studied the list of names to no avail. They recognized none of them.

The two were given a brief summation of the current lead, (involving Busch) and were both advised how the lead was developed through the Livonia Police Department. However, sensitive case particulars, (IE) polygraphs, the Atlanta investigation were not discussed.

Both were then advised of the prior investigation involving Theodore Lamborgine and Richard Lawson, and how that case came to a conclusion, (receiving life prison sentences), was discussed. Many other prior investigations involving numerous suspects, (IE) as well as dozens of other large binders and investigations were also brought to their attention. They were also shown the file cabinets that held tens of thousands of other case investigations into the Oakland County Child Killer case. Retired Police Officer Raymond Anger was also discussed, and Debbie advised she was very familiar with "Ray" and all the hard work he had done on the case.

In conclusion of the meeting, Debbie and Erica were advised that this particular lead, (Involving Busch), although very promising has yet to be investigated fully, regarding physical evidence and other followup leads that still need to be looked into. They were also advised that if any decisions regarding the status of the case are made by prosecutor's, etc. they will be contacted and kept in the close confines of information. Both also advised the undersigned that the information they were given this date, will be held in the strictest confidence and not shared with others.

On Thursday December 10, 2009, Prosecuting attorney for Oakland County, Jessica Cooper hosted a meeting with all task force agencies that was associated with the Oakland Count Child Killer investigation from 1977, till present.

The meeting began with introductions by Capt. Harold Love of the Michigan State Police and a brief overview of the current investigation into Christopher Busch, the King family concerns and what his role has been regarding same. Prosecutor Cooper added that all task force original agencies should be brought up to date regarding this current lead and what the status of said investigation has revealed up till now.

The undersigned then gave a brief overview of the current Christopher Busch/Gregory Greene investigation, however only a small portion of the investigation was revealed to the entire group. All in attendance were advised that the current task force investigators, Sean Callaghan, (FBI), along with Detectives Robertson and Gray were currently developing a possible power-point presentation, (If need be), that to date is yet to be completed into the Busch Greene lead.

All information concerning the Busch/Greene lead was not discussed due to time constraints and preparedness by the team, however another OCKK Task Force meeting may be set at a later date. Pending final lab reports.

On Wednesday December 15, 2009, the undersigned made telephonic contact with Parole Supervisor, Cheryl Deschaine, (517-241-0322), regarding the parole status of [redacted]. Cheryl stated [redacted] has been paroled, however he has had his parole violated for two violations. Cheryl advised that since [redacted] has been paroled, he tested positive on two separate occasions for "Cocaine". Cheryl stated he is currently being housed in the Ingham County Jail, and should be there until January 11, 2010.

Cheryl further advised that part of his parole agreement, was to be placed on global position satellite, (GPS) tether, and has many violations regarding his tether requirements and being outside set boundaries.

Cheryl Deshaine advised she will forward an E-Mail document, specifying his current status, as well as forward copies of any reports they may have on his current situation. As far as she could tell by his file, [redacted] has not filed for paroling back out to Montana where his sister [redacted] resides and where he was recently brought back from for violating his parole there.
