Chevrolet, Mi. connected to Greene. The only other information on this tip-sheet showed that Greene was cleared on tip# 370, by polygraph in the Stebbins case.

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Tip #14753, was written up by a task force member from Southfield PD (Detective Lourn Doan) on 2-13-1978. This tip showed the same address for Greene and the brown Chevrolet vehicle, both on Baldwin St. in Flint, but indicated that it is a Chevy van. There is also a note that Greene was in Jackson Prison at the time this tip was submitted by Doan in 1978. It shows Christopher Busch listed as his associate, but does not state how they know each other. Doan wrote the following handwritten notes in the details section on the front of this tip sheet on Greene: "Subject Previously investigated for Stebbins & Mihalic tip#369. Subject cleared by polygraph. Subject matches last composite & fits profile given by crime historian. Was sent to Jackson Prison on 6-17-1977. Out on Bond till then. Arrest Flint PD, CSC 1. California arrested him for 50 counts of CSC 1st Degree and put him in a mental institution for a short time and released him. He then came back to Michigan." The notes they say "drove Blue," then nothing after that. The notes then say on 2-14-78, officer's contacted subjects Probation Officer Dave Witter of the Genesee County Probation Department who stated that Greene was in the County Jail from the time he was arrested for CSC 1, January 26th, 1977, till he was sent to Jackson Prison. This was confirmed with the PD, the notes say, (Cleared). Detective Doan from Southfield was the Detective that requested the MSP polygraphs of Busch and Greene, during the Stebbins, Mihalic case. Both passed the polygraph at that time and were cleared, so it does not appear they were polygraphed again in the King case, or would it have been necessary. Greene was arrested prior to the King disappearance and it appears as if he was still in custody (not confirmed yet) during the disappearance. Busch was also arrested prior to the King disappearance. Busch, on the other hand, was arrested on 1-28-77,2-28-77,3-3-77 & 3-4-77, all of which appear to be multiple CSC 3rd Degree cases in different counties in Michigan. Due to the fact they were CSC 3rd Degree cases and that he had an attorney (Possibly Jane Burgess) at that time he may have possibly been out on bond at the time of the King murder. (Later it was confirmed to having been out on bond during the King abduction/murder).

11-28-07: I ran a CCH (criminal history) on Gregory Greene, which showed an arrest 2-26-1969 in Flint for Burglary, an arrest 5-25-1969 in Flint for Family Offenses, an arrest 1-2-1970 in Flint for Obstructing Police & 1-25-1977 in Flint for Sexual Assault. This last arrest in Flint in 1977, was the case Greene went to Jackson Prison for life after being found guilty for CSC 1st Degree. Prior to this CSC 1st Degree case, it appears Greene left Michigan in 1970 and went to California where he was arrested 9-13-1970, in Huntington Beach California for Possession of Marijuana. Greene had numerous arrests in California over the next 5 years that include arrests for: Burglary, Forgery, Kidnapping, False Imprisonment, Narcotics, Stolen Property and multiple Sexual Offenses. On 1-31-1975, Greene was convicted in California on multiple CSC 1st Degree cases and sentenced to the Patton State Mental Hospital as a disturbed sexual offender. Documents show, Greene was released from this hospital on 7-21-1975 and he made his way back to Michigan. He told MSP Polygraph Examiner Cabot that he arrived in Flint Michigan on 2-14-1976. This is a day prior to Stebbins being abducted. Nowhere so far, in any of this documentation have I found the connection between Busch and Greene, or how they knew or met each other. They are simply listed as associates of one another, so far.

11-29-07: I performed a check today thru Oakland County Government, on-line database for Christopher Busch, and located his Circuit Court file from 1977, archived. This response showed court docket # 1977-032312-FY.

11-29-07: On my way home tonight, Larry Wasser called me wanting to know if we could get together on Friday (The following day) to look at the polygraph files from Examiner Cabot at MSP. I told Wasser that we still needed to gather any polygraph files Cabot might have conducted at the Northville post in regards to the child killings. Wasser told me that he didn't think that was necessary because he was fairly certain, the polygraph test had been conducted, by Cabot in Flint. I told Wasser, "c'mon Larry, you temember the name of the dead attorney (Jane Burgess) that

represented this guy, you remember the name of the examiner and where the MSP exam took place, you remember that you polygraphed him at the height of the investigation on CSC charges and you know the subject is now deceased, but you don't know his name? Wasser responded with the fact that he doesn't remember the name. I asked Wasser if he remembers approximately when this subject died, to which Wasser paused then stated that, he died not too long after I had polygraphed him, stating further that the guy killed himself. This matches Christopher Busch, who Cabot polygraphed in January of 1977 on CSC charges out of the 6th Circuit in Pontiac, and committed suicide in 1978. (I am still trying to confirm that Jane Burgess was Christopher Busch's Attorney). I asked how he knows that the subject committed suicide in 1978. Wasser told me that he was discussing Christopher Busch with Burgess, after he had polygraphed him, wondering (Wasser was) what happened to the guy, and Jane Burgess told Wasser that he didn't have to worry about it, because the guy killed himself. Arrangements were made to meet with Wasser at the MSP Metro North Post the following day, Friday 11-30-07 @ 1:30pm.

11-30-07: *** (Interviewed private polygraph examiner Larry Wasser today) *** Garry & I interviewed Larry Wasser today in regards to his information about a person that was polygraphed by MSP Examiner Cabot & by Wasser in 1977. We interviewed Wasser at the MSP Metro North Post in Oak Park. Dave Robertson (MSP) video tape-recorded this interview. During the interview, we showed Wasser, Cabot's polygraph file that contained the MSP polygraphs of Busch & Greene in 1977, in regards to the Stebbins abduction/murder. Wasser looked at the two names (Busch & Greene) but did not recognize either one. When Wasser began to read the report Cabot wrote on Christopher Busch's polygraph, Wasser stated that this looks familiar to him. Wasser was talking about the statement from Busch that he had been in England in February of 1977. Wasser also recognized some of Cabot's notes, when Busch was talking about his parents living in Birmingham and him going to a place in northern Michigan at that time. Wasser was also familiar with the fact that he remembers that, this person committed suicide in 1978. Wasser stated that he cannot remember the name, but this Busch subject sounds like the guy, based on what we were showing nim. It appears that Wasser was trying to point us in the right direction, without actually identifying the suspect himself, or supplying investigators with the information, to protect himself from the possibility of being sued by the suspect's family. See MSP's report and tape for further details.

11-30-07: Christopher Busch's Criminal History showed that he was charged in Oakland County Circuit Court, with CSC 3rd Degree, in February of 1977. I performed an on-line checked of the Oakland County Court database for Christopher Busch, and located his court docket # from his case in 1977. The case was heard in front of Judge McDonald of the 6th Circuit Court.

12-06-07: I called the Oakland County Prosecutors Office records section today and ordered a copy of the Circuit Court file on Christopher Busch, faxed to me at LPD. This file is the CSC 3rd Degree case he was arrested for, by MSP on 2-28-1977. This case was adjudicated in the 6th Circuit Court, in front of Judge McDonald on 7-29-1977. The Criminal History on this case shows that he was found guilty and received 2 years probation. This is 6th Circuit Court docket # 1977-032312-FY.

12-06-07: I called the Montmorency County Sheriff's Dept. today and requested a copy of their entire file on Christopher Busch. His Criminal History shows they arrested him on 3-3-1977 for sexual assault. This may also be the county he was in when he committed suicide. I requested any and all paperwork they could find on Busch to be faxed to me at LPD.

12-06-07: I received a packet of faxed information today from Montmorency County Sheriff's Dept. regarding Christopher Busch. The Dispatcher that faxed it to me (Amanda), called me and stated that she checked the basement at their department, but could only locate the "booking packet" on Busch. In this packet was a "Jail Inmate Record" that showed that Busch was arrested by their agency on 3-3-1977 for 1st Degree Criminal Sexual Conduct. It showed that the crime took place in Atlanta, Michigan. Busch gave the following information to the "booking" Officer: Christopher Brian Busch, w/m, born, in Pontiac, Michigan, with a current address at

This also shows that Busch is the manager of a restaurant in Alma called the "Scotsman," which is located at 315 E. Superior St. Alma, Michigan. This matches what Busch told Polygraph Examiner Cabot (MSP) in January 1977 during the pre-polygraph interview of Busch. During that interview with Cabot, 2 months earlier, when Busch was polygraphed about Stebbins, Busch told Cabot that he had an associate's degree from Northwood Institute in hotel restaurant management and currently managed the "Scotsman" restaurant in Alma, Michigan.

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This packet of documents from Montmorency County Sheriff's, indicate that Busch was arrested 3-3-1977, case # 0695-77 and that he was issued Montmorency County inmate # M-00027. It shows that Busch had two previous arrests in Ithica County & Genesee County, Michigan. This matches his CCH that shows 4 arrests for Criminal Sexual Conduct between January 1977 & March of 1977, in 4 different counties.

It appears that Busch was arraigned the following day, March 4th 1977 in the 88th District Court, Atlanta, Michigan, in front of a magistrate, on 1st Degree CSC, who set a \$10,000.00 bond. Paperwork in this packet indicates that Busch was released on March 4th, 1977, after his arraignment. **His father, H. Lee Busch posted a cash bond for Christopher's release.**

**** (Found the supplemental report on Busch being at Ess Lake with two minors, March 19th, 1977. Tim King was missing at this time) *** While I was going thru this information from Montmorency County, I found a supplemental report written by a Sheriff's Department employee, named Charlotte Pelham, on March 24th 1977. In this report, Pelham writes that she received an anonymous phone call at the sheriff's dept. on March 19th, 1977. A woman caller (middle-aged) was asking to speak to a person that I determined later was a detective at that time in Montmorency named Junior Brandenburg. Pelham told this woman she would take a message. The woman caller stated, "No, by then it would be too late and that she had to talk to Junior. Pelham indicated that anything she told her would be kept confidential at which time, the woman spoke with someone in the background and agreed to give Pelham the information. The woman said they did not want to get involved and would not leave her name or number. This woman caller then told Pelham that Christopher Busch was in town with two minors. Pelham asked the woman where she had seen them? The caller spoke to someone in the background again and said that she could not tell Pelham that. Pelham told the caller how important this would be to enable the Sheriff's Dept. to find him. Pelham could here the caller talking to the person in the background, saying, "Why did you have me call them at all, if I can't tell them enough to help them?" She then told Pelham in an angry voice, "I am sorry I can't tell you more, but I would if I could!" Pelham then told the caller that if she changed her mind, to call right away. The woman caller then said, "All I can say is go to his place on Ess Lake and just please check it out!" Pelham stated that the woman seemed sober and was very serious about what she had just told Pelham. *** See this supplemental report in Busch file for details. ***

The day this call was received by Montmorency County Sheriff's, Timothy King was still missing. There was no indication in this report, or the file they faxed me on Busch, whether or not anyone followed up on this call or went to Ess Lake to check on this. It appears Busch was out on bond at this time. Timothy King was taken from Maple Rd (15 Mile) near Woodward Ave. on March 16th, 1977 and found in Livonia on March 22, 1977. Busch's parents lived on Morningview Terrace, near Maple Rd. (15 Mile & Cranbrook) at that time, just 2 miles from where King was abducted.

I also found a newspaper obituary in this packet from Montmorency County Sheriff's, about Christopher Busch's death and the funeral arrangements. This obituary stated that Christopher Brian Busch, died November 19th, 1978. It said that he was the son of Mr. & Mrs. Harold Lee Busch, brother of John S., David L. & Charles N. Busch. The funeral was at The Bell Chapel of the William Hamilton Funeral home on Maple Rd. in Birmingham, Michigan.

There were 2 Circuit Court Probation orders contained in this packet of info about Christopher Busch. The first one was signed by Judge David Dewitt, from Midland County in reference to Busch's arrest there on 3-4-77 for CSC 3rd Degree. Busch received 3 years probation, fines & costs. The second order was from Judge Phillip Glennie from Montmorency County, reference to Busch's arrest on 3-3-77 for CSC 1st Degree. It appears that this charge was reduced to a CSC 3rd Degree and Busch received 3 years probation. This judge added a seventh condition to Busch's probation order which included him not be able to associate with any individuals under the age of 16. This order was signed September 8, 1978. Busch committed suicide November 1978.

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**** It is interesting that when Busch & Greene were brought in to be polygraphed by MSP on Stebbins, during the pre-polygraph interview, they both independently tell Cabot that they don't really remember all the details of what they did or where they went after arriving back in Michigan, but they both state they arrived in Michigan February 14th, 1976. The newspapers had originally reported Stebbins was abducted on February 13th, 1976, but later corrected the date to February 15th, 1976. Busch told Cabot that he arrived back in Detroit from a trip to England, Feb. 14th, 1976. He said that he thinks he may have stayed a day or two at his parents in Birmingham, before going up north to Hillman or Sanford. Hillman is where the cottage is on Ess Lake in Montmorency County. Greene told Cabot that he was released from the mental institution in California in January of 1976 and arrived back in Flint, Michigan on February 14th, 1976. It appears as if they may have been trying to get there story straight for their alibi on when they both arrived in Michigan, but might have screwed it up because the media reported the abduction of Stebbins on the wrong date. They are listed in the original tips as associates, they told Cabot they are associates, they were polygraphed together, but I have not made the connection yet and there is nothing that indicates anywhere, how they knew each other or met each other. Both Busch & Greene both told Cabot that they arrived in Michigan 2-14-1976, even though one supposedly came from California after 5 years and the other had arrived after being in England.

Also during this interview, Busch admitted to Cabot that he has a sexual problem that he is not proud of and when Cabot asked him if he knew why he was there that day to be polygraphed by MSP, Busch indicated that it was to determine whether or not he picked up that boy from Ferndale and killed him. Busch added that he was also there because Greg Greene told police about their discussion, when Busch told Greene he had fantasies about liking tying up some kid.

12-07-07: I met with Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) today and explained to them what I had found in regards to Christopher Busch and the possibility that he may have been out on bond at the time of the King abduction and could have possibly been involved in this. We also discussed the possibility that Busch & Greene may have been involved in the earlier abduction of Mark Stebbins. I gave them copies of the "Mapquest" results I found for "Ess" Lake in the Hillman/Atlanta, Michigan area. They are going to have MSP in Lewiston, Michigan check and see if the cottage on Ess Lake still exists and if so, who the owner is now.

12-10-07: I received an e-mail from Gay Cook today, after I had sent her one, to see if Christopher Busch was possibly connected to the Busch's that are related to her, from the Utica/ Mt. Clemens area. Gay indicated that she didn't believe they were, but thought it was possible that Harold Lee Busch could be Elmer Busch's brother. Elmer was Gina, Joe & John Busch's father. (These are the Busch's connected to Carl Shonebeck).

12-10-07: I forwarded info today to Dave Robertson (MSP), on Christopher Busch and the cottage on Ess Lake in Montmorency County. Dave is going to have the State Police in Lewiston, Michigan assist us in locating this cottage.

12-10-07: *** (Confirmed today that Jane Burgess was Christopher Busch's Attorney in 1977) *** I received the court file today on Christopher Busch, from the records office in Oakland County. This file confirmed that Jane Burgess did in-fact represent Christopher Busch in a multiple count CSC case involving a juvenile in Oakland County in 1976-77. In this file, it appears that

Christopher Busch's father, H. Lee Busch, posted a \$9,000 cash bond for the release of Busch pending trial. It appears that the victim in these CSC's was a Kenneth Bowman, male between 12-16 years old. Mothers name was Patricia Bowman. There is mention in this file of a co-defendant that was not bound over for trial, but it does not give his name (possibly Greg Greene). The file indicates that Busch pled guilty to the 3rd Degree & the 4th Degree CSC's and the 1st Degree was dropped. It appears that Busch ended up getting 2 years probation and fines & Costs.

12-10-07: I sent Cathy King an e-mail today, with the names of the Busch family to run by her dad and siblings to see if any of the King's, recognize these names from the Birmingham area. She e-mailed me back a short time later, stating that she had asked her dad and siblings and none of them recognized any of the Busch names.

12-11-07: I received a copy of the death certificate today for Christopher Brian Busch. Busch's suicide was Oakland County M.E. case# 78-2221. The M.E. that conducted the autopsy of Busch was Dr. Robert J, Sillery. The cause of death was a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head. The date of death was 11-20-1978. Christopher Busch was 27 years old when he killed himself. The death took place at Busch's parents home at Busch's brother Charles N. (Nels) Busch was notified of the death. In the occupation section of the death certificate, it says Franklin Club Apartments. Busch possibly was the "maintenance guy" there or possibly was involved in managing a kitchen there? In the section that states the type of business

the subject was in, it says Food Service Manager. This death certificate indicates that Christopher Busch was cremated and lists the cemetery or crematory as Evergreen, Detroit, Michigan. I forwarded this information to Garry Gray & Dave Robertson (MSP) via e-mail.

12-12-07: I received an e-mail from Dave Robertson today. He forwarded me a copy of the request to MSP in Lewiston, for them to search the county records in Montmorency County, in an attempt to locate the cottage Busch lived at and was seen at on 3-19-1977 with two minors. This cottage was located on Ess Lake near Hillman, Michigan in Montmorency County.

12-12-07: I called Bloomfield Twp. PD today and talked to a woman in the records department. She attempted to locate a police report on the suicide of Christopher Busch. The only record of a report they had for Christopher Busch, was when he was arrested in 1977 on a felony warrant for another jurisdiction (probably the warrant from MSP Pontiac on the CSC's). They have no record of a death report for Busch.

12-17-07: I called Genesee County Sheriff's Dept. Today and spoke to a woman in records (Donna) who is going to try to locate the arrest report on Christopher Busch from 1-28-1977, when he was arrested for sexual assault. The CCH shows this arrest to be Genesee County Sheriff's Dept. case # 77-00487. Donna indicated to me that it would probably take her several days to locate this report, if she can find it at all.

12-20-07: I received a call today from Donna at the Genesee County Sheriff's, who stated that Christopher Busch's arrest, was actually made by Flint PD on 1-14-1977, and thought that I might be able to get a copy of an arrest report from them. She stated that her records showed that Busch was housed at the Genesee County Jail until he posted bond on 1-31-1977. The phone number for Flint PD records, fax, is 810-237-6169. Donna Jones is at This is interesting, because Greene was born, raised and arrested many times in Flint. That could be why Busch was in this area at this time. I want to see who Busch was arrested with and if they held and/or hurt the victims.

Christmas Break 2007

12-27-07: I received an e-mail today from Cathy King, who indicated that she looked on "Mapquest" for the Busch Family on Morningview Terrace in Bloomfield Twp., and observed that another OCCK suspect, named John Hastings lived in the same neighborhood as Busch, 0.4 miles apart, on a street called "Tuckahoe" Rd. Busch and Hastings were both approximately the same

age. (We do not at this point in the investigation have any indication of Hasting being involved with Busch & Greene).

1-3-08: I faxed a request today, to the Flint Police Department Records supervisor for any/all reports pertaining to Christopher Busch & Gregory Greene, specifically the arrest-report on Busch from 1-27-1977. On the CCH it shows this arrest of Christopher Busch was on 1-28-1977 by the Genesee County Sheriff's Dept. After several phone conversations with the records people at the Sheriff's Dept. it was determined that Busch was actually arrested on 1-27-1977 in the case, by Flint PD. Busch was then housed after his arraignment at the Genesee County Jail, until he posted bond on 1-31-1977 (after he was cleared by polygraph in the OCCK case).

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1-3-08: I received an e-mail today from Dave Robertson (MSP). He forwarded a request to the
 Michigan State Police Intelligence Unit in Lansing today, requesting copies of the reports from MSP 27's arrest of Busch in February of 1977. This request from Robertson also included any/all reports
 that MSP has on Christopher Busch & Gregory Greene.

14 1-11-08: I received a fax today from Flint Police Department, regarding my request for reports on Busch & Greene. The fax stated that they showed no arrest for Christopher Busch,

I had requested any/all reports on Busch & Gregory Greene, so I don't know if they even checked on Greene, or for other reports on Busch.

1-15-08: *** (Found possible connection between Lamborgine and Busch & Green) *** | was reading the report tonight on the Lamborgine investigation, looking for connections between Busch & Greene and Ted Lamborgine. I thought Greg Greene sounded familiar to me from past interviews. While reading the report, I came across a phone interview I conducted with a person who called on 12-13-2006, with information about Ted Lamborgine. This person identified himself as Kenneth Bowman and stated that he had met Lamborgine when he was 14 years old, hitchhiking in Ohio in 1976. Bowman stated that Lamborgine fed him, paid him for sex and drove Bowman to Woodward Ave. & Warren Ave. in Detroit.

*** I noticed when reading the court file on the arrest of Christopher Busch in January of 1977, for 3 counts of child molestation, that the victim in this case was Kenneth Bowman, whose mother was Patricia Bowman. This could possibly be a connection between the 2 leads, connecting Lamborgine with Busch & Green. This Lamborgine connection, could also possibly explain the MSP tip sheet on Busch, stating that he was involved in a child porn ring.

1-16-08: *** (Identified the Kenneth Bowman tonight that was the victim of Christopher Busch in Oakland County in Busch's January 1977 arrest by MSP 27) *** I performed a check thru the Michigan Dept. of Correction's Offender Tracking Information System (OTIS) and found Kenneth Arthur Bowman, white male, born The age matches the victim Kenneth Bowman from 1977. This subject was released from Prison for Burglary in 2006 and is currently on Probation out of the 3rd Circuit Court in Wayne County, until 2010. I performed a criminal history check, which revealed a huge multi-state criminal history and showed this Bowman subject to be a registered sex offender. This check also revealed this subject to have lived and been arrested multiple times in the Flint, Genesee County area. This is where Greg Green lived. This report revealed that Bowman may possibly be living in Belleville, Michigan and gave a phone number. I called and spoke with a woman, who identified herself as Kenneth Bowman's mother. I asked if I was speaking to Patricia, to which she stated, "yes." This confirms this subject to be the victim of Christopher Busch from Busch's 1977, Oakland County case, when Jane Burgess represented Busch. I left my name and number for her to give to Kenneth, for him to call me. I still need to confirm whether or not this is the same guy that called about Lamborgine and identified himself as Kenneth Bowman.

1-17-08: *** (Another phone interview with Kenneth Bowman's Mother, Patricia Bowman) ***
\[\text{called Patricia Bowman again tonight in an attempt to interview Kenneth. She told me that he has been hanging around in Detroit. I asked her if he's been staying over on Clairmount St. and she

stated that she thought that sounded right. I stated that he's reporting the Belleville address to his probation officer, to which Patricia stated that he is staying with her in Belleville, but hangs out in Detroit. I asked again about a cell-phone number for him and she stated that she does have a number for him. She stated that he is at in I told her that, that is the address for the Wayne County Jail. She stated that he must have gotten in trouble again. I told her that I would go see him to talk to him, but wanted to ask her a few questions about their past. I asked if they used to live in Flint and she told me that they lived at pack in the 70's. I asked her if she knows Chris Busch & Greg Green, to which she stated she did, adding that they used to live on the next street (Later identified as Simcoe St.), stating that she thought Green & Busch might be cousins. I talked about Chris Busch being arrested and charged in Oakland County in 1977 for molesting Kenneth. Patricia stated they were both arrested, adding that Greg Green was the other one. I asked if Kenneth spent a lot of time with Chris Busch, to which she stated that he (Kenneth) was always with Chris & Greg. She indicated that she knew that Busch & Green were Pedophiles, stating that they were sex offenders. I asked if she knew about Christopher Busch having a place up north, to which she stated she did, saying that he (Chris) & Greg took Kenneth up there to a cottage a couple of times. When I asked about the cottage, she stated that the only thing she knows about it is that it possibly belongs to a cousin of Busch's. I asked her if she remembers what Green & Busch were driving back then and what they would go up north in, to which she stated it was an older Pontiac, She thought it was blue or dark blue. I asked her to clarify when she said and older Pontiac, to which she stated from the 60's. I asked about Kenneth being younger than Green & Busch, to which Patricia stated he was a lot younger than them. They were in their mid twenties and Kenneth was only 13 years old at the time in the mid to late 70's. I asked about Kenneth spending time with them and she said that they would take Kenneth everywhere with them. I asked where else they would go to, and she stated that they were always taking Kenneth to Detroit to see some guys that Busch & Green knew. I asked her if she knew the names of the men that they went to see in Detroit and she stated she did not, adding that I should talk to Kenneth about all this, he would be able to answer all your questions about these guys. The men in Detroit could possibly be Lamborgine, Moore, Tazelaar and/or others that would explain a note in Busch's 1977 tip file, stating that he had connections to a child porn ring. This would also explain Kenneth Bowman calling with information about Lamborgine molesting him in the past. I asked if she knew about Christopher Busch's family being rich, to which she stated that she did. I asked her if Kenneth ever said anything to her about what Busch said about his family and she stated that Busch hated his parents and said they were "bad" people. Patricia kept telling me to ask Kenneth these questions and he would be able to tell you a lot more about them than she could. I asked if she knew who Busch & Green stayed with on Simcoe and she stated that she thought it might be Green's Cousin's house.

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37 **1-19-08:** I called the Wayne County Jail today to see if Bowman was still there for an interview.
38 They had no record of him. I checked his Department of Corrections probation status that showed a "last movement" date of 1-16-08 and showed "transfer between offices." This report gave the phone number (313) 972-3170 to check on the status of the offender.

41 **1-20-08:** I called Wayne County probation Supervisor Kirk McVittie and asked him to please locate Bowman for me so I can interview him. McVittie is checking on Bowman's whereabouts and will call me back.

1-22-08: Garry Gray (MSP) called me today and stated that he went to the Michigan State Police Forensics lab today and picked up the newly acquired DNA evidence from the clothing of the OCCK victims, that was obtained during the recent re-examination by the State Police Lab.

1-23-08: Wayne County Probation Officer, Jeaney Cheeks called me today about Kenneth Bowman. She stated that Bowman is in the Dickerson Center for OWI 3rd offense. She is his probation Officer and stated that he will be in Dickerson until March 2008.

1-28-08: When I returned from the interview of Lawson tonight, there was a message from Kenneth Bowman indicating that he was currently at "Operation Get Down" in Detroit (Halfway House) and that he heard I wanted to talk to him, stating that I can call him at his counselor's (Mr. Phillips) office at (313) 921-9422, ext. 233. Bowman stated that his counselor would let him talk to me in his office.

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1-29-08: *** (1st tape-recorded interview of Kenneth Bowman. Today at "Operation Get Down" in Detroit. This is a "halfway house" located @ Gratiot & Harper) *** I went to "Operation Get Down today, interviewed Bowman about his relationship with Christopher Busch & Gregory Green and to see if he was the same Kenneth Bowman that called me a year earlier with information about Ted Lamborgine. I also was attempting to confirm a possible connection between Busch, Green & Lamborgine. I asked Bowman right away if he was the same guy I talked to a year earlier about Ted Lamborgine, to which he stated he was. Present at the beginning of the interview, along with Bowman and myself, was Bowman's counselor Mr. Phillips. I had Bowman start at the beginning with how and when he met Busch & Green. Bowman went into detail about his relationship with Busch & Green, how he met them, why/how he was afraid of them, the places they took him and how they used him to lure kids to the car. The details that Bowman laid out to me about Busch & Greene mirrored the information in the police reports from 1977, when Bowman was interviewed about Busch and Greene molesting him and his relationship to these two. These details included the information when Greene molested Bowman, Gunnels, Busch, & Plumley at the drive-in theatre in Flint in 1976. These details Bowman gave me about Busch & Green, included descriptions of vehicles they were driving at that time, one of which was a 1977 blue Chevy Vega Hatchback with a white stripe, the fact that Busch was carrying a handoun at that time and threatened Bowman prior to molesting him, also the story about Green choking Bowman unconscious in the back of his van, when Green was attempting to have anal intercourse with Bowman. These 1977 police reports were from the investigation and interviews conducted by MSP, Flint PD & the OCCK Task Force into Christopher Busch & Gregory Greene, including reports of the interviews of the victims/associates of Busch & Greene.

Bowman talked about how Greg & Chris would drive him around in their cars and have Kenneth "lure" kids closer to the car by talking to them, stating that the kids were more comfortable and would approach the car once they saw he was a kid too. Kenneth talked about Greg driving him around Oakland County having him call-out to boys to come over to the car so that Greg could get a look at them.

During the course of this interview, Bowman made statements about Busch bringing a boy down to Flint from the cottage up north in the spring of 1977 and making him (Bowman) perform oral sex on this boy in the woods in Flint. Bowman stated that he thought the boy was nervous, but did not appear to be scared or being held against his will. Bowman said that he and Busch then drove the boy to a house somewhere between Flint & Detroit, stating that it could have been Pontiac, Waterford, he wasn't sure. Bowman then stated that Busch walked the boy up to the door and the man that came to the door appeared to be Ted Lamborgine. Bowman stated that he knew Lamborgine from the time Ted picked him up while hitchhiking in Ohio in 1977, and from a couple of times when Lamborgine took him to "XXX" places on Woodward in Detroit and molested him. Bowman stated that he believed that the man Busch dropped this boy off to was Lamborgine, based on knowing him and seeing him on the TV when we arrested him in Ohio in December 2006. Bowman stated that he believes the boy was the King boy because in the spring of 1977, Flint Detectives Fran Miller and Tom Waldren, showed him pictures of two dead boys, naked, lying on a table and their faces were kind of blue like his was after Green choked him. I asked Bowman if Chris & Greg used him to lure kids to the car, to which Bowman stated, "Yes." I asked Bowman if he was involved in abducting the kids from the child killings? Bowman paused for a long time and stated, "Yes." I asked him who else was involved to which he stated Chris. I asked Bowman who else knew about this and he answered, "Just Chris." Bowman stated that when these Detectives showed him those photo's, he knew right then that one of the dead boys was the boy Busch brought from up north and had him perform sex on, stating that he is a co-conspirator. I explained levels of

culpability to Bowman and asked him why he didn't say anything to the police back then, to which he stated he was too scared. During this interview, Bowman talked about Busch buying a blue Chevy Vega hatchback, with a white stripe that he (Busch) purchased at Al Serra Chevrolet in Flint in January of 1977. Bowman also talked about how Busch and Green took him for a ride in 1976 to a rural area off Dixie Hwy. In northern Oakland County, stating that he thought they were going to molest and kill him that day, stating further that Busch had the handgun under the seat of the blue Vega. Green had told Bowman in the past that Busch has killed a kid before, in the woods up north. While asking Bowman about Busch's cottage up north, Bowman kept saying that he thought it was a house, not a cottage. Bowman insisted he was never up at Busch's cottage, but during earlier interviews with his mother, she told me that Kenneth was always with Chris & Greg, and that she remembers Kenneth going up to the cottage at least twice with Chris & Greg.

We started talked further about his statements regarding Busch, Green & Lamborgine all being involved in the killing of the King boy and possibly others. Bowman could not say how he knew that for sure, other than saying that he heard they were and kept saying that they had him at Busch's cottage up north before they brought him down to Flint. When I would ask Bowman if he was hesitant on responding to that question, because he himself was involved he would state "No," but not very convincingly. Bowman kept saying that he knows that the boy I showed him a picture of (Tim King) was the boy that Busch made him have sex with and the same boy that he later saw a picture of, dead. We kept getting interrupted during the interview by other employee's at the halfway house and had to switch offices. Bowman also stated that after they dropped this boy off at the house to who he believes was Ted Lamborgine, he never saw the boy again until the police showed him the picture of the boy. Before this interview ended, Bowman stated that he later saw a Polaroid of this boy who he believes was the King boy in Busch's Vega. Bowman said that the boy was tied up in the car, in the picture. Bowman stated that Busch kept a set of handcuffs in the Vega. My time for this interview was cut short by the staff at Operation Get Down and I still had a lot of questions for Bowman, especially about the authenticity of Busch seeing the King boy & how Lamborgine is possibly connected to Busch & Green. I made arrangements with Bowman and with his counselor, Mr. Phillips, to interview Bowman further at the Michigan State Police Post in a few weeks down the road, so that we can talk at length without interruptions. Bowman agreed. *** (For details of this interview, see the transcripts or listen to the disc from the recording) ***

1-29-08: I called Rob Moran from the Wayne County Prosecutors Office after this interview and told him that I wasn't sure because we kept getting interupted, but that it's possible this Bowman was involved in the child killings. I told Moran that Busch & Green used him in the past as a "lure" and that Bowman feels that one of the boys Busch had may have been the King boy. I told Moran that Bowman stated while talking about this boy that he called himself a "co-conspirator." I stated to Moran that I felt that it was possible that Bowman was leaning towards admitting involvement or knowledge after the fact, as possibly an unwitting at the time of the crime, but was hedging based on what might happen to him as a conspirator. I told Moran that we are going to interview Bowman further to clarify his possible involvement. Moran stated that he was going to look at the law on this, due to the fact that Bowman was 13-14 years old at that time.

1-29-08: I called Garry Gray (MSP) right after this and told him about what Bowman was saying. I gave Garry the details of what Bowman described about his involvement with Busch & Green in 1976 & 77. Garry stated that the details of what Bowman was saying, is matching, exactly to what he was reading in the state police report he was holding in his hand, from the Busch/Green CSC investigation from 1976 & 77. This is the case that Bowman was the victim of Busch & Green on that was prosecuted in Oakland County in 1977.

2-1-08: *** (Kenneth Bowman called my cellphone today) *** Kenneth Bowman called my cellphone today to tell me that he sent me a letter to the police department about Busch & Green and also to tell me that he is scared about all this, worrying about being charged. I told Kenneth that . was glad he called and that I did not want him to be scared, stating that our intentions at this point.

based on his level of culpability, about what he told me during the first interview, are to make him a witness in this case, but it depends on him. I told Kenneth that when we meet with him next week, he is going to have to be completely honest with us in regards to the information he has about the child killings and about his involvement in the killings and be polygraphed about his involvement and the information he supplies. Kenneth stated that he doesn't know what happened to them after he saw them, but he learned later that those same kids had been killed. I told Kenneth that I talked to a prosecutor named Rob Moran, who is going to attend the next interview and explain the situation to him from a legal stand point, but what he is going to tell you, basically is that you need to be 100% truthful about your involvement and if you saw the kids alive with these adult men, but did not participate in the killings, then you are possibly in a position to be a witness in this case. I told Kenneth that I was not making him any promises, because we have not heard the whole story yet and he would still have to be polygraphed about his information. Kenneth stated, "I'll pass." | informed Kenneth that when we meet next week, he would meet Mr. Moran and Sgt. Gray from the State Police who is my partner and the officer in charge of this case. I reminded Kenneth not to worry, because he just has to tell the truth. Kenneth asked me to just call his counselor next week with which day we are going to conduct the interview and that Mr. Phillips would bring him. Kenneth also asked me to bring a picture of Ted Lamborgine from back then, because he wants to make sure he's referring to the right person. Kenneth stated that he is fairly certain he is, but that he wants to

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2-4-08: I received two letters today from Kenneth Bowman. In these letters Bowman described in more detail, his relationship with Christopher Busch & Greg Green. He also talked a little more about Ted Lamborgine, including the story of how he met and was molested by Ted Lamborgine, while hitchhiking in Ohio in 1977. He is going to have to explain this relationship to us further. It's just too coincidental that he gets picked-up by Lamborgine in Ohio and later he says that Lamborgine is connected with Busch & Green. Bowman is either not being truthful, and trying to make his own connections, or simply holding back on the entire story right now.

Bowman wrote in his letters about how Busch, Green and Lamborgine would use him as a lure, to lure kids over to the cars of these Pedophile men, stating that when he (Bowman) would call a kid to a car, these children were not afraid when they saw that he was the same age they were.

(See letters from Bowman in the Bowman file for details)

2-6-08: I talked to Garry Gray (MSP) today and we decided to interview Lourn Doan about Busch, Green & Bowman, before we interview Bowman next week. Doan is the retired Southfield Detective that was working for the task force in 1977 and conducted an investigation into Busch & Green as possible suspects in the child killings, even after they had passed a State Police polygraph in January 1977, about Stebbins. As I uncovered information about Busch & Green, after the investigative subpoena of polygraph examiner Wasser in 2007, it began to appear that our current investigation was mirroring what Doan was doing 30 years earlier in 1977. It appears that he felt strongly about these two as suspects during the original investigation, but did not have all the information then that we have today about these guys, nor did he know about Ted Lamborgine and his possible connection with Busch & Green.

- 2-8-08: Garry (MSP) e-mailed Lourn Doan today to try to set up a meeting or a conference call with
- him for the beginning of next week. We are waiting to hear back from him.
 2-8-08: We are still waiting for all of the police reports from Flint PD on Busch, Green & Bowman.
- Dave Robertson sent a formal request last week from the State Police, for archived records on these guys.
- 2-8-08: I noticed in the Michigan State Police report from their CSC investigation into Christopher Busch & Greg Green in 1977, that Southfield Detective Lourn Doan & MSP Detective Dyer had gone to Busch's parent's home on Morningview Terrace in Birmingham to arrest Busch on the Criminal
- 49 Sexual assaults he had committed against Kenneth Bowman. The Detectives made contact at this

home with Christopher Busch's father, who stated that Chris was in "Whitehall" and he would call Chris to have him turn himself in. Detectives instead, had Whitehall Police go to Busch's home in Whitehall to arrest him. Busch had left Whitehall and a statewide B.O.L. was entered in the law enforcement computer. Busch was taken into custody in Ionia Michigan.

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I thought at first that Whitehall, Michigan was a small town near Ess Lake, where supposedly Busch spent time at a cottage and was seen there with juveniles on March 19th, 1977 (While King was missing). I performed a check thru "Mapquest" and determined that Whitehall, Michigan is actually on the west side of the state in Muskegon County, no where near Ess Lake, which is located near Hillman, Michigan in Montmorency County. I performed some computer checks thru the "Lexis-Nexis" system and found that Christopher Busch's parents owned a property in Whitehall at that time, that they were buying on a land contract. It appears that the Busch's had relatives in the area. There were several "Busch" families listed with property in the Whitehall area. The property that was owned by Christopher Busch's parent's, was eventually "Quick Claim Deeded" to John S. Busch (Chris's brother), who is now deceased. I located Christopher Busch's older brother Charles Nels Busch, living in New York City, but am unable to locate David L. Busch (The other brother) so far.

2-11-08: We still have not heard from Lourn Doan, so we are going to go ahead and interview Kenneth Bowman on Wednesday this week. We will interview Doan about this case whenever we can make contact with him.

2-11-08: *** (Located reports from Montmorency & Identified the cottage on Ess Lake, near Hillman, Michigan.) *** I called Montmorency County Sheriffs office today and spoke to a dispatcher named Mike Juricz who told me that Junior Brandenburg and Charlotte Pelham are both retired, but still live in the area. Brandenburg was the Montmorency Detective that investigated Christopher Busch in the CSC case when Busch was arrested and charged with in their county in 1977. Charlotte Pelham was the Sheriffs Dept employee who took the anonymous call from a woman on March 19th, 1977, that stated that she saw Chris Busch in the area with two minor boys. Juricz made contact with Charlotte Pelham who agreed to talk to me and gave Juricz her phone number for me. I called and spoke to her about the report she wrote on the anonymous phone call she took on March 19th, 1977. I read her report to her over the phone and she stated that she does not specifically remember that incident, but the part about Christopher Busch being in town with two minors, "rang a bell" with her. Pelham stated that Juinor Brandenburg would probably know who the anonymous caller was and where the cottage was at, stating that he (Junior) still lives in the area near Ess Lake in Hillman, Michigan. Juricz the dispatcher called me back and stated that Brandenburg's phone was busy, that he would keep trying to call him to either call me or give me his phone number.

During this conversation, Juricz stated that a Deputy Shaw, who is trying to help out, found the Busch file and has info if I wanted to talk to him about it. I spoke to Shaw who stated that in Detective Brandenburgs notes, it says that the woman who called on March 19th, 1977 was a "Suzie" from the "A frame" party store. Shaw stated that he is familiar with that store and can call over to the new owners and get "Suzie's" name. Shaw called me back and stated that "Suzie" is Susan King who is now deceased, but her widower is Kenneth King who currently owns the Grand Lake Lodge bar near Alpena, with a phone number of the follow-up on these calls, it states that "Suzie" stated that in Det. Brandenburg's report of the follow-up on these calls, it states that "Suzie" stated that the boys with Busch were approximately 16 & 18 years old. Brandenburg also interviewed Mary & Norman Wiseman, who had called after seeing Busch with 3 young boys at the IGA on March 19th, 1977. These callers stated that the 3 boys were approximately 13, 14 & 15 years old that were with Christopher Busch. These witnesses all gave statements indicating that they only ever saw Christopher with young boys when he was up north.

Deputy Shaw then faxed me a copy of a letter in the file from Detective Waldren at Flint PD to the Chief of the Alma Police Department, March 9th, 1977. In this letter, Waldren tells the Alma Chief that Busch has CSC cases pending in Genesee County, Oakland County, Montmorency County and

Midland County. Waldren stated that the strongest cases against Busch are in Oakland and Genesee County, stating that he has hired the best legal counsel to represent him (Jane Burgess). Waldren also wrote in this letter on March 9th, 1977 (7 days before King was abducted), that Busch is currently free on bond on all charges. I asked Deputy Shaw if he knows who the victim was in the Montmorency case and if he was from that area, to which he stated he did not, but would call the prosecutors office to see if they have the court file on Busch from their cases.

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4ッ Deputy Shaw called me back and stated that he talked to the prosecutor's office, and that they do have the file on Christopher Busch. Shaw gave me the victim's information from this file, stating that a James Vincent Gunnel w/m, was the victim. In Brandenburgs report on this investigation, he writes that all of the boys that Busch would take to the cottage were from down state. I looked at the Flint PD report for the names of the boys that he & Green had molested in that area, and one was a Vincent Gunnel from Flint, Michigan. This corroborates what Bowman said about Busch taking kids up to the cottage, although Bowman stated during the first interview, that he himself was never there. Bowman was not very convincing about this and it's interesting that he is trying to distance himself from this cottage. This report stated that Busch would bring young boys from "down state" to the cottage in the winter for "snowmobile parties" and also in the summer time. It said that Busch would give the boys Marijuana and alcohol before molesting them. This cottage was identified in these reports as being owned by Christopher Busch's father, H.Lee Busch for 12 years and is located on Norway Ct. on Ess Lake. I had been trying to locate this cottage thru computer databases and remember Norway Ct. to be a street on the north side of Ess Lake.

Deputy Shaw stated that in Brandenburgs interview with Busch on 3-3-1977, Busch stated that he did molest James Vincent Gunnels at the cottage on Ess Lake, but never used force. Busch would not name any of the other boys from down state that he brought to the cottage and would not make any written statements until he had a chance to speak with his attorney. Busch told Brandenburg that he knew Gregory Green, but at no time did he ever bring Green to Ess Lake. Busch stated that Green was violent and tried to strangle a boy in Flint that he believes was Kenneth Bowman. Busch continued about Green, stating that the police have confiscated all of his photographs & movies and are holding them. Busch told Brandenburg that he did not have any Photo's or movies at the cottage. Busch went on to say that his problem (Pedophilia) started went his father sent him to boarding school at 17 years old. Busch said that his father has owned the cottage for 12 years. ***

(See Detective Brandenburgs reports and the Montmorency file on Busch for details of their investigation into Christopher Busch) ****

2-11-08: Deputy Shaw had indicated to me, that he could call the "Equalization Dept. at Montmorency County and locate the information on the address and ownership of the Busch Cottage. I told him to go ahead and do that if he can. Deputy Shaw called me back a few minutes later and stated that the Busch family cottage is located at Sax Lake. Shaw said that H. Lee Busch was the owner for many years, sold it to a family named "Secret," who in turn sold it to the current owners, John & Donna Dace. Shaw stated that the "Dace family," that currently own the cottage, live at Shaw then faxed me a copy of the counties paperwork on the property from their tax rolls. This information included the Legal Description, Parcel ID & Location, assessment values, Owners name and address where taxes are sent,...etc. Shaw then supplied me with Detective Junior Brandenburg's home phone number and stated that Brandenburg was waiting for me to call.

2-12-08: I met with Garry Gray (MSP) today and we went over the new developments in this lead on Busch & Green and their possible connection to Lamborgine. I filled Garry in on all the information on Busch from Montmorency County, including the identification of the Busch cottage on Ess Lake. We also discussed our interview strategy with Bowman for tomorrow.

2-12-08: *** (Phone interview with retired Montmorency Detective Junior Brandenburg) *** | called and spoke to Detective Brandenburg today about his investigation into Christopher Busch in 1977, for CSC 1. | informed Brandenburg who | was and what we were working on. | told him that

Deputy Shaw had located his reports and file on Busch from back in 1977 and that Shaw told me that you had an old Detroit News and/or Free Press newspaper clipping about the disappearance of Timothy King in the Busch file. Brandenburg started out saying that he remembers the case and 4567 remembers Busch being a very odd guy, stating that he always felt that Busch might have been involved in the King case, that's why he had the news clippings. Brandenburg said that the dad H. Lee Busch was rich, owned a home in Birmingham, the cottage on Ess Lake and bought Christopher Busch a big two-story restaurant. I asked if it was the restaurant in Alma, to which he stated he 8 believed it was. Brandenburg said that Christopher Busch always had young boys with him and 9 remembers that the boys were from his (Busch's) area, down state. I asked Brandenburg if he 10 remembers the cottage and he stated that it was a "flat roofed" kind of cottage, that may have been painted in the past, but not much has been done to it over the years. Brandenburg stated that he 11 12 lives not too far from there and that he was there when they searched it. I asked him if they found 13 any photographs or anything that would indicate someone may have been held there against their 14 will, to which he stated no. Brandenburg then stated that Busch committed suicide not long after 15 their case, but he didn't know how he did it. I told him that Busch Shot himself in the head. 16 Brandenburg again stated that he always had a gut feeling that Busch was involved in the child 17 killing case. He said he would contact me if he remembered anything else about the case that might 18 help. 19 2-12-08: Deputy "Bud" Shaw called me today and stated that he went over to the old "Busch 20 cottage" on Ess Lake and took pictures of it that he will e-mail to me. Shaw stated that he walked 21 around the cottage and it appears from the foundation and looks of the structure, that it has not 22 changed much if any, over the past 30 years, other than maybe paint, a garage and new deck. 1 23 received the e-mailed photos of Busch's cottage from deputy Shaw this afternoon. It appears to be 24 a 60's style structure with a flat type roof on it.

2-12-08: *** (Livonia Polygraph Exmanier, Tim Larion, reviewed the Busch & Green polygraph charts from 1977 today, and gave his opinion) *** Today, I showed Tim Larion (Livonia Polygraph Examiner) the MSP polygraph charts from examiner Cabot, on the polygraph's of Busch & Green from 1977, in regards to the Stebbins/Mihalich abduction/murder. After approximately 30-45 of reviewing these charts, Larion determined that based on their responses to the relevant questions & both subjects showing deception in regards to the relevant questions, it is his opinion that both subjects should have failed the polygraph and at very best, should have been ruled an inconclusive. The third chart was incomplete and does not include the relevant questions

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that Greene was failing during the first two charts. Larion stated that he did not understand this third chart being incomplete, nor could he understand, based on his training and experience, how the original polygrapher in 1977 could have possibly passed these two.

2-13-08: ***(Video/audio-taped interview of Kenneth Bowman @ MSP Metro North Post)***
Today we interviewed Kenneth Bowman about his information in regards to Busch & Green's possible involvement and his possible involvement in the child killings. We also wanted to clear up how Bowman was connecting Ted Lamborgine to Busch & Green. We felt that this was too much of a coincidence to be true. I also felt after talking to Bowman last time that he was holding back information, because he himself was possibly involved in the killings, even possibly as an unwitting at the time. Bowman was adamant that the boy that Busch made him have sex with was the King boy.

We made arrangements to have Rob Moran present at the beginning of this interview to clear up any concerns Bowman may have had in regards to his culpability in this case and his ability to speak freely without the possibility of being charged. Bowman indicated during the first interview, that he had been used by Busch & Green, as a "Lure" to get kids to the car for them and that they drove all over Genesee, Oakland & wayne Counties looking for kids. We felt that Bowman may possibly be the witness we were looking for that could put the pieces of the puzzle together and put the King boy with Busch, Green & Possibly Lamborgine while missing and prior to them killing him (King).

Moran talked to Bowman for a short time and then we read Bowman his rights. Bowman was asked if he understood all of his right, to which he stated he did. Bowman then agreed to waive his ights and talked with investigators. We then had Bowman start from the beginning on how he met Busch, Green & Lamborgine. A lot of the beginning of this interview was the same information that he told me during the first interview and was corroborated thru Flint & MSP police reports from 1976 & 77. When Bowman was talking about how he met Lamborgine and his relationship with Lamborgine, we noticed some discrepancies in his story from the first interview. We began questioning Bowman about his Knowledge of Lamborgine, his connection to Busch & Green and how he (Bowman) knows that Ted Lamborgine was involved in the child killings with Busch & Green. I also had Bowman describe the boy that Bowman said Busch made him have sex with in 1977, that he (Bowman) believes was the King boy. Bowmans physical description and what the boy was wearing, did not match Timothy King. After a time of questioning Bowman about his information. Detectives determined that Bowman was trying to make the pieces of the puzzle fit to connect Lamborgine with Busch & Green. Bowman believes that the man that Busch & Green stopped to see back then was Ted Lamborgine, because he (Bowman) remembered Lamborgine from when he picked him up hitchhiking in Ohio in 1976/77 and molested him at a restaurant. Bowman said when he saw Ted on the news last year, he knew it was the same guy. Bowman made some comment at this point, about Lamborgine being a pedophile and needing to go to prison for life, indicating he was possibly trying to make Lamborgine fit into this puzzle. Bowman cannot say for sure that Ted Lamborgine is connected with Busch & Green, but believes he is. Bowman cannot say for sure that the boy he had sex with that Busch brought down from up north was the King boy, but he (Bowman) believes it was, stating again that when the Flint police showed him the pictures of the two dead boys lying naked, he knew that the one (identified by Bowman as King) was the same boy that Busch had. Bowman also insisted during this interview that he was never up at Busch's cottage in Hillman, Michigan.

We determined during this interview that it appears, that Bowman was possibly not, for lack of a better term, the "Home-run hitter" we were looking for in this case, that could put the pieces of the puzzle together. Bowman is going to have to be polygraphed now, due to the two different stories and the possibility that he may have knowledge or have been involved. Bowman may have just gotten "cold feet" after possibly attempting to confess during the first interview and got scared while waiting for the second interview. It is also possible that Bowman learned what he had been involved in after the fact. I asked Bowman, out of the boys that Busch & Green were running with back then, who, were they closest to and had the biggest propensity to be involved in something bad with Busch & Green, to which Bowman stated Vince Gunnels. Bowman said that he saw Gunnels in Jackson prison in the mid 1990's. We then asked Bowman for his consent to a Buccal Swab for DNA, to which he gave us, but appeared very nervous about it, asking a lot questions and when the results would be back. The interview was terminated at this point. *** (See the video or transcripts from this interview for details) ****

2-14-08: ***(I identified another one of Busch, Green & Bowman's associates today named Vincent Gunnels) *** I performed a check thru the Michigan L.E.I.N. system for a criminal history on the name James Vincent Gunnels, which showed a criminal history in Michigan for Gunnels with a D.O.B. of This criminal history in Michigan was lengthy and included arrest in 1980 in Flint for Burglary, Stolen cars and led to many arrest in Lansing for Armed Robbery, Larceny, Burglary, stolen cars...etc. Gunnel's has lengthy criminal histories in 4 states, including: Florida, Minnesota, Montana & Michigan. Gunnel's is currently serving 4-10 years in Michigan Dept. of Corrections for a purse snatching he committed in Ingham County in 2004. Gunnels is currently being housed at the Ojibway Correctional facility in Gogebic County, Michigan. This is located in the far northwest section of the upper peninsula of Michigan. Gunnels is the guy that Bowman stated was the closet to Busch & Green back in Flint in the 70's and the most likely to have been involved in something bad with them.

2-15-08: I received a phone message today from Garry Gray (MSP) who stated that he finally got a call-back from Lourn Doan, the retired Southfield Detective that was "looking hard" at Busch & Green as OCCK suspect back in the 70's. Doan had been on vacation in the Bahama's for the last couple of weeks, but told Garry that he would be more than happy to come in and talk to us about this lead.

2-19-08: I talked to John Ouelett (FBI) today about trying to get a copy of the report or file from Bloomfield Twp. PD, on the suicide of Christopher Busch. John said that he knows the Chief of Police at that agency and would call him today to request this file or a copy of it. I told John if they locate it to let me know and I would drive over to Bloomfield Twp. and pick-up the file today.

2-19-08: *** (Identified several of Busch & Green's other associates today, including: Jeff Plumley, Brent Busch & Dale Cooper) *** I performed a check thru the Secretary of State today for a Jeff Plumley and located Jeffrey Allen Plumley, w/m born to reside at A check thru Lexis-Nexis showed this subject to have several addresses in the past around the Flint/Genesee County area. I obtained 3 photos of Plumley thru the Secretary of State imaging system. A check thru the Michigan LEIN system showed no Criminal History for Plumley.

I performed a check thru the Lexis-Nexis system for Brent Busch and located a Brent Harris Busch living in Newaygo, Michigan. The results of this check, also showed this to be the Brent Busch related to Chistopher Busch. A check thru the Secretary of State, showed this person to be Brent Harris Busch, w/m, born and B, to reside at I obtained 2 photos of this subject thru the Secretary of State imaging system. Busch has a lengthy CCH for mainly misdemeanor type offenses in White Cloud and Newaygo, Michigan.

I had Dale Coopers name from the MSP report during the 1977 CSC investigation involving Busch & Greene in Flint and Oakland County. Cooper, along with Busch & Green was listed as a suspect in that case. I ran his name thru MDOC and located Dale Arthur Cooper, w/m, born check thru the Michigan LEIN system showed Cooper to have a lengthy CCH in St. Clair County in the 1970's & 80's. I don't know yet how Cooper is connected to Busch & Green. He shows an address on Park in the Cass Corridor as of the past 10 years. No photo yet of Cooper. When we interview Brent Busch, he may be bale to make the connection with Cooper, Busch & Green. *** (See their personal files for all this information on each subject)***

2-19-08: Garry Gray e-mailed me today about some of our upcoming plans for this case. We are going to meet with Bob Dykstra (MSP Polygraph Examiner) at 09:30 tomorrow to get his opinion on Busch & Green's polygraphs from January 1977 in regards to the Stebbins case. We are going to also show these charts to the FBI examiner in the area for his independent opinion. We have arrangements to interview Lourn Doan on Thursday this week after Lawson's sentencing.

2-20-08: *** (MSP Polygraph Examiner, Lt. Dykstra reviewed Busch & Greene's charts today)
Today, Garry, Dave & I took Busch & Green's polygraph charts from January 1977, over to the Michigan State Police post in Northville, to get Lt. Dykstra's (polygraph examiner) opinion on the charts. We didn't tell Dykstra anything about the case, or anyone's opinions or findings ahead of time, just simply asked him to review the charts and give us his opinion. We left the room, and after approximately 30 minutes or so, Dykstra called us back into his office. Not knowing what the original polygraphers opinion was, Dykstra pointed at the chart for Green and stated that he would have failed this subject, stating that based on his charts he believes he had involvement, stating further that his were pretty clear cut. Dykstra stated the other guy (Busch) shows some deception to the relevant questions, but that he (Dykstra) would probably call his inconclusive, stating that based on the responses/reactions to the relevant questions, he may have had knowledge. Afterwards, Lt. Dykstra asked what the original polygraphers opinion was. When we told him that they were both "Passed" back then, Dykstra stated that he did not see how they could have been a pass, especially Green's, stating that Busch's should have been an inconclusive, but not a pass.

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Lt. Dykstra's opinion on the polygraph charts of Busch & Green from 1977, in regards to their involvement in the child killings, almost "mirrors" the opinion of polygraph examiner Larion. These examiners gave their opinions of the charts, independent from each other and without knowing the opinion of the original examiner. (Examiners, Larion & Dykstra, did not score these charts numerically when reviewing them, but merely looked at the questions and Busch & Greene's responses to the questions, and based on their training & experience, rendered an opinion).

2-20-08: Cathy King sent me an e-mail today, stating that she ran the Busch name by retired Birmingham Detective Jack Kalbfliesch and asked if he remembers the name, stating that Busch committed suicide in Birmingham in the late 70's and was a suspect in the child killings. I expressed concerns with Cathy talking to someone outside the Task Force & Law Enforcement, about what we are working on, and she re-assured me that we could trust him. She stated that he has known about this since Coffey and Wasser a year ago and hasn't said anything and she was very vague with him about what she was looking for. Anyways, Kalbfleisch told her that he did remember a suspect in the child killings that killed himself with a shotgun at a home near Maple & Lahser in the late 70's, and the reason he remembers this is because they found a pencil drawing in Busch's room of a boy "screaming" that looked like the Stebbins boy.

2-21-08: The Task Force met at the MSP Metro North post today and we had retired Southfield Detective Lourn Doan there to interview him about his investigation, back in 1976 & 77, into Christopher Busch & Gregory Green. We gave Lourn a few general facts about the case, as to "jog" his memory, but really wanted him to "fill in the gaps" on his own, without us leading him. Lourn remembered the investigation and remembered Christopher Busch when we showed him the picture. Being that it is such an old investigation, Lourn was struggling a bit, trying to remember details of the case. We showed him the original tips he wrote up on Busch & Green in 1976 and also the tip he wrote on these guys again in 1978. Detective Doan & Detective Roy Itami (Berkley PD) were working together on the Timothy King Homicide, as part of the Oakland County Child Killing investigation. Even after Busch & Green had been cleared by an MSP polygraph in Flint in January of 1977, Doan continued to investigate these subjects as suspects. He remembered Busch killing himself at his home in 1978, but stated he thought he hung himself, but stating he did not remember for sure. We called Detective Roy Itami, who agreed to come to the meeting. Doan & Itami looked over the tips they wrote up and began talking about when they took Busch & Green to the polygraph with MSP in Flint. Doan stated that they, along with the "Task Force" were so convinced that these two suspects were involved in the killings that Deputy Cakand County Prosecutor Dick Thompson went along and was present during the polygraph, believing a polygraph failure was forthcoming, along with a confession. Doan stated that Thompson also thought they would be issuing charges on these subjects. Both Doan & Itami stated that during the hundreds of polygraphs conducted on suspects during this massive investigation, this was the only time a presecutor, especially the Deputy Oakland County Presecutor attended a polygraph. I asked Doan if he remembers how he felt when Examiner Cabot (MSP) passed both of these subjects, to which he stated that he does not remember exactly because it was so long ago, but he does remember vaguely that they couldn't believe they passed and that they were kind of "scratching their heads, over it."

We then told Doan & Itami that we have recently, based on Wasser's statements to Coffey about Busch's confession to him and our recent investigation, shown Busch & Green's polygraph charts to two independent examiners, one of which is a very experienced MSP examiner. We told Doan & Itami that both examiners were in agreement, independent of each other, & neither subject should have been "passed" that day after their polygraphs in 1977. We further stated that both examiners stated that Green's polygraph was such a conclusive failure that they could not understand how examiner Cabot could have passed him. They both stated that Busch's polygraph showed deception on the relevant questions indicating to the examiners, possible knowledge of the crimes. Both stated at best, Busch would have been an inconclusive, but not a "pass." Doan & Itami were shaking their heads stating this could have been solved 30 years ago. Both Detectives asked where

- their reports were. All we have is the tip sheets they wrote up and what was attached to the tips.

 Doan stated that he knows he wrote lengthy reports on this lead. Itami stated that he remembers he amount of writing Doan did at that time on this lead and stated that there should be a large file on these guys. We are going to check further in the state police files for these. Doan stated that if we call Chris Helgert at Southfield PD, he may have a copy of his (Doan's), indicating that he thinks he gave a copy of everything to his agency.
- 2-22-08: I was reviewing Polygraph Examiner Cabot's pre-polygraph interview of Gregory Green today, and noticed that Cabot asked Green if there were anyone he wished were dead? Green mentioned his father, a couple of other names and Vince Gunnels. It's interesting that Green wants Gunnels dead. It's possible that Gunnels had information about Green and he (Green) was afraid Gunnels would tell someone. We are going to take this report with us when we interview Gunnels in prison in a couple of weeks.
- 2-25-08: We went to Southfield PD today and talked to Chris Helgert about Lourn Doan's old 13 reports involving an investigation Doan conducted at the time of the child killings, regarding two 14 subjects, Christopher Busch & Gregory Green. Helgert had already pulled all of Southfield PD's 15 reports that they had from the child killing investigation. In these reports, we found two tips written up 16 by Detective Doan on Busch & Green in January of 1977. This file from Southfield PD also 17 contained several typed reports by Doan about this investigation into Busch & Green. The 18 following is a short "Time-Line" of the, "one-week" investigation in January 1977 when 19 Greene was arrested for multiple CSC's in Flint and told the police Chris Busch killed Mark 20 Stebbins. This short time-line includes some highlights of interviews and when & why they 21 were cleared and the case was closed: 22
 - 1-25-1977: OCCK Task Force contacted by Det. Waldren from Flint PD. They have arrested a subject named Gregory Green for CSC 1st Degree, who says that Chris Busch killed Mark Stebbins.

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- 1-25-1977: Doan & Lt. Simmons went to Flint PD and interviewed Greene about this information. Greene, according to Doan's report supplies Detectives with all the information about Busch's involvement in the Stebbins abduction/murder. Doan notes that Green is looking more like a suspect in the homicides than an informant.
- 1-26-1977: Kenneth Bowman (the victim in this case) was interviewed. Bowman said that he was afraid when Greene & Busch took him into the woods to molest him that they were going to kill him. Greene had choked him unconscious in the past when trying to anally molest him. Greene had told Bowman prior to this that Chris Busch had killed a kid before. Bowman told the police that Greene had asked him a few months ago, to help him kidnap and kill a boy. Bowman went on to say that when Greene anally molested him in the past, Greene used force, Bowman was crying, but Greene would not stop.
- 1-26-1977: Flint PD polygraphs Green about his info about Busch Killing Stebbins. Flint PD
 polygraphed Green about whether he knows for sure who killed Stebbins. Green answers, "no"
 is found by the Flint examiner to be truthful.
- 1-26-1977: Green was interviewed today by Dick Thompson (Oak.County Pros.), Gary Hawkins and Lt. Simmons (Southfield PD).
- 41 1-27-1977: Warrant obtained today for Christopher Busch, by Flint PD for a CSC 3rd Degree.
- 1-28-1977: Detective Doan, Det. Cattel (Ferndale PD), Sgt. Rivard (MSP) & Det. Waldren (Flint PD) went to the "Scotsman" restaurant today in Alma, Michigan and arrested Christopher Busch on Flint PD's CSC charge.
 - 1-28-1977: Detectives conduct a consent search of Busch's home at Detectives find 2 shotguns, ½ 1lb. Of Marijuana and 2 suitcases. 1 suitcase contained ropes and

the other contained child pornography, including child porn films and scrapbooks. The 2 suitcases found in Busch's home in Alma, were confiscated by Flint PD as evidence in their CSC case.

1-28-1977: Doan, Cattel, Waldren & Rivard (MSP) interviewed Busch about his possible involvement in the Oakland County Child Killings. Busch denies involvement in the Stebbins case, but told Detectives about fantasies that he and Green have discussed. Busch said that they have talked about wanting to kidnap a boy, tying him up and sexually abusing him. Busch stated that either he or Green would work at night and the other during the day, so one of them would always be with the boy. When Busch was asked what they would do with the boy when they were done with him, he couldn't answer. While Busch was talking to Investigators about being a pedophile and locations he picked up and dropped off boys in the past, he named the following locations in chronological order: 9 Mile & Woodward in Ferndale, 13 Mile & Woodward in Royal Oak, & the "7-11" store on 12 Mile in Berkley. These are the first three abduction sites, in order. The King abduction had not occurred yet.

1-28-1977: Busch was polygraphed today by Ralph Cabot, at MSP in Flint. Busch was asked about his involvement in the Stebbins abduction/murder and/or his knowledge of it. Busch denied knowledge and involvement and according to Cabot, Busch was being truthful.

2-1-1977: Green was polygraphed today by Ralph Cabot, at MSP in Flint. Green was asked about his involvement in the Stebbins abduction/murder and/or his knowledge of it. Green denied knowledge and involvement and according to Cabot, Green was being truthful.

2-1-1977: Both Busch and Green were cleared today by polygraph. An article in the Daily Tribune was in this file that stated on the headline that Task Force finds no link between Flint case and child killings in Oakland County. The article stated that two men arrested in Flint were polygraphed about their possible involvement in the child murders in Oakland County, but both were cleared. *** case was closed. ***

2-26-08: We went to Flint PD today to try to get any reports or notes their Detectives might done on Green's info about Busch, and also copies of the polygraphs Flint PD did on Green. The only file that we could locate at Flint PD was the old CSC cases (reports) on Busch & Green. We already have copies of those. A Detective Greg Hosmer is going to manually go thru the old polygraph files and see if he can locate the polygraphs administered on Green at Flint PD on January 26th, 1977.

2-26-08: *** (We got copies of Bloomfield Twp.'s reports today on Busch's suicide at his parents home in 1978) *** Garry & I went to Bloomfield Twp. PD today and picked up a copy of their reports on Busch's suicide. John Ouelett (FBI) knows the Bloomfield Twp. Chief (Kurt Bowden) and asked him to pull their reports for us. Their reports stated the following: On November 20th, 1978, Bloomfield Twp. PD was called to Chris Busch's parents home at

Chris's older brother, Charles Nels Busch, who lives in the area at Chris's brother, Charles, had been contacted by a neighbor Harry Dunn, after the Busch Maid (Christine Bracken) was unable to gain entry into the home and went to the neighbor's house to call Charles Busch. The Maid comes to the Busch home once a week on Mondays to clean the house, but was unable to get in due to the latch being locked at the front door.

The police made entry into the home and they found Christopher Busch upstairs in his bed with a gunshot wound to the head. Busch had shot himself between the eyes with a 22 cal. Rifle that was lying next to him in the bed. Charles told the police that Chris lives there with the parents Harold Lee & Elsie Busch that were currently in England. Charles went on to say that he had not spoken to Chris in the last 3 weeks, but that he did not seem despondent. In this report, Charles Busch told the police that his brother John Busch resides in Whitehall, Michigan and his brother David resides in England. The maid, Christine Bracken was interviewed and stated that she has a key to let herself in when she comes to clean, but on this date, she could not open the front door because it was latched from the inside. When she became suspicious she called Mr. Dunn, the neighbor.

During an interview of a close family friend, W. Aitken, he stated that he and his wife had both talked to Chris a few days ago and that he seemed fine to them. Newspapers from Friday thru Monday were found on the porch of the home. The Thursday edition of the paper was found in the home.

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Investigators spoke with the manager of the Franklin Club Apartments, 28301 Franklin Rd. in Southfield, Michigan, where Chris worked as an administrative Chef until he resigned on November 4th, 1978, to pursue a new job at the Franklin Terrace Apartments.

During an interview of Christopher Busch's father, H. Lee Busch, on November 27th, 1978, he stated that Christopher was due to start his new job on November 20th, the day he was found deceased.

Christopher Busch was found lying on his side in his bed facing the wall. Pinned to the wall was a hand-sketched pencil drawing of a boy screaming. The boy was wearing a coat in the drawing that matched the coat Mark Stebbins was wearing when he was abducted and killed. The coat was a "snorkel" type coat with fur around the edge of the hood. Mark was found at Ten Mile & Greenfield wearing that coat with the hood pulled up around his face and zipped up, just like in the drawing Busch had. Also found in the walk-in closet in the bedroom were ropes/ligatures lying in the middle of the floor. This property, along with 3 spent shell casing's, a box of bullets, a vodka bottle and a small amount of Marijuana was confiscated and placed into evidence.

2-27-08: Met with Polygraph Examiner John Wojnarski (retired MSP) today and he looked at Busch & Greens charts. We had Examiner Wojnarski review the charts from Busch & Greene's polygraphs today, without Wojnarski knowing anything about the case or the polygraphs. After reviewing and numerically scoring the charts, he determined that Greene was failing on relevant questions, but that the examiner that conducted the original test in 1977, did not ask Greene the relevant questions that he was failing (about involvement) on the first two charts, on the third chart, like he should have. Wojnarski stated that he did not understand this and stated you have to ask the relevant questions on all three charts, especially when Greene was failing on the first two. Woinarski stated that he would have had to call this inconclusive. When we told him that the examiner passed Greene, he stated that he did not know how he could have passed him and said that it should have been inconclusive because he didn't finish the test. Wojnarski asked who conducted the test, and we told him Ralph Cabot from the MSP Flint post conducted the test in January of 1977, about the Oakland County Child Killings. Wojnarski stated right away that Cabot had a couple of polygraph problems towards the end of his career, where he got into trouble with the State Police when he screwed up a test on a homicide case. This test was done by Cabot in 1977 and he retired in 1980 from the State Police. This info about Cabot, matches what Examiner Larry Wasser said about Cabot, when he told me that he had a couple of times in the past, overturned Cabot's polygraphs on cases.

Wojnarski told us that Chris Busch's polygraph by Cabot was the same way, stating that he did not ask the relevant questions on the third chart, so the results would have to be an inconclusive. He did not see how the original examiner could have possibly passed these subjects on these tests. Wojnarski did say that he thought that Busch was being truthful, but possibly showing some deception problems on a couple of the relevant questions. Wojnarski also stated that the "control" questions that Cabot used were terrible and would not allow them to give a good test.

Wojnarski suggested that all three examiners that looked at these charts, he, Larion & Dykstra all get together, score them the same way (numerically) and then compare notes to come up with a consensus on the results of the tests. Arrangements were made for this meeting.

2-28-08: *** Richard Lawson's sentencing today. ****

2-28-08: We had retired Detective Lourn Doan (Southfield PD) come to the MSP Metro North Post today, and look over his reports from January of 1977 that we picked up at Southfield PD. Doan read over all of his reports, and he did remember most of what he had read, including remembering that investigation, but could not add much additional information to assist us.

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2-28-08: *** (We Briefed Detective Lt. Darryl Hill (MSP) today at the District Headquarters in Northville) *** Garry, Dave & I went to the MSP 2nd District headquarters today and briefed Lt. Hill on the developments in this investigation. Based on what we told Lt. Hill, he authorized D/Sgt. Gray make this case top priority at this point and to work full-time on trying to put this case together. My administration at Livonia PD was also brought up to speed on this lead. Chief Stevenson, felt as strongly about the potential of this lead as Lt. Hill, and also authorized me to work full-time with the State Police right now to continue to pursue this Busch & Greene lead. Lt. Hill also authorized us to use the Michigan State Police Aviation Section to fly Garry & I up to Camp Ojibway to interview Gunnels.

2-29-08: John Ouelett called the Chief of Bloomfield Twp. PD (Bowden) and requested that they try to locate the crime scene photos that they took at Christopher Busch's home on Morningview Terrace when Busch committed suicide in November of 1978. They are going to call me if/when they find them.

2-29-08: Doan's report on the interview of Busch at Flint PD in January 1977, showed the name Mike Boldiyar as the kid Busch Picked up from the 12 Mile Rd. & Greenfield area and took to Hartfields Bowling Alley and the 7-11 store. Busch stated to Detective Doan that Boldiyar was a w/m that Lived in Berkley and would be 18 years old. I grew up in Berkley and thought I remembered a kid named Bolidzar from my neighborhood or school. I called my Brother Mark Williams (retired Berkley Police Lt.). I asked Mark if he remembers a family in Berkley, in the 12 mile & Greenfield area with the last name Boldiyar or Boldizar. Right away, Mark stated you mean Michael Boldizar, he lives on Thomas just north of 12 Mile Rd. This is in the area of 12 & Greenfield in Berkley. Mark said that Boldizar was a few years younger the he (Mark) was and a few years older than I am. Mark then stated that Boldizar had many arrests and police contacts in Berkley and surrounding cities. Mark went on to say that he was eating a meal at a restaurant in Berkley one time (on-duty) when the waitress yelled out, hey Mark there's a guy slashing the tires on your police car. My brother observed and arrested Michael Boldizar for Malicious Destruction of Police Property.

2-29-08: *** (I identified Michael Boldiszar today, an associate of Chris Busch) *** | performed a Lexis-Nexis computer search for Boldiyar and found no matches. I performed the same check on the name Michael Boldizar and observed a Michael Boldiszar, born Michigan (12 Mile & Greenfield area). This check showed this to be a current address for Boldiszar. I performed a search thru the Secretary of State database and located Michael Joseph Boldiszar, w/m, born These results also showed Boldiszar to have a valid Michigan driver's license, registered at able to obtain photos of Boldiszar thru the Secretary of State images. The age, race of Boldiszar and location of his home in Berkley match what Chris Busch told investigators about Michael "Boldiyar." I performed a check thru the Michigan LEIN system and found that Michael Joseph Boldiszar has a Certified Criminal History (CCH) in Michigan for the following offenses: 4/77-Larceny in Southfield, 4/83-MDOP in Berkley, 11/87-Felony Dangerous Drugs in Oak Park, 7/88-Felony Assault w/ Dangerous Weapon in Madison Heights, 8/90-OUIL Oak.Cty. Shrfs, 9/90-CCW Berkley PD, 9/97-2 traf offenses in Troy, 7/99-Driving While Revoked in Berkley, 10/02-OUIL 3rd in MSP-21. It's possible this Bolidszar was more of an associate of Busch's than a victim. Boldiszar was 18 years old at the time of our abduction/murders.

3-2-08: While working on the "time-line" for the current Green & Busch investigation, I noticed that Busch, when being interviewed on 1-28-77, by Doan & Cattel at Flint PD, described his flight from England to the U.S. Feb. 14th, 1976. Busch told Detectives that he flew from London to New York to Chicago and then into Flint Bishop Airport where his parents picked him up and they went directly home to Birmingham. Approximately an hour or two later, when Busch was telling the MSP polygraph Examiner Cabot, when he arrived back in the U.S. from England, he stated that he flew into Detroit Metro Airport. Cabot has Detroit Metro in his notes and on his report.

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I also noticed while doing this "time-line," that Green told Cabot during his pre-polygraph interview, that he was released from the mental institution 1-15-76. Green also told Detectives Waldren & Miller, during the interview, after his arrest on 1-25-77, that he was released from Patton State Mental Hospital in California on 1-15-76. Records from California Dept. of Justice, Bureau of Identification and teletypes in the file from 1978, both show that Green was discharged from the mental hospital on 7-21-1975. If Green was in-fact released from the mental hospital on 7-21-1975, then he may have been back in Michigan and possibly associating with Busch, several months prior to the first OCCk victim, Mark Stebbins being abducted, 2-15-1976.

One of the other noteworthy items from the "Time-Line," was something Busch mentioned to the Montmorency Detective, during his interview after his arrest on 3-3-77. Busch was talking about the boys from the Flint area that he would bring up to his father's cottage on Ess lake, and he said that he had his first women up to the cottage approximately two weeks ago. This could possibly have been around the time that Kristine Mihelich was missing, found 1-21-77.

3-3-08: I was talking to John Oulett (FBI) today and told him about Boldiszar. John stated that Ray Anger from Berkley PD conducted extensive interviews of employees at Hartfields Bowling Alley after Kristine Mihelich's abduction. Mihelich's mother, Deborah Ashcroft worked as a bartender at Hartfields at the time of Kristine's disappearance. Kristine used to frequent the bowling alley to visit her mother. John Oulett stated that he thought he remembers that the police were looking at a local 18 year-old guy at that time that frequented the bowling alley. We are going to look thru the interview reports to see if the 18 year-old may have been Boldiszar and if Busch & Green, may also have been mentioned by employees.

3-3-08: I talked to Jason Bolinger (FBI) today, about getting the lead sent to New York to interview and swab Charles Busch for DNA. This is Christopher Busch's only living family member that we can get DNA from.

3-3-08: ***(Identified Chad Nikle today, one of Greg Green's ex-celimates from prison)***
We had received a list of Green's cellmates that he was with during his years in prison, from the Assistant Warden of Jackson Prison, Cindy Ackers. One of the people on the list was a guy named Chad Nikle, that was doing time for CSC 1st Degree (child u/13), the same thing Green was serving time for. Nikel was charged with his CSC in Genesee County. I determined that Nikle is from the Flint area and now resides in Flint, where Green grew up. They may have possible had a lot to talk about. I performed a search thru MDOC and located Chad William Nikle, w/m, as a search thru the Michigan LEIN system, showed Nikle to have been discharged from Department of Corrections in 2004 on his CSC case. Nikle is currently a registered sex-offender that resides at I was able to obtain several photos of Nikle thru the Secretary of States Imaging system. *** (See Nikle file for further info) ****

Cindy Ackers also sent us information on Gregory Green's family and about his death. According to Akers, Greg Green died of a heart-attack while watching TV in his cell in 1995. The guards found him sitting up with his eyes open. Because of his position and his eyes being open, his death was not discovered for a long period of time. Cindy Ackers also supplied us with Green's brother's names, who visited Green in December of 1995, shortly before his death. One brother is James D. Green, w/m.
