

Regarding prisoner Last week Detective Williams and I made contact with at the Ryan Facility and interviewed him, (or shall I say, attempted to interview him). At the beginning of the interview, was less that respectful and told us in no uncertain terms, that he wanted nothing further to do with us. After explaining to him that all he had to do was then listen, we told him that after our earlier interview up at camp Ojibway, we found that he was less than completely honest with us and we just needed to clear up a few details.

advised that prior to cooperating with us any further, he must first seek the advice of an attorney. was again advised of the seriousness of this investigation, (homicide of 4 children back in the mid 70's), and we wanted, (hopefully) to clear him of any possible involvement, and or knowledge. advised that after he consults with an attorney, he will get back with us. So I guess we're sort of on his time-table now as to when he wants to get back with us.

Please advise if MDOC plans on paroling prior to the completion of our investigation of him, so we can make further arrangements if need be.

Detective Sergeant Garry Gray called me from MSP. I explained MDOC's concerns regarding an attempt to retur as a PV at this point. I also explained the possibility of a parole rescission, but that recission would require at least some disclosure of their case to Gary is not 100% sure if/how quickly they could get a warrant upon returning ______ to Michigan.

I told him is now living in a shelter in Butte and that he has a new agent and reports to a new field office. Gary would like us to find out the name, address and phone number of the shelter, and the name, address and office phone number of the supervising agent and get this information to him as soon as we can.

I've cc'd Gary on this email so he can follow-up with the rest of the task force so they can discuss what is

in their best interest at this point. Gary hopes to get back with us today.
