TO THE CONTRIBUTORS OF THE TIM KING FUND:

As an eleven-year-old boy, Tim's world was neighborhood oriented. Much of his recreational time was spent at the Adams School playground and in participating in other athletic events near home. When we were making the funeral arrangements, we preferred that any tributes be used for these purposes. Hence, we established the Tim King Fund.

We felt that tributes might be made by our friends, neighbors and relatives. We did not anticipate the substantial contributions from those persons whom we do not know. In response to this generosity, we wish to use a portion of the Tim King Fund for the care of children who have been physically abused. This is in recognition of the support of the entire community during our crisis.

The contributions to the Tim King Fund exceed \$6,000. Because of the amount involved, we have established a trust to administer it. One half of the annual income will be used for the construction or maintenance of recreational facilities in the Birmingham, Michigan area for use by boys and girls in the age group 10 to 12 years. The remaining income will be used for the benefit of children who have been physically abused. These distributions will be made at the discretion of the Trustees. All of the distributions will be for charitable purposes, and it is our intention that all your contributions to the Tim King Fund shall be deductible as charitable contributions.

Tim was a very special person to all of us. As the youngest member of our family he brought special meaning to all our lives. Your generosity will enable us in some small way to help other children in a manner which he would enthusiastically approve. We thank you very, very much.
