Present in the interview was Sgt. Muller from Flint P.D., this officer and Det. Cattel from Ferndale P.D.. The interview was held in the Flint P.D.

Above subject is a victim of subject Gregory Green. He states he met Green last May. He states Greg introduced him to Chris Busch. He states at when he first met Greg he was driving a blk Chev. Impala. Next he had a dark blue Chev Nova. He is now driving a Brown Van. On one occasion Greg and Chris picked him up at his house and drove around some back road & then stopped by some woods. Chris wanted to go into the woods with him. He states he didn't go into the woods with him because he was afraid he would be killed. He then stated later on and awhile Chris performed fellatio on him & then he did Chris.

On another occasion Greg picked him up and they went behind some buildings and Greg asked him if he could suck his dick. After this was done Greg wanted him to do it to him. He states he didn't want to and Greg forced him to. He states while he was performing this act, Greg grabbed him

around the neck and choked him unconscious. after he gave him \$3.00 to keep his mouth shut. He states Greg has never tied him up before but knows he has tied up other kids.

He states a few months ago Greg told him that he thinks Cris killed a boy. Officers asked him if Greg or Cris had any friends or relatives around Detroit. He states Greg told him once he had a friend in Ferndale but would not talk about it and said it was personal.

on another occasion Greg wanted to go to a local Playland store and help his kidnap a young boy. If he did Greg would cut off the boy penis and put it in a box to give to him. This did not happen.

stated Greg has sodomized him and when he did this he cried because it hurt and begged Greg to stop but he wouldn't.

He states he is afraid of both subjects.

Interview - Christopher Brian Busch

This officer, officer Cattel, officer Waldren + Sgt Rivard, sat in on a interview of the above subject at 4³⁰pm on 1-28-77 in the Flint P.O.

Subject again was reminded of his rights and again indicated he would waive his rights. Subject admitted his involvement in Flint's case involving

Wm 15 + Greg Green. He stated he was born in Pontiac, moved to Huntington woods and then moved to Europe + lived all over Europe. He was back + forth from Europe to Mich several times. This was do to his fathers job.

He admits he is a homo-sexual + strictly likes young boys 10-15 yrs old. He states approx 1 1/2 years ago he picked up a young boy at 9 mile + Woodward in Ferndale. He stated he thinks he was 15 or 16 + did not know his name or remember what he was doing. He states he did not molest the boy but dropped him off in Royal oak near 13 + Woodward. He states he comes down to the Detroit area to pick up young boys. He states in approx 1971 he was involved in the Big Brother program + had the brother in Berkley, who lived in the 12 + Greenfield area. He states

He took him to Heartfields for a while + also to the 7-11 store. He states he never sexually abused this boy. He states he is involved in the big bro program in alma + was with the big bro in midland.

Officers advised him Greg Greene told these officers that he, Busch, had killed Stebbins. Officers told him Greene had confronted him with this. Busch denied any involvement with Stebbins, + stated Greene had never confronted him about it.

He states he + Greene had discussed their sexual fantasies together + they were to kidnap a young boy to kidnap him up + sexually abuse him. one would get a job in the day + the other at night so that one would be with him all the time. When asked what would happen when they were through with him, he could not answer.

He states he was only involved with one woman - did have sexual relations with her. He states this was not enjoyable to him and likes little boys better. He states he was in London, England from Feb 7, 1976 thru Feb 14, 1976. He flew from London to New York, New York to Chicago + Chicago to Bristol airport in Flint. He states his parents picked him up at the airport and they went directly home. He states this could be verified by his passport.

Det. Sgt. Lombardi of the alma P.O. was contacted and asked if he would go to Buseles house.

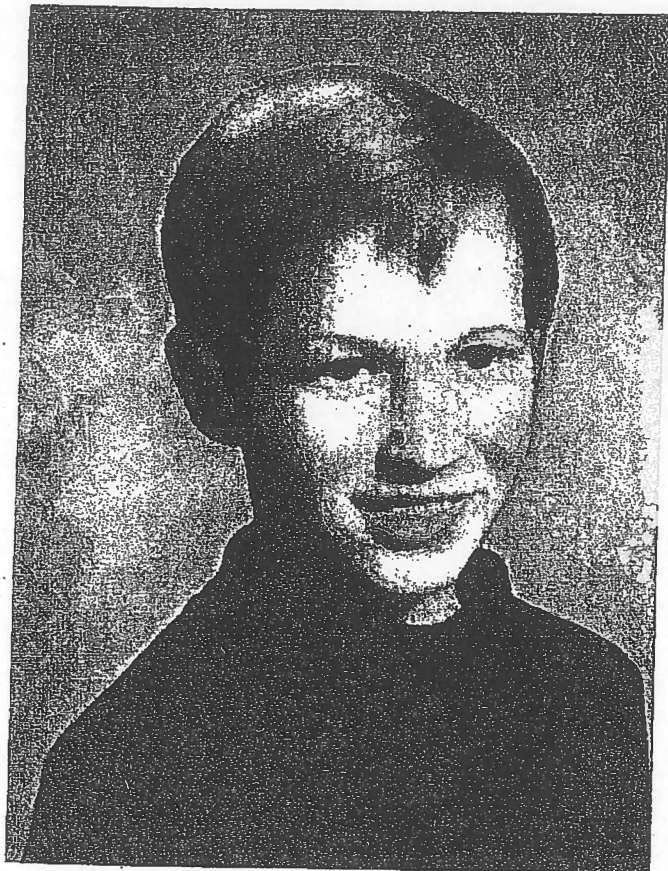

III. THE FINAL FOUR

A. Mark Stebbins

On February 15, 1976, at about 1:30 p.m., a 12-year-old boy—Mark Douglas Stebbins--left the Ferndale, Michigan, American Legion Hall to head for his home at _____ to watch a movie on television. His mother, who spoke with him just before he left the hall, called the Ferndale Police Department that night at 11:00 p.m. to report that he had not yet returned home and that she was concerned, since he had never done anything like this before. He was, she told the police dispatcher, wearing a blue, hooded parka, blue jeans, a red sweatshirt, and black rubber boots.

The missing person report filed by Mrs. Stebbins was of little help in finding her son, whom she described as being 4'8" tall, weighing 100 pounds, with reddish-blond hair and blue eyes. However, four days later, at 11:45 a.m. on February 19, a businessman named Mark Boetigheimer left his office at 15660 W. Ten Mile Road in Southfield, Michigan, to walk over to the drugstore at New Orleans Mall. Along his route, he glanced toward the northeast corner of the parking lot he was crossing and noticed what he thought might be a mannikin or dummy dressed in a blue jacket and jeans. As he came closer, he saw that it was the body of a young boy; he immediately returned to his office and called the Southfield Police Department.

The body, which would soon be identified as that of Mark Stebbins, was removed to the department's security garage where it was checked for injuries and possible cause of death. The autopsy, when performed by Dr. Thomas J. Pentinga, noted that death was due to asphyxia caused by smothering and added that there were also two small crusted lacerations of the scalp on the left rear of the head, that there were discolorations of the wrists and ankles that might be rope marks, and that the anal orifice was widely distended with obvious but superficial lacerations.

In the light of the fact that Mark's body was found just before noon on the 19th, the story told to Southfield police by Mack M. Gallop, another
