Vincent DePaul Society camp overlooking Lake Huron in Port Sanilac.

Mark Stebbins, a 12-year-old Ferndale youth who was kidnapped and murdered in February 1976, attended that camp a few years before his death. His brother, Michael, who also attended the camp, said he knew of no incidents at the camp involving Mark or any other campers.

Police attached to the Oakland County Homicide Task Force — which is investigating the child murders — said there is no evidence linking Father Berthiaume to Mark Stebbins or any of the murder victims in south Oakland County. They said the violation which allegedly occurred at Camp Ozanam is "an isolated incident."

Father Berthiaume has been free on a \$50,000 personal bond since Sept. 6.

He was arraigned on the new charge, involving a different boy, Monday in 47th (Farmington Hills) District Court before Judge Michael Hand and released on a second \$50,000 personal bond. He is expected to be arraigned on the Sanilac charge Tuesday.
