

1 We began talking to _____ about anything Greg might have said to him over the years, to which
2 _____ stated that Greg wrote he and his brother James a long letter while he was in prison about
3 his life, but stated that they had thrown the letter away after Greg died in 1995. _____ stated that
4 Greg died of a heart attack in prison and that the doctors determined that Greg's heart, even though
5 he was only 45 years old, was like that of an old man. _____ began talking about when Greg was
6 arrested in January of 1977, for the molestations in Flint he (Greg) had been living with their father at
7 _____ t said that he was at the _____ ouse after Greg's arrest and
8 found a hidden room in the crawl space of the attic that Greg had built. _____ told us that when he
9 found it, he knew what Greg built it for and was sick to his stomach over it. We asked _____ t to
10 describe this room to us _____ stated that this room had a hidden door that he found accidentally
11 and stated that the people that reside in the home right now probably do not know it is there.
12 _____ stated that it was a small room behind a wall in the crawl space and stated that it had paneling and
13 carpeting in it _____ t went on to say that the room was big enough for Greg and a boy to stay in.

14 *** We knew from the 1977 police reports; during the interview of the victims of Greg Greene, that
15 one of the victims _____ told the police that he had stayed in a hidden room in the attic of
16 Greg Greene's house where Greene molested him. We asked _____ if Greg ever told him anything
17 about the child killings or his involvement in the killings that might assist us in our investigation, to
18 which _____ stated no. We asked _____ if Greg did ever say anything to him, would he have said
19 something to the police. _____ told us that if Greg ever told him anything like that or if he ever
20 learned any information like that he would have turned him in right away. _____ stated that he is
21 Greg's older brother and was not around the house a _____ hat often and stated that
22 Greg's younger brother _____ that lives in Saginaw was closer to Greg and lived with Greg and
23 their father on Baldwin at that time. _____ stated that he would give his brother _____ our phone
24 numbers and ask him to call us about an interview. *** (See MSP transcripts of this interview for
25 details) ***

26 **3-25-08:** While we were in Flint today, we stopped by the Genesee County Sheriffs Department
27 records section and picked-up a copy of Gregory Greene's fingerprint cards and a photo of Greene
28 from February 1977. These fingerprint cards will be used for a comparison to a partial fingerprint
29 lifted off of Kristine Mihelich's coat from January 1977.

30 **3-26-08: *** (MSP Forensics Lab in Lansing today, with Busch, Greene & Lamborgine's**
31 **fingerprint cards) ***** Garry & I drove up to the MSP lab in Lansing today to give Fingerprint expert,
32 Michelle Glasgow, Busch, Greene & Lamborgines fingerprint cards today to conduct a comparison
33 on the partial latent print from Kristine Mihelich's coat. We spoke with Michelle Glasgow who
34 showed us the partial latent fingerprint. It appeared to be a fairly clear latent print, but Glasgow
35 explained that she may not be able to make an exact identification with our known suspect prints,
36 but the latent is good enough for elimination purposes. Glasgow explained further that she would
37 also be able to determine if the general pattern of our suspects prints match this latent print. She is
38 going to conduct a thorough examination/comparison with our suspect's fingerprints and would
39 contact us afterwards.

40 While we were there, and discussing the case with her and showing her some photographs, she
41 stated that we could use their technical support unit to possibly enhance the photograph from
42 Christopher Busch's bedroom to determine if the shotgun shell that was on the desk, is in fact a 12
43 gauge shell and also if it had contained "#2" shot. This was the caliber and the size of the shot used
44 to shoot our victim, Jill Robinson in the face.

45 *** If the lab were able to determine that the caliber and size of the shot matched what was used on
46 victim Robinson, this would add credence to the theory that Christopher Busch was possibly laying
47 out clues in his room before he shot himself, as sort of a suicide note. Also found in his bedroom
48 was the drawing of the boy (Stebbins) screaming and the ropes/ligatures laying out in the walk-in
49 closet. Busch knew how much the police in 1977 thought of him as a suspect, and possibly thought
50 these would be enough clues for the police to put "two & two" together. It is also possible that there

1 was in-fact a suicide note from Christopher Busch in the bedroom, but the brother
2 who was at the house that day, picked up the note without the officer seeing it. It says in the
3 police report from Bloomfield Twp. PD, when they responded to the call at
4 that entered the home with the officer and also entered the bedroom where
5 his brother Chris was found dead.

6 Michelle Glasgow called back later this afternoon and stated that she talked to her technical
7 support unit about our photograph, and they stated if we were willing, they would ship the 2 photos
8 to NASA to be enhanced, stating that they have "state of the art" equipment. We agreed and Garry
9 authorized them to go ahead and ship them to NASA.

10 **3-26-08:** We received a call today from Mr. Fountain at Michigan Department of Corrections in
11 Lansing, who stated that parole has been officially violated and he has
12 been put on "suspected felon" status. Mr. Fountain told Garry that prior parole date of April
13 15th, 2008, has been suspended until the middle of May 2008. Fountain also stated that will
14 be transferred ASAP to the Ryan facility in Southeast Michigan. This will allow us time to re-
15 interview and polygraph him.

16 **3-27-08: *** (Sent Greene, DNA Buccal swabs to the FBI Lab via Fed-Ex**
17 **today) ***** Garry Gray (MSP) called me today and stated that he shipped Greene & DNA
18 Buccal swab's to the FBI Lab in Quantico, Virginia. The DNA scientist there, Connie Fischer, is
19 going to produce Mitochondrial profiles from these swabs that we have collected and compare them
20 to the DNA from the OCCK victims. DNA Buccal swab obtained from by the
21 Georgia Bureau of Investigation was also sent to Quantico today.

22 **3-27-08:** Garry received a call today from the MSP Forensics Lab in Lansing. They were
23 requesting the negatives of the 2 pictures we left for them to enhance, which will make it easier to
24 enhance and will have better quality. One of these pictures was a picture of a "spent" shotgun shell
25 casing on the desk in Busch's bedroom that was found when he killed himself. We were able to
26 locate the negatives of these pictures and will forward them to the lab.

27 **3-27-08:** I briefed Livonia polygraph examiner Tim Larion today on the upcoming polygraphs he is
28 going to administer on n and I brought Larion "up to speed" on
29 these two subjects, their connection to Busch & Greene and their possible involvement/knowledge of
30 the Oakland County Child Killings.

31 **3-27-08:** I called the records office at the Genesee County Jail today and spoke with Donna Jones
32 about Gregory Greene's inmate status from his arrest in January of 1977, until he was sentenced to
33 prison in June of 1977. The only record that she could find was the jail index card for Greg Greene,
34 file #3515, Case #77-00589. Donna faxed me a copy of this card. The card had typed notes on it
35 that say the following: "2/3/77 2 charges CSC 1st Elliot-CC rel SMP 6/16/77." I asked Donna
36 if their jail was computerized back then, to which she stated no, indicating that the index cards are
37 what they used back then to track inmates. I asked her to explain what the card said. She stated
38 that the 2-3-77 entry, was when he arrived at the jail, then the charges, then where it says Elliott-CC,
39 was the Circuit Court Judge, indicating that Greene was released after his sentencing on 6-17-1977.
40 She stated that it does not appear as if Greene was ever out of the jail between 2-3-77 & 6-17-77
41 and the card shows 141 days credit for time served, sentenced to "Life" in prison by Judge Elliott. I
42 asked Donna if it was possible that Greene was out of the jail at any time or bonded out and it just
43 didn't get put on the card, to which she stated it was possible, indicating that the cards were only as
44 accurate as the people typing the entries on them, but more than likely if he was out or bonded out it
45 would say that on the card. ***** (See copy of this card from Genesee County jail in the Greg**
46 **Greene file) *****

47 **3-27-08: ***** I was reading thru the pre-polygraph interview Cabot conducted with Greg Greene in
48 1977 and noticed that when Cabot asked Greene what type of person he thinks killed the Stebbins
49 boy, Greene answered, "knew the kid & killed him to keep him quiet." Greene then stated, "Or a 1

1 shot deal, somebody who," then stated, "I don't know." Choking a boy to keep him quiet was
2 Greene's M.O. and it's interesting that that was his first response and then almost as if he caught
3 himself and changed directions, eventually stating that he didn't know. When asked what should
4 happen to the person when he is caught, Greene answered, "Completely depends on the person,"
5 another answer that could indicate personal involvement or knowledge.

6 It is also interesting that Greene first mentioned to Cabot that it was someone that knew the kid.
7 Mark Stebbins lived and was abducted in Ferndale, Michigan. During an interview the task force
8 conducted with _____ in 1977, _____ was asked if he had knowledge of any friends of
9 Chris or Greg's in the Detroit area. _____ told the task force that Greg talked about a friend he
10 had in Ferndale and when _____ inquired about this friend, Greene would not answer and told
11 _____ it was personal. It's possible that this friend of Greene's and/or Greene himself was
12 familiar with the Stebbins boy through this friend in Ferndale or from going to this friend's home in
13 Ferndale.

14 **3-27-08:** I began searching through the Oakland County Child killer Task Force tip files today in an
15 attempt to identify this possible associate of Greg Greene that possibly lived in Ferndale. While
16 searching this database, I found several possible suspects called into the task force in the 1970's
17 that lived in Ferndale and a few that lived on Saratoga St., the same street Mark Stebbins lived on.
18 Unknown at this point, if any of these Ferndale suspects were associated with Greene or Busch.
19 While searching this database, I also found that _____ was called in on a tip to the task force in
20 the 70's, but it was not _____ It was _____ at the same address of _____
21 _____ This is possibly the father or brother of _____ This
22 tip was called in by, Berkley Police Officer, Mark Thomas.

23 I performed a check through the Lexis-Nexis database and located _____
24 w/m, born _____, residing at _____ This subject also shows a
25 past address of _____ The age of this subject would indicate that he is
26 more than likely a brother of _____

27 **3-28-08:** I called and left a message today with _____ counselor, Mr. Phillips. I
28 indicated to him that we have _____ scheduled for a polygraph on Wednesday 4-2-08 at 1:00pm.
29 I asked that either he or _____ give me a call and stated that I would pick _____ up at
30 "Operation get Down" at 12:00 noon on Wednesday for the polygraph and have him back by
31 4:00pm. Mr. Phillips called me back a short time later and stated he would have _____ give me a
32 call on my cell-phone.

33 **3-28-08:** We still have not heard from Greg Greene's younger brother _____ who lives in Saginaw.
34 _____ was going to have him call us. I left a message today for _____ on his cell-phone
35 to have _____ call me, indicating that we want to interview _____ next week.

36 **3-31-08:** I went to "Operation Get Down" today after not hearing back from _____ or Mr.
37 Phillips about the polygraph we have scheduled for _____ at Livonia Police Department on
38 Wednesday April 2nd. The clerk at the front desk made a call for me and stated he would be right
39 down. After approximately 10-15 minutes, the clerk called me over and stated that Mr. Phillips
40 signed _____ out to the hospital today to visit his brother. I left my card with my
41 cell-phone number with the clerk to have _____ call me.

42 **3-31-08:** I called _____ home in Saginaw today _____ and the son _____
43 answered the phone. He gave me his dad's number at work _____
44 I spoke with _____ younger brother who was expecting me to call, stating
45 that he had spoken to his brother _____ about us interviewing _____ last week.
46 stated that he was living with Greg and their dad at _____ in 1976-77, but that he
47 didn't remember being around the house very much, stating that he was working in Ann Arbor.
48 _____ told me that his dad was real sick back then, with ulcers _____ mentioned the
49 name _____ but stated he didn't remember a lot of people in the

1 neighborhood back then, stating that he didn't know how much help he would be. I asked him if he
2 remembers a Chris Busch, to which he stated Busch sounds familiar, but he knows some Busch's
3 so he wasn't sure [redacted] agreed to meet us for an interview, Friday April 4th at 11:30am in the
4 Arby's parking lot on M-46, just west of I-75 in Saginaw. I gave him my cell-phone number and
5 Garry's desk number in case he can't make it.

6 **3-31-08:** I went to [redacted] today and spoke with [redacted] and requested a time that
7 we could interview him in length about Christopher Busch & Greg Greene. [redacted] indicated that he
8 knew Greg Greene, [redacted] but stated that he did not
9 remember a Chris Busch. [redacted] stated that these are names he hasn't heard for 25-30 years.
10 [redacted] agreed to an interview on April 1st, 2008 at 12:00 noon at his house.

11 **4-1-08: *** (Tape-recorded interview of [redacted] today in Linden, Michigan.) ***** Garry
12 Gray (MSP) & I went to [redacted] today and interviewed [redacted]
13 lived in Flint in the 1970's and was an associate of Greg Greene,
14 [redacted] stated that he first met Greg Greene while hitchhiking with
15 [redacted] in Flint in the mid 1970's. [redacted] stated that Greene gave them alcohol and marijuana
16 to smoke and would "party" with them. [redacted] admitted being molested by Greene back then,
17 stating he was with Greene approximately 5 different times. [redacted] told us that Greene molested
18 him orally and anally, but that Greene never used any type of force or violence to commit these acts
19 against him. [redacted] also stated that he was never alone with Greene, stating that it was usually
20 Greg, him & [redacted] referring to [redacted] stated that he was fairly close with
21 [redacted] closer than any of the other boys in the neighborhood, including the
22 [redacted] talked about an occasion when he, Greg and [redacted] went to a motel and had sex.

23 [redacted] began talking about [redacted] not really having any friends in the neighborhood and
24 that kids would chase him and beat him up. [redacted] told us that the [redacted] were especially
25 rough on [redacted] stating that [redacted] hated [redacted] stated that he was, friends with
26 [redacted] partly because he felt sorry for him. [redacted] told us that Greg Greene beat [redacted] up real
27 bad one time, stating that he remembers that [redacted] had blood in the whites of his eyes.
28 [redacted] said that he didn't know why Greene did this to [redacted] and that he didn't think [redacted] ever told him
29 why, but he couldn't remember. [redacted] told us that he did not know Chris Busch, didn't recognize
30 Busch from the photos we had, but stated that [redacted] was with Greg Greene all the time
31 [redacted] went on to say that he knew [redacted] and his younger brother [redacted] stating that he also
32 knew their dad [redacted] brother), but did not know Chris Busch ([redacted] uncle).

33 When we told [redacted] what it is that we are investigating, he stated that he never heard anything
34 about hurting or killing any kids and that he never heard [redacted] mention anything like that.
35 We asked [redacted] if Greene ever used him to lure kids to the car, to which he stated, no. We asked
36 [redacted] if he ever heard about [redacted], Greene or any of the other boys in the neighborhood going
37 up north to a cottage with a friend of Greene's (Busch), to which [redacted] stated, no. None of the
38 other information [redacted] supplied investigators about Greg Greene was of immediate assistance to
39 investigators in this investigation. *** (See transcripts from this interview for further details). ***

40 **4-2-08:** I drove by [redacted] house in Berkley this morning, at [redacted]
41 [redacted] There were no cars in the driveway, no cars in front of the house and no cars in
42 the garage, which was standing open. There were no curtains in any of the windows and some type
43 of a "warning" sign was in the front window of the house. It appeared as if it were vacant and
44 possibly condemned.

45 **4-2-08: *** (Polygraphed [redacted] today at Livonia Police Department) ****
46 [redacted] was polygraphed today, by Livonia Polygraph Examiner Tim Larior [redacted] was
47 polygraphed on his possible knowledge of the Oakland County Child Killings and/or his involvement.
48 Garry Gray (MSP) & I were present and witnessed the polygraph c [redacted] Prior to the first

1 polygraph chart, denied any participation in the murders, denied being present when they
2 occurred, or withholding any information on who committed the crimes.

3 The subject was asked the following relevant questions which he answered as indicated:

14 **4-3-08:** Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) took the negatives from the photos taken by
15 Bloomfield Twp. PD at Busch's suicide scene, to the MSP Forensics Lab in Lansing today. They are
16 going to have the negative enhanced/enlarged and they are also going to try to identify the markings
17 on the single, spent, shotgun shell casing on Busch's desk.

18 They also went to the MSP long-term evidence storage facility today to locate & remove the
19 "wadding" & "pellets" from the Jill Robinson homicide for comparison.

20 **4-4-08: *** (Tape-recorded Interview of _____ Greg Greene's brother in Saginaw) *****
21 Garry Gray (MSP) & I met and interviewed _____ today in Saginaw _____ had agreed
22 previously to meet with us and discuss his brother Greg's possible involvement in the Oakland
23 County Child Killing case _____ told us that he remembers his brother coming back from California
24 to Flint in the mid 70's and that he (Greg) was really different when he got back _____ stated that
25 he remembers telling his dad that something is wrong with Greg since he returned _____ told us
26 that he had talked to his brother _____ about us interviewing him and stated that he didn't know
27 what else he could tell us that his brother _____ didn't already say _____ stated that he lived at
28 the house at _____ with his dad and Greg when Greg got back from California.
29 _____ is said that Greg got a job working with his uncle doing deliveries of appliances in Flint after he
30 returned to Michigan. _____ stated that he was working a job selling shoes in Ann Arbor after Greg
31 returned, stating that he wasn't around the house in Flint very often _____ told us that he was
32 aware of Greg's problem with Pedophilia, stating that he didn't realize what was wrong with his
33 brother (Pedophilia) until after Greg was arrested for child molestation and went to prison.
34 _____ talked to us about the "hidden room" that Greg had in the attic of the house on
35 stating that he found out later that Greg had a boy stay in that room that he (Greg) was molesting.
36 _____ kept mentioning a boy named _____ asking if we heard of him, stating
37 that he was with Greg a lot in the 70's before Greg was arrested.

38 We asked _____ about vehicles that Greg was driving back then. _____ told us that he
39 remembers Greg driving a van and could never figure out why his brother would want to drive a van,
40 until Greg was arrested and charged with child molestation and then he understood why Greg had
41 the van. _____ stated that it was a tan or brown colored van.

42 _____ told us that Greg wrote a long letter while he was in prison about his problem of Pedophilia,
43 out-lining why he thinks it started. _____ told us that Greg stated in the letter that he thinks his
44 pedophilia started when he was about 12 or 13 years old and some kids made fun of his penis while

1 in the shower after gym class. explained that Greg stated that his penis was never
2 circumcised and that's why the kids teased him. said that it was as if Greg were saying he
3 was searching for the perfect penis said that there was nothing in the letters about hurting
4 or killing any kids, but he (James) remembers that a boy got hurt jumping from Greg's moving car in
5 California trying to get away from Greg. went on to say that Greg then took the boy to the
6 hospital and that's how he got caught. We told that what actually happened was that Greg
7 choked the boy to keep him quiet and almost choked him to death and that's when Greg panicked
8 and took the boy to the hospital and got caught. stated that he never heard that before,
9 stating that his brother Greg was always lying about things and twisting things around in his favor.
10 said that he believes his brother had the box of belongings they received of Greg's
11 from prison after he died. stated that he didn't think that still has any of Greg's things.
12 did not supply any other information that would assist immediately in this investigation. The
13 interview was terminated. *** (See transcripts from this interview for further details) ***

14 *** The story relayed about his brother Greg getting into Pedophilia because he was teased
15 about his penis & in search of the perfect penis, matches what told the police in the 1977
16 MSP report when he stated that Greg approached him about kidnapping and killing a boy, stating
17 further that he (Greg) would then cut-off the boys penis and put it in a box for

18 4-4-08: Garry & I stopped by place of employment today at Coldwater Rd. & Saginaw
19 Rd. in Flint to make sure is all set for the polygraph on 4-7-08 was not real happy to
20 see Detectives. We told him that the State Police from the Flint Post would pick him up at his house
21 on Monday at 11:30am to bring him to the Northville post for his polygraph. stated reluctantly
22 that he would be ready at 11:30am Monday to be picked up.

23 4-7-08: We heard from Agent Tommy MacDonald, New York FBI today about the lead we sent him
24 on Christopher Busch. MacDonald stated that he made phone contact with Chris's Busch's brother,
25 who is currently in South Carolina on vacation. MacDonald stated that
26 lives in Connecticut and keeps the apartment in Manhattan for weekend visits. MacDonald stated
27 that appeared cooperative and agreed to call MacDonald at the FBI in New York for
28 an interview when he returns home in Late April or early May.

29 4-7-08: Garry called the Ryan Correctional facility and made arrangements for us to interview
30 in the morning on Wednesday 4-9-08. This is the prison we had transferred
31 to from Ojibway Correctional in Ironwood, Michigan.

32 4-7-08: *** (Polygraphed: today at the MSP 2nd District Headquarters) *** The
33 State Police from the Flint Post brought down to the Northville Post today for his polygraph. Lt.
34 Robert Dykstra from MSP is the Polygraph Examiner that conducted the test. Prior to the test, Lt.
35 Dykstra went through a pre-polygraph interview with to assist him (Dykstra) in formulating the
36 questions for the polygraph. During this interview Dykstra asked if it were true that when he
37 was cellmates with Greg Greene in prison in the mid 1990's, Greene told him he had gotten away
38 with killing four kids, to which answered, "No." Dykstra told he was confused, indicating
39 that Detectives Williams & Gray, that interviewed you a few weeks-ago, told him (Dykstra) that you
40 said Greene told you he killed four kids stated that he never said that and never told the
41 police that.

3 To which _____ stated, " in the
4 1970's." _____ told Lt. Dykstra that he lied on the polygraph because he was scared about getting
5 involved and getting hurt. When asked, _____ stated that when he told Detectives Williams & Gray
6 about what Greene had told him in prison about killing those kids during the interview a few weeks
7 earlier, he had told them the truth.

8 **4-9-08: *** Greg Greene's fingerprint ruled-out after being compared to the partial print from**
9 **Kristine's parka. ***** Garry Gray (MSP) received an e-mail today from Michelle Glasgow, the
10 fingerprint expert at the Michigan State Police Forensics Lab. She stated that the latent print from
11 Kristine Mihelich's parka needs a lot of work and she is going to look into digital enhancement
12 technology to see if there is any, new developments that she might be able to use. Michelle did say
13 that she can rule out Greg Greene based on the fingerprint pattern, stating further that the other two
14 we submitted (Lamborgine & Busch) she can't say either way without more clarity and is working on
15 that.

16 **4-9-08:** Garry Gray has been in contact with Reinhard Pope, an expert from the State Police
17 Forensics Lab, who is looking into enhancing the photos from the Busch suicide scene for us.
18 Reinhard is going to be looking at the photos and negatives today for us and we will be sending him
19 a copy of the old lab report on the "wadding" & "pellets" from the shotgun shell and gun that killed Jill
20 Robinson.

21 **4-9-08: *** (We went to Ryan Correctional today and interviewed**
22 Garry Gray (MSP) & I went to Ryan Correctional today and interviewed _____ about why
23 we believe he lied to us about knowing Greg Greene. _____ was upset when we got there about us
24 having him transferred to Ryan Correctional and holding up his parole. We explained why this was
25 done, the importance of the investigation and what it is we wanted from _____ prior to him being
26 paroled. We explained that because he associated with Busch & Greene at the time of the Oakland
27 County Child Killings, we want to make sure he didn't have information about the killings that he was
28 holding back or repressing in his memory. We explained to _____ that Busch & Greene are our main
29 two suspects, that he _____ was just a kid at the time and that we, at this point have no intention of
30 charging him with anything, we simply want to clear him of possibly having knowledge of the case
31 from Busch & Greene. _____ indicated that he wanted to talk to his sister in Montana first and also a
32 lawyer. We asked _____ if he would be willing to consent to a saliva swab for DNA, to which he
33 stated that he didn't want to do that either until he made some phone calls. We told _____ to call
34 whoever he wanted to and if there is an attorney that had questions, he (the attorney) could call
35 either myself or Garry and we would explain that we are simply attempting to clear him of having
36 possible involvement or knowledge in the child killings. We also explained to _____ the 4 questions
37 that would be on the polygraph test and asked him how he would do on those questions, to which he
38 stated he would pass, no problem. We terminated the interview at this point and told _____ to let us
39 about taking the polygraph as soon as he can.

40 **4-10-08:** I had received several calls from _____'s sister, _____ from Montana in the
41 past few days, in regards to Vince's parole getting delayed because of our investigation. I called her
42 back today and explained the situation to her and that we are simply looking to clear _____ on any
43 possibility that he might have information because of his association to Busch & Greene during the
44 time of our homicides. She said that she understood what we are trying to accomplish, she has
45 concerns about her brother's rights and wanted to talk to a lawyer for him before he decides on
46 taking the polygraph. _____ is supposed to parole to his sisters home in Montana when we are
47 through with him. She took my cell-phone number and stated she was going to talk to _____ and an
48 attorney about all of this and call me back.

49 **4-14-08:** Garry Gray (MSP) sent me a copy of an e-mail today that he sent to Mr. Fountain at

MacDonald and Barbara A. Daly. [redacted] was advised of the identity of the interviewing Agents and that the interview pertained to a Michigan cold-case matter known as the "Oakland County Child Killing" investigation in which his brother, CHRIS BUSCH (hereinafter "CHRIS"), was a potential suspect. [redacted] provided the following information:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Busch family consisted of four children, all boys. [redacted] and [redacted] were both older than [redacted], and CHRIS was seven years younger. The family moved around quite frequently when the boys were young as [redacted] father was an executive with General Motors. [redacted] is the only living member from his immediate family.

[redacted] who [redacted] described as a homosexual and "sort of an activist", died of leukemia in England where he had lived for several years. [redacted] had no children.

[redacted] died approximately five years ago in Michigan of congestive heart failure and diabetes. [redacted] advised that [redacted] had struggled in his life with alcoholism but had stopped drinking at the time of his death. [redacted] has two children who are alive today, both living in Michigan. [redacted] is [redacted] adopted son, and he is currently believed to reside at [redacted].

[redacted] is [redacted] biological son and is believed to reside at [redacted].

[redacted] has a daughter named [redacted] and according to [redacted] mother is E. [redacted] and [redacted] are no longer together but remain friendly. [redacted] stated that it was "a little dysfunctional", but that [redacted] is now involved with [redacted] and [redacted] lives with the two of them. [redacted] advised that both of [redacted] children and [redacted] have struggled with substance abuse and have in the past been in trouble with the law. [redacted] advised that his contact with them is mostly telephonic, and on a monthly basis.

advised that CHRIS was born in Pontiac, Michigan and prior to the age of ten had lived in Rochester, New York, Short Hills, New Jersey and Germany (in that order). These were all family moves pertaining to their father's career at General Motors. By age ten CHRIS was living in Germany and attending the first grade. While their family was settled in Germany, both and CHRIS attended a grade school and high school at a boarding school in Switzerland called Le Rosey. After his graduation from Le Rosey (completion of the twelfth grade) CHRIS stayed at Le Rosey as an instructor. CHRIS then returned to the United States and attended Wayne State University in Detroit for one year. CHRIS then transferred to a Culinary Institute in Midland, Michigan from which he eventually graduated. After this, CHRIS worked as a chef at a retirement community in the Detroit area for approximately one year. After this CHRIS, with the financial assistance of his father, opened his own restaurant in Alma, Michigan called "The Scotsman". During the time period CHRIS was operating this restaurant, which advised was in CHRIS' mid to late twenties, CHRIS was arrested for molesting a boy in Birmingham, Michigan. This boy (the complainant or victim in the molestation case) had been mentored by CHRIS in the Big Brother Program, a program CHRIS had become involved in. believes that CHRIS also knew this boy's mother, and that she possibly worked as a cashier at the Fishers Meat Market in Birmingham, Michigan. 78-78

advised that after CHRIS was indicted for this molestation case (mentioned above) he moved back in with his parents in Bloomfield Hills, Michigan. This was primarily due to the fact that his attorneys and psychiatrists were nearby. It was during this time that CHRIS committed suicide.

described CHRIS overall as a "gregarious and happy guy", who physically was "big and heavy". provided the following as hobbies for CHRIS: food, skiing and riding his motorcycle. advised that CHRIS also struggled with problems associated with living overseas and returning to America, stating "it is hard to go back to your own country".

advised that he had no recollection of CHRIS taking art classes, or of being particularly interested in drawing as a hobby. Both CHRIS and took art classes at boarding school as part of the normal curriculum.

had no recollection of CHRIS being involved in hunting, and advised that hunting was not something their father did or introduced to his sons. had no knowledge of how or where CHRIS obtained the shotgun that was found in the bedroom where CHRIS killed himself, or of any ammunition he collected.

THE SUICIDE OF CHRIS BUSCH

advised that he was present when CHRIS' body was found after he had killed himself. stated that this was a very traumatic experience and he admittedly has blocked some of this experience from his memory.

recalled that at the time of his suicide CHRIS was living at his parents residence in Bloomfield Hills (as mentioned above). This was an "affluent" neighborhood, and the Busch house was located on Morning View Drive. At the time of his suicide CHRIS was staying at this house by himself as their parents had traveled to England to visit older brother with whom they had a "falling out". advised that this "falling out" had to do with being both a homosexual and "a little bit of an activist".

recalled that on the day CHRIS' body was found he had received a phone call from the maid, named , who was at the house and could not gain entrance. was nervous that something was wrong and the dogs inside of the house were barking. went to the neighbors (across the street) who phoned could not recall the name of the neighbor that went to, but described them as a Caucasian couple, with a daughter, who were good friends with his parents. then phoned the police and left work to go to the house. At the house, met up with the police and after entering they found CHRIS' body upstairs in the bedroom CHRIS was staying in recalled that when they opened the door to CHRIS' bedroom he could see CHRIS' body, which was lying on the bed. recalled a terrible smell and remembered seeing a shotgun and remnants that CHRIS had been drinking. also recalls seeing a painting of a tiger over a chest that had "bullet holes in it". does not recall seeing anything else in CHRIS' room, to include any drawings, ropes or ligatures. did not recall there being any suicide note as well and has no recollection of the police ever mentioning this to him. advised that he "did not look" at the room or CHRIS' body for very long as he was very traumatized. IS further advised that any items or belongings that were in the room where CHRIS killed himself belonged to CHRIS.

In regards to why CHRIS would kill himself, _____ advised that he believes it was due to other molestation charges that were about to be filed against CHRIS. _____ seemed to recall a pending case which originated in the Lake Ess area. When asked if CHRIS could have been bipolar, _____ advised that he never noticed any signs of depression or mood swings from CHRIS, and that he always seemed "easygoing", qualified this by advising that he was seven years older than CHRIS and had his own life - with a job, wife and five year old son. CHARLES further advised that after the molestation charge(s) surfaced against CHRIS he and his wife kept their distance from CHRIS. CHRIS was "shielded" by his parents and their relationship (between _____ and CHRIS) became more "superficial".

_____ advised that CHRIS' attorney at the time of his suicide was Keith Stark who is likely still alive.

ASSOCIATES AND VEHICLES FOR CHRIS BUSCH

_____ advised that in terms of friends for CHRIS he only recalled that he "hung out" with co-workers of his at his restaurant. _____ did not recall CHRIS being involved in any social organizations, with the exception of the Big Brother program. _____ recalled that _____ did have one friend from boarding school in Switzerland. _____ could not recall the name of this friend, but described him as being from Middle Eastern descent, and as residing in the state of Michigan for a period of time.

_____ did not recall the name "Greg Greene", nor did he recall CHRIS associating someone by this name.

CHARLES advised that he vaguely recalled a maid who worked at his parent's house named _____ described "Christine" as a black female, and stated that CHRIS was likely friendly with her "given his personality".

Regarding female associates or "girlfriends" for CHRIS, _____ advised that he only recalled CHRIS having one girlfriend from boarding school in Switzerland who he brought back to the United States. _____ could not recall this woman's name, and advised that she returned to Europe after she and CHRIS broke up. _____ could recall no other women who were associates, or involved with, CHRIS.

_____ advised that CHRIS did visit the house on Ess Lake, and was likely to visit it more when he was living in Midland, Michigan (which was _____ CHRIS used to enjoy waterskiing and fishing at Ess Lake. _____ advised that CHRIS was more likely to go to the Ess Lake house with his brother John, who lived in Flint, Michigan at the time.

_____ advised that he and his wife used to visit the Ess Lake house often. _____ stated that he and his wife "outfitted" this house, and would "weekend there" when his parents were overseas.

_____ advised that CHRIS had a house in Alma, Michigan which was the same town his restaurant was located. _____ advised that he never visited this house, and only could recall visiting CHRIS' restaurant on one occasion.

Regarding a residence in Sanford, Michigan, _____ advised that he had no recall of such a place but that it was likely that this was where CHRIS stayed while at Culinary School in Midland, Michigan.

_____ did recall he and his wife visiting CHRIS one time when he was living in Midland. This was the only time he recalled socializing with CHRIS during this period.

Regarding a residence in Whitehall, Michigan, _____ advised that his brother _____ moved from Flint to Whitehall where he opened and operated a convenience store.

PETS ASSOCIATED WITH CHRIS BUSCH

_____ advised that his parents had a Welsh Terrier with white hair, named "Tabatha", that was at their house at the time of CHRIS' suicide.

_____ advised that other than when the molestation charge surfaced he had no knowledge of any lifestyle CHRIS had with young boys.

_____ advised that he was "concerned" when CHRIS was charged with molesting a boy. _____ stated that it "seemed like it happened" and he and his wife were scared for their own son. After these charges surfaced, _____ and his wife had their son see a psychologist and never allowed their son to be alone with CHRIS.

_____ advised that after CHRIS was charged his brother mentioned to him that he believed CHRIS had molested his own two sons because his sons had informed him of this. _____ stated that _____ knew this never talked to him about molesting children or about him having fantasies of molesting children.

_____ advised that he had no knowledge of CHRIS ever being molested as a child, but that you "just think of boarding school" and think that it could have happened. _____ had no knowledge of any molestation which took place within his immediate family, or by anyone associated with he and his siblings in their earlier years (ie, family member, teacher or coach).

CHRIS BUSCH AND THE OAKLAND COUNTY CHILD KILLING CASE

_____ advised that he is familiar with the Oakland County Child Killing case, and is aware that at one time CHRIS was viewed as a suspect. _____ stated that Timothy King, one of the victims, was from Birmingham, Michigan and disappeared from a supermarket that was

_____ had no recollection of CHRIS ever being administered a polygraph in regards to the Oakland County Child Killing case. When asked if CHRIS ever talked to him about this case or his position as a suspect, _____ replied "absolutely not". _____ was asked if CHRIS was capable of these killings and he replied "that he did not think it was in his nature".

MISCELLANEOUS

_____ advised that he graduated from the University of Michigan, _____ is currently retired from the General Motors, Chrysler LLC. _____ and his wife, _____ currently reside in the Chapel Hill, North Carolina area, which is near where their only child, a son, resides with his wife. [Note: This residence is known as _____

_____ advised that his father worked as the controller of the Cadillac Division of General Motors. _____ is an artist, and was employed as an advertising executive during the mid 1970s when CHRIS committed suicide.
