Information from **Sharon Norberg**, wife of suspect David Norberg.

December 1991. Sharon Norberg was interviewed and placed under hypnosis by Dr. Steve Miller, Detroit, Michigan. The sessions with Dr. Miller were videotaped.

Sharon Norberg described the following **items, from a small, wooden box**, about 4 inches square, that belonged to her husband, David Norberg. The wooden box was inside a shoe box. The wooden box was opened following his death in 1981, in the State of Wyoming. Present at that time were other members of David's family, brothers and sisters. Sharon Norberg believes the items belonged to the children David killed.

ITEM 1: "Kristine" cross. **KRISTINE MICHELICH** (Identified as by aunt as belonging to Kristine Michelich.) Sharon observed the cross, once before, in the box, in Warren, Michigan, before they moved to Wyoming. Cross is cheaply made, is 1 1/4 inches long, and 3/4 inches across. Engraved, freehand, "Kristine". When observed in Michigan had a thin silver chain attached. In Wyoming, the chain is missing. Cross given to Kristine "Tina" Norberg (sister).

ITEM 2: Paratrooper pin, "Blood wings". Worn on Army uniform. Given to David's mother.

ITEM 3: Divorce papers from first marriage with Shirley Jean Norberg.

ITEM 4: Military papers. Court martial file. Discharge papers.

ITEM 5: Bank deposit book. David Norberg and Janice or Janet - K. or R. - Schipprio or Schippa'rio. Believes the name is "Janice K. Schippa'rio". Last entry in bank book is a \$1000 deposit, June 20, 1977. Detroit Bank and Trust.

ITEM 6: Pocket knife, similar to a Swiss Army knife. Has spoon, file, cork screw, and can opener, white and blue. Given to brother Albert Norberg.

ITEM 7: Cuff links, black onyx, square with round diamond. David received in Ohio when selling Miracle Maid.

ITEM 8: Women's pin. Cameo style, old fashion, white star, filigree, small. Given to sister Diane or Gloria.

ITEM: 9 Stick pin/tie tac. Long with a little head.

ITEM 10: St. Christopher's metal. **TIMOTHY KING** (Mr. & Mrs. King, parents, state Timothy's St. Christopher metal is missing.) No reason to have a religious metal and David did not attend church and was not Catholic.

ITEM 11: Scout pin. JILL ROBINSON Small, round bronze. (Jill Robinson was a girl scout.)

ITEM 12: Fuzzy green and yellow caterpillar type worm. JILL ROBINSON Mrs. Robinson states her daughter had a green worm pin that she hasn't found.) The worm moved when touched. Funny, big, plastic eyes. Fuzzy looking, about 4 inches long, one inch wide. Something like a person would get at a fair. Given to brother Bobby Norberg.

ITEM 13: Knife. Thick, yellow and green, paint scraped off. Two initials with periods, very fine, like a little boy would scratch onto the knife. Unable to read initials. Opposite side of knife had something removed, oblong shape, now bare.

ITEM 14: Necklace, baby or toddler type. Silver chain with dark red or green, tiny stones.

ITEM 15: Religious Medal. Catholic type metal. Silver. No chain. Oval shaped with center cutout. Two figures, Mary and baby wrapped in blanket. Letters/writing in Latin. Also, Sandra or Sheila written on back side of medal. Unknown which family member received this item.

ITEM 16: TieTac, bar type. Gold and red, with a stone. About 3 inches long.

ITEM 17: Church Pin. Round, back has a square design. About the size of a dime. Bronze color. Church building with steeple. Bible verse - "Blessed are the peace makers for they shall become the children of God". Something else scratched on pin, unknown what.

ITEM 18: UAW pin.

ITEM 19: Cameo Necklace. White lady in ivory color, with high collar, ruffles, hair bun, old fashion looking, on black onyx with gold base. May be a locket that opens. Has female name scratched on back, possible "Sue" and "Kathleen" or "Katravina". Name scratched with an instrument like the point of a knife. Not well written.

Items from a Tool Box:

ITEM 1: Dildo, sex aid. BenWal balls. Plastic butt plugs.

ITEM 2: Magazines: Playboy. Penthouse. Others of bondage with whips and chains, female dominance. Others with women having sex with animals.
