PSI CRIME DESCRIPTION: On 10/1/83 in Wayne County, 10-yr-old V's father allowed the boy to stay w/ P, who was a co-worker. P and V watched TV in a building next to P's trailer. As they watched television, P pinched V's nipples, rubbed his chest & fondled his penis. V was forced to perform oral sex on P. P took V into his trailer and had the boy take off his clothing, get on the bed and pull his legs to his chest. P put lotion on his own penis and anally penetrated V's rectum. After the assault, P gave V pop w/ wine in it and V fell asleep.

PRISONER'S STATEMENT/VERSION: P states V had been asking to stay w/ him and V's father finally agreed. P describes the offense as "just fooling around" and denies that he put his penis in V's rectum - says the penis was placed *against* the rectum. P stated the sexual acts were performed by mutual agreement and that the 10-yr-old V was not ordered to do anything. P says he paid the boy \$5 for a blow job, but did not offer him any money for the additional sexual acts.

PERSONAL HISTORY:

FAMILY: Father and Mother both alive and together at the time of the instant offense – mother very supportive; 4 brothers and 3 sisters. P states he has a good relationship w/ his mother and father. Father, a 21-yr reformed alcoholic, retired after an industrial injury. Father was verbally abusive when he was drinking and P states the home environment was chaotic and unstable and burdens and responsibilities were put on him.

P's mother states that P was a normal kid while he was growing up and was reliable, helpful and dependable. She says he is very close to the family and has never had difficulty relating to people on an adult level. P relates especially well to children and states all of his nieces and nephews are very fond of him. She does not know anything bad about P except for "this little quirk that he has that flares up every once in a while." He does not have a temper or carry a grudge and has never known him to behave in a violent or assaultive manner. In regard to the instant offense, P stated, "Mom, I just slipped again".

EDUCATION: Graduated from High School while at MTU and given an institutional diploma in 1960 or 1961. IQ test showed 122.

EMPLOYMENT: Working as a wrecking operator and was on a leave of absence due to the instant offense.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE: Experimented w/ marijuana in 1978.

MENTAL HEALTH: P's sister had P committed to the Clinton Valley Center in Pontiac in 1983. His sister began to notice P's behavior, which involved P watching his 10 & 11 year old nephews when they were bathing or sleeping, and she was afraid he needed help again. Psychosexual therapy 8/79 – 5/83.
