

OAKLAND COUNTY CHILD KILLER INVESTIGATION

VICTIM: **Stanley Roy Whiteaker**, DOB White Male. LKA - 2648
Belmont Ave., New Smyrna Beach, Florida 32069 (904) 423-3055.

Crime: Attempted Criminal Sexual Conduct

Occurred: Winter 1971 or 1972. About 12 inches of snow on ground.

SUSPECT: **David Norberg**, age 26, White Male. Living with wife, Sharon Norberg in Shelby/Utica area at time.

Incident information:

Victim Whiteaker was about 11/12 years of age and hungout at Longhorn Ranch, 25 Mile Road and Vandyke, Washington, Michigan. Suspect Norberg also hungout at the Longhorn Ranch, often hanging around young boys and girls, drinking beer, and often buying beer and partying with the youngsters. David Norberg took Stanley Whiteaker to a farm house on M21, north side of highway, near Imlay City. They drank beer together and Norberg began talking about getting laid (sex). Norberg told Whiteaker that he had been in prison, had sex in prison, and that the prisoners took care of each other. Whiteaker knew Norberg was making a sexual pass at him, fled the farm house, running towards home.

Mrs. Bonnie Whiteaker (mother) stated she received a phone call from her son who told her a "fag" made a pass at him. She left her house, drove in the direction given by her son, and met him running her direction.

Stanley Whiteaker stated he reported the incident to the Michigan State Police, who came to the Longhorn Ranch, took a handgun away from Norberg. Norberg never bothered him again. D/Sgt. Anger checked with MSP Romeo Post, no record of incident with Norberg and/or Whiteaker.

Jerry Kenyon, 4723 Benren, Shelby Township (810) 731-6339. States he owned a horse and was president of a riding club at the Longhorn Ranch. He described Norberg as a drinker, bulls--ter, and person who liked to act macho. Kenyon recalls Whiteaker asking him if Norberg was gay.

During the time of the child killings, Jerry Kenyon recalls that David Norberg

was employed at Chrysler's and was reading a bible and belonged to a plant bible study group. This action was 180 degrees different from the personality of Norberg when he knew him in 1971/72.
