

Second Man Arrested In Baseball Molest

HUNTINGTON BEACH — A second man has been arrested in connection with alleged child molestations by a Little League baseball coach, police disclosed Wednesday.

Officers said Edgar H. Mohan Jr., 45, of 8881 Vestavia Ave., Buena Park, sponsor of a team in the Fountain Valley South

Little League, has been arrested on suspicion of allegedly conspiring with Gregory H. Greene, 24, "for the . . . purposes of multiple child molestations."

Greene, a coach in the league who listed no permanent address, was arrested Friday following an investigation that began when a 12-year-old boy was

left on the lawn of Huntington Inter-Community Hospital about 1 a.m. Friday.

According to police, the unconscious boy was the victim of an apparent assault. Police reported the youth's parents said he had gone to a drive-in movie with a baseball coach.

A police statement said the charges against the two men resulted from a joint investigation by detectives in Huntington Beach, Fountain Valley and Newport Beach police departments.

Police said Mohan sponsored the team through a Garden Grove firm which he managed.

"Investigation is continuing into the possibility that the suspects have been involved in repeated incidents of child molestation over a period of the last two years," police here said.

Newport Beach police said they wanted Mohan on suspicion of 16 counts of child molestation, conspiracy and related charges, and Greene on suspicion of 19 similar counts.
