Case History:

On February 15, 1976, a Mark Stebbins, 12 years, of 429 E. Saratoga, Ferndale was reported missing and on 2-19-76 his body was found in a parking lot. Victim had been sexually assaulted. Examinee has been arrested on a morals charge involving a young boy. Examinee's family live in Birmingham and he admits being in that area at the time of the victim's disappearance. He denies having anything to do with the killing of Mark Stebbins.

Person(s) Examined: Christopher Brian Busch,

Report:

During the pretest interview, Chris Busch admits having a sexual problem which he is not proud of. Stated he is attracted to young males in the twelve and thirteen year age bracket and has tried to pick up young boys. Admits that he has had affairs with young boys but denies knowing or having anything to do with the Stebbins boy. Stated that he did fly back from England and arrived at Metro Airport about February 14, 1976. That he don't remember for sure but believed that he stayed a couple days at his parents home in Birmingham before going back up north.
