

On 3-24-08 I referred this file to the Parole Board and they amended his parole date to 5-13-08 to allow additional time for your investigation and to allow the transfer to Ryan Correctional Facility. I also contacted the Department's Classification Director who advised he could have the prisoner moved to Ryan.

I was just notified by the Record Office at Ojibway today that they have entered a Felony Suspect detainer on the MDOC database and that the prisoner is being moved to Ryan. As a result of the Felony Suspect detainer, I'll be referring this back to the Board for a possible suspend of his parole.

Per our conversation earlier, please consider the following request to have inmate Gunnels transferred to either the Mound or Ryan Facility in the city of Detroit, regarding additional investigation/interviews into the case involving the Oakland County Child Killer case.

Several weeks ago, D/Sgt. Williams and I traveled to Camp Ojibway to interview Mr. Gunnels regarding his knowledge of a key suspect in the Child Killer Case. Recently we've learned that Mr. Gunnels has been less that honest and we would like to interview him further and confront him with our new information.

Unfortunately Mr. Gunnels is coming up for parole on April 15, 2008, and he is requesting movement to the State of Montana. This causes us great concern because of the inability to further investigate Gunnels or proceed in our investigation. Presently I have scheduled Mr. Gunnels to take a polygraph test on May 7th at 1:00 PM. If Mr. Gunnels is transferred to the Detroit area, I'll request that an earlier polygraph date possibly be set to expedite his getting paroled.

It is very important that we confront Mr. Gunnels again to gain the much needed information we feel he may still possess.

Regarding prisoner Vince Gunnels. Last week Detective Williams and I made contact with Mr. Gunnels at the Ryan Facility and interviewed him, (or shall I say, attempted to interview him). At the beginning of the interview, Mr. Gunnels was less that respectful and told us in no uncertain terms, that he wanted nothing further to do with us. After explaining to him that all he had to do was then listen, we told him that after our earlier interview up at camp Ojibway, we found that he was less than completely honest with us and we just needed to clear up a few details.

Mr. Gunnels advised that prior to cooperating with us any further, he must first seek the advice of an attorney. Mr. Gunnels was again advised of the seriousness of this investigation, (homicide of 4 children back in the mid 70's), and we wanted, (hopefully) to clear him of any possible involvement, and or knowledge. Mr. Gunnels advised that after he consults with an attorney, he will get back with us. So I guess we're sort of on his time-table now as to when he wants to get back with us.

Please advise if MDOC plans on paroling Mr. Gunnels prior to the completion of our investigation of him, so we can make further arrangements if need be.

Thank You very much for your cooperation in this matter.

I would also like to commend the staff at the Ryan Facility as well as the entire corrections system in general. Every time I've needed to do followup at a prison, whether it be Camp Ojibway and Inspector Don Majurin (sp), the Macomb Facility, with Inspector Wanda Moore or Jackson's Inspector Cindy Aker, I've been met with nothing but the utmost in professionalism, respect and complete cooperation. I always look forward to doing work with the Michigan Department of Corrections because of people like these.

Per our earlier conversation regarding inmate Gunnels, (currently at the Mound Facility).

Mr. Gunnels was transferred from Camp Ojibway last winter when we learned he wasn't 100% honest with us regarding a cold case homicide we are currently investigating. (We flew up to the U.P. to interview him, which was very costly), thus we had him transferred to Detroit for additional interviews.

Approximately 3 weeks ago, special agents John Ouellet and Sean Callaghan of the FBI spoke with Mr. Gunnels regarding a polygraph examination to clear himself of possible involvement/knowledge. Mr. Gunnels agreed with the Feds to take the polygraph, however he won't do anything without his sisters advice. She currently resides in Montana.

I scheduled Mr. Gunnels to take a polygraph test this Friday, 10-10-08 at 10 AM, of course if he's willing to cooperate.

As soon as Mr. Gunnels takes the polygraph, he can be released immediately. He is a person of interest that we'd like to clear, before he is paroled and goes to Montana.

If one of the inspectors from the Mound Facility can call me, maybe we can get this matter cleared up and get Mr. Gunnels paroled.
