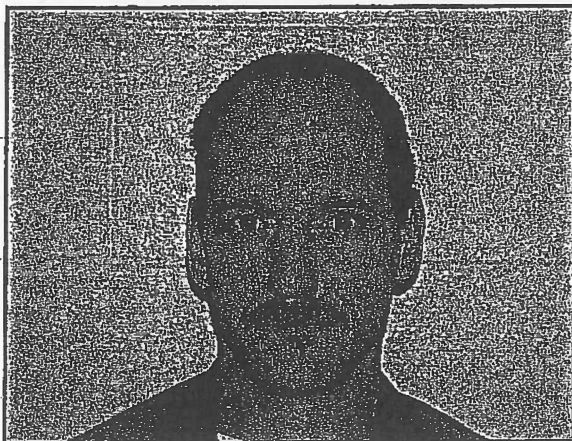

Regarding prisoner [redacted] Last week Detective Williams and I made contact with [redacted] at the Ryan Facility and interviewed him, (or shall I say, attempted to interview him).. At the beginning of the interview, [redacted] was less that respectful and told us in no uncertain terms, that he wanted nothing further to do with us. After explaining to him that all he had to do was then listen, we told him that after our earlier interview up at camp Ojibway, we found that he was less than completely honest with us and we just needed to clear up a few details.

[redacted] advised that prior to cooperating with us any further, he must first seek the advice of an attorney. [redacted] was again advised of the seriousness of this investigation, (homicide of 4 children back in the mid 70's), and we wanted, (hopefully) to clear him of any possible involvement, and or knowledge. [redacted] advised that after he consults with an attorney, he will get back with us. So I guess we're sort of on his time-table now as to when he wants to get back with us.

Please advise if MDOC plans on paroling [redacted] prior to the completion of our investigation of him, so we can make further arrangements if need be.

[redacted] was transferred from Camp Ojibway last winter when we learned he wasn't 100% honest with us regarding a cold case homicide we are currently investigating. (We flew up to the U.P. to interview him, which was very costly), thus we had him transferred to Detroit for additional interviews.

Approximately 3 weeks ago, special agents John Ouellet and Sean Callaghan of the FBI spoke with [redacted] regarding a polygraph examination to clear himself of possible involvement/knowledge. Mr. [redacted] is agreed with the Feds to take the polygraph, however he won't do anything without his sisters advice. She currently resides in Montana.

I scheduled [redacted] to take a polygraph test this Friday, 10-10-08 at 10 AM, of course if he's willing to cooperate.

As soon as [redacted] takes the polygraph, he can be released immediately. He is a person of interest that we'd like to clear, before he is paroled and goes to Montana.

Recently, new information has surfaced indicating that is has been directly linked to a 3 decades old homicide of 4 children.

The address of the parole office is 51 W. Granite Street, Butte, Montana, 49701. I have not called Mr. Berry due to my understanding that this information is to be kept extremely confidential.

According to my conversation with the Interstate Compact Office Deputy Compact Administrator, is staying in a homeless shelter in Butte. I do not have the address, nor did the Interstate Compact Office. Again, I have not wanted to raise suspicion so I have not contacted the Parole Agent to get an address.

Detective Sergeant Garry Gray called me from MSP. I explained MDOC's concerns regarding an attempt to retur as a PV at this point. I explained the possible outcome of having an ALE that might not agree with how the PV was processed, and the possibility of getting wind of the investigation if we push the PV issue with the Montana Interstate Compact office. I also explained the possibility of a parole rescission, but that rescission would require at least some disclosure of their case to Gary is not 100% sure if/how quickly they could get a warrant upon returning to Michigan.

I told him is now living in a shelter in Butte and that he has a new agent and reports to a new field office. **Gary would like us to find out the name, address and phone number of the shelter, and the name, address and office phone number of the supervising agent and get this information to him as soon as we can.**

I've cc'd Gary on this email so he can follow-up with the rest of the task force so they can discuss what is

in their best interest at this point. Gary hopes to get back with us today.
