about it. Then she got so consumed in it that I cut her off and when I talked to her a few days later, it appeared that she had leveled off a little bit and I went over it a couple of more times and she got back on it again, and so I cut her off. I started finding out about the stuff. the police and everything and I had enough. By the time I called you last week, I had had enough. I said fine, if you want to sit down and talk about this, that's fine with me, but I'm not going to talk to her anymore.

- DS Do you have any other women friends that you go out with?
- Mould you like to have some other ones?

  Ya. That's one of the reasons I go to the restaurant with her because I get a ride up there, but I do know some other girls.

  Just socially though.
- EPO How long has it been since you've known in a biblical way?

Probably 3 or 4 years. In a biblical way she hasn't shown too much faith about anything since...

- DS He meant what was the last time you had sex with

  Oh, when she was pregnant. It's been a long time since I've

  had sex with her.
- DS Have you had sex with Helen?

  No. I really can't even stand to be in front of her.
- DS Now. But before that?

  She didn't turn me on when I first met her either. I may have

led her to believe that.

DS So motivation with Helen was that she was someone to talk to and she bought you coffee and cigarettes?

Helen is not boring. If anything, she's not boring. It's like going over a cliff with her. You get on and there you go. She does have a conscientiousness about her that you can talk to her, but there's this part about her that takes over where she stops listening and becomes a one-way conversation. Everything goes dead up here and it's all Helen after awhile. That I could live without.

EPO I had a question that I've been saving. I don't know what would be an appropriate time. I always run the risk of irritating people with this irritable question.

DS Are you homosexual?

No, I'm not a homosexual, and...

DS Are you bi-sexual?

Not bi-sexual, not homosexual. I'm neuter.

DS You haven't had sex with you haven't had sex with Helen. Give us some more motivation here. When you threw it out, did that mean like your asexual?

Do you mean neutered?

DS Ya, you're the one that said that.

JH Ya, it like...

DS Like you can live without it?

Ya. Like living without it. I'm 42 and I want to have relationships, but a relationship isn't as important as it use

to be.

DS That was the question.

I have to kick myself sometime because I am so particular and ...on some relationships because I've been that way, and I want to get on with my life and it's a matter of meeting the right person. That's probably more important than the relationship itself, and is not bad. I could live with her. I really tried with her, really tried to make it with her. Sometimes I'll go over there and she'll start talking about her ex-husbands. I don't care, you know.

EPO Does think your sexual?

No, I don't think so. Not really, she'll joke around with that kind of stuff. Her kids call everybody fagots. I don't like them. My generation wasn't like that, but I don't know what these kids are like, but they have seem to have no boundaries. That stuff gets in conversations and there's a lot of it in the newspapers and stuff like that. Some of the newsletters I get are...the education system is just crumbling.

DS What kind of newsletters?

I get one from Dr. Gary North, he use to be secretary to Republican Congressman Ron Paul. He's probably American's foremost historian and there was a story in one of the newspapers in Iowa that said that the one of the classes there was shown a homosexual film in German to help students learn German language better.

DS In Iowa? of all places. This newsletter is kind of a conservative...

It's a Christian conservative newsletter. For example, my sister teaches her kids out of school.

DS Your sister, -

she teaches them one year at home. She's doing that this year, and she teaches them one year in the public schools. That's just the way she feels about it. One of the goals of the Communist party on their agenda back in 1958 was to present homosexuality, degeneracy as normal, natural and healthy, as one of their goals written down back in 1958. One of them was to internationalize the Panama Canal. I see they've done that. These are moral subjects that are being undermined. There's a lot of talk about.every time you turn around on the news theirs talk about Gay rights, you know.

DS I take it from that then you're opposed to Gay Rights?
Ya. I don't see..

DS So, if someone would call you a homosexual, you'd be offended?

Probably.

EPO If somebody every called you a John Bircher would you be offended?

Ya, because I'm not that extreme. We don't have to be extreme.

EPO If someone were to call you a Christian, would you be offended?

No.

EPO Are you?

No. Oh, am I a Christian?

EPO Born again?

Yes.

EPO So, I was a little while ago suggest you get a job as a
 priest, but I guess you can't now, can you?
 I can't now?

EPO If you're born again, you're not born again ...

Oh ya, I was born in the Catholic Church. There's too many world events that are happening now are relating to the Book of Revelation. It started with the Jewish becoming a nation in 1948...

DS Does that connect up with the coming of priests?

No. You're talking about a Catholic priest?

EPO We're getting way off the subject. You did just bring something up. Somebody we talked to said you hate Jews.

This is a conflict, because there's many Jewish tribes and there's some Jewish people I do not like as to their banking habits, but I'm not opposed to the Jewish race. I'm talking about a very small minority of people. I've got a lot of Jewish friends I grew up with.

EPO Name one.

DS In the Village?

In the Village. Not at Brother Rice. I go back to my childhood when I grew up there. I remember a guy named

and a guy named .

and

some

These were good people. I have some criticisms about some of the banking habits that some of the Jewish people have and I don't condone credit either. There are times in history that mention things like that that happened. They're similar. In 1923 currency was totally destroyed. prices rose 1.3 trillion percent then. The economy was...there was a situation of bankruptcy, which is one of the reasons Hitler had persecuted. This kind of sets the table for a dictatorship to come in and enforce emergency type powers.

DS Which you're opposed to?

Right, because their unconstitutional.

DS You said you were a born again Christian, when were you born again?

About a year ago.

DS The reason that I ask that is because your sister said the same thing, and she said that it changed her life, and that wa right about the time she got married, which would have been about 1972. She said you and her were close. I wondered if that was about the same time that caused you...

I have a younger brother, who graduated from Oral Roberts University. He does missionary work. He's a born again Christian. I like him, you know.

DS He lives in Sterling Heights?

No, that's my other brother. He's in California. As a matter of fact, he's done work with homosexuals to straighten them out.

- DS Who has?

  My brother
- DS From Oral Roberts?
  Right.
- DS What do you mean straighten them out?

  Telling them that what they have is a sickness and it's unnatural, and it's not something you're born with, or inherited.
- DS Do you believe that?

  Ya, I do. I think can't understand it. Some of these guys walk around and talk funny. I don't understand how they do that. Is that something they learn or something they adapt...or it is something they're born with or what? Is it the way they grow up? I don't know.
- DS Well certainly in your life you've met people that were homosexuals and didn't act like that?

I don't know.

- DS You don't know of anybody that you've ever come in contact with that has been?
  - No, I've met some people on the street that appeared to be a little bit...
- DS Not even when you were in Europe, or anything like that?
  No.
- DS How about this guy?

  Ya, he's a little bit questionable. He would talk about homosexual topics.

- DS Such as?

  Rock musicians and stuff like that. You know, in songs.
- DS Like what, songs that refer to homosexuality?

  Ya, which you'd never know unless he brought it up. You wouldn't suspect anything.
- DS Double meaning or something?

  Ya, double meaning. That kind of thing. You gotta wonder after awhile why is he talking like that all the time. Fine you go your way and I'll go mine.
- PO Did you talk to your sister after we talked to her?

  No. I told her..I called her last week after I talked to you and she said they're coming her at 7 o'clock in the morning, and I said "What." That's the only time mom is available. I told her to go with her and I said cancel it if you want. My sister said she would be more free this week.
- EPO We had a real nice conversation with your sister. Your mother didn't seem think you went to Europe on a steamer.
- DS She thinks you took a boat to Europe.

  Her mind is..
- DS She said you worked your way over on a boat..Icelandic Air Commuter. Did you run out of money before you could get to England?

Ya.

DS She's right about that then?

I took the fairy over there and talked to customs. I said I didn't have enough money to get in there, so I went back.

- EPO Maybe that's where she got the boat idea from.

  Ya, I did take a fairy from Stanton over the English Channel.
- EPO You were dating this woman back when you were 28, 29.
- DS That girl? You were 28, she was 19.
- EPO Did you ever tell her about Europe?

  I don't know. To tell the true, she was not really interested in me, maybe for a short attention span.
- EPO Did she ever talk about the child killings to you?

  I don't think so.
- DS Did she ever strike you as being really odd?
  Ya.
- DS Unbalanced, maybe?

  Ya. There were times I would like to really talk to her but I couldn't because she was consumed in something. She had an old boyfriend that would dwell on her mind all the time.
- EPO Do you seem to gravitate toward this type of person?

  I don't know.
- I know. I thought about that myself, because I met her at the restaurant (that and and I met by a wrong phone number. She called me on the phone and was calling the wrong number and got me. I was laid off and had time to sit and talk to her. So I talked to her. In a way, I think I do kind of gravitate to those people.
- EPO I'm not saying "those people" exactly, but strange people.

  You described them that way yourself.

Ya.

EPO Helen could be described as strange too.

Ya. There's times in my life that are like cycles, I swear.

This is one of those times where I'm gravitating to some people that I shouldn't be. But, there just there. I know some good people in this town that I've met. Some good ones.

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rented me an office over there and he's a good guy.

He'll do anything for you.

sister's husband is a real good guy too.

EPO What does he do?

He's lived here all his life, he worked at the cement plant and he drove a truck after that and had some tendinitis or in his arms and he can't drive anymore. Apparently, he's getting a settlement from one of the trucking companies. I believe he gets SSI too. the kind of guy who will sit down and read a book, while these other people. can't even do that.

- EPO When you were in Europe, did you have any sexual encounters?

  Ya. I met a girl there, a college girl.
- DS An American girl?

  No. She was from Luxenburg and she spoke a little bit of

  English, and it was short, you know.
- DS You seem to have a negative impression of a lot of the people up here because of the way they rely on general assistance, SSI, and that sort of thing.

Ya.
