

Four Police Departments File Molest Charge Against Coach

HUNTINGTON BEACH—Four police departments have filed charges of child molestation against a Little League baseball coach and another has filed charges against a team sponsor in an investigation that began when a 12-year-old boy was found unconscious on a hospital lawn last Friday.

A spokesman for the district attorney's office at the municipal court in Westminster said charges have been filed by four departments against Gregory Greene, 24, a coach in the Fountain Valley South Little League.

The charges allege Greene sexually assaulted 11 victims, all juveniles under the age of 14.

Charged with assaults involving four victims was Edgar Mohan, 45, of 8881 Vestavia Ave., Buena Park. Mohan sponsored a team through a Garden Grove firm he managed, police said.

Charges against Greene have been filed by police in Huntington Beach, Fountain Valley, Westminster and Newport Beach, the district attorney's office said. Charges against Mo-

han were filed by Newport Beach police. All are being processed in the Westminster court.

Greene, who listed no permanent address, was arraigned Wednesday on charges filed by Huntington Beach police and is scheduled to have a preliminary hearing Aug. 28.

Greene is slated for further arraignment today on charges filed by the other departments. His bail, originally set at \$200,000, was reduced to \$20,000 but may be increased

after the additional arraignment.

Mohan was held under \$100,000 bail and is scheduled for arraignment today.

Police filed the initial charges against Greene after an investigation that began when the boy was found on the lawn of Huntington Intercommunity Hospital on Beach Boulevard, last Friday morning.

Police said the youth "apparently had been the victim of an assault and was unconscious at the time." The boy's parents told police their son had gone to

a drive-in movie with a baseball coach, police said.

The youth was discharged Monday from Orange County Medical Center, where he was transferred from Huntington Intercommunity Hospital, a medical center spokesman said.
