Cory Williams: (Uh, what we're here, here doin' today is we're, we're workin' on old, uh, serial homicide case back from back in the seventies; late seventies; where uh four kids were kidnapped and molested and killed back then.) Ummm...during the course of our investigation, a guys name came up, named Greg Greene and uh, I...I know, we know from doin' our, doin' some background and that you were in a cell either with him or next to him when he died back in ninety five?

Chad Nichol: Yea.

Cory Williams: UNCLEAR you remember Greg?

Chad Nichol: Yea.

Cory Williams: Okay. What we're, what we're lookin' to do and the reason we're comin' to talk to you is...first of all let me just say it for the tape, uh, today is Chad Nichol here. We're interviewin' Chad at his home on at eleven thirty East Coldwater in Flint. Detective Sergeant Gary Gray is present, myself Detective Williams from Livonia Police and we're talkin' to Chad Nichol about uh, possibly some information about Greg Greene. Um...like I said we're not t...we're not tryin' to get you jammed up with anything. Um...we're hopin' that maybe Greg might have said somethin' to you about any type of involvement in somethin' like that, or, or, talked to you about somethin'. I know uh...Gary knows, Detective Gray knows from, from doin' this job for twenty something years, the same with myself, that, when you're in, when you're in the

joint, and you're, you're with people, 'specially both you guys were from Flint, from the Flint area, you were both in for the same, for the same thing UNCLEAR ...

Chad Nichol: Yea. Well, when he died, they, they thought I, I was commitin', gonna commit suicide. So they put me in a room by myself...

Cory Williams: You...

Chad Nichol: ... after that happened.

Cory Williams: ...you guys were pretty close.

Chad Nichol: Yea we, I see, our T.V.'s were stacked on each other to watch. He watched football, I watch what I wanna watch.

Cory Williams: Um, hmm.

Chad Nichol: And we'll go to s...we'll both go to store get what he wanted, like cheeseburgers; we ate cheeseburgers that day. And the next day we'll get like pizza or somethin'. Somethin' different every other day.

Cory Williams: Hmm...How long were, were you together with Greg in a?

Chad Nichol: Uh...

Cory Williams: You were in the same cell?

Chad Nichol: Yea.

Cory Williams: Okay. How long do you think that was?

Chad Nichol: That was in Lapeer...I, I got locked up, I was in...first I went to M...uh, Ionia first and they transferred me to MR, from MR to uh...Lapeer. I had been there, I think it was jus' a couple years I was there.

Cory Williams: With Greg?

Chad Nichol: Well, at UNCLEAR, well I had a room like by myself and then you had to...bunk, bunk with people and stuff.

Cory Williams: Okay. Let me just say somethin' to ya, just so you know where we're comin' from. Detective Gray and myself have not only investigaed homicide cases, we've investigated numerous cases

involving guys that are into pedophilia into, into kids, you know? So we, we know from, from our experience the guys, share stories. You share stories with guys, and uh, that are into the same thing that you're into. So, I'm sure you and Greg, I mean, you had a lot of time to talk probably talked about somethings, and like I said, even, even if he said somethin' to you Chad, we're not lookin' to jam you up. We're lookin' for help on this thing. These families I mean, there're four of these kids that were killed, and uh...these families are lookin' for some closure on this thing. It's been thirty years and uh...if, if Greg said somethin' to you that peaked your interest, or your eyebrows went up one day or said something kinda strange to ya, or said directly to ya, maybe you can tell us.

Chad Nichol: He never really said anything to me really off, off hand.

Cory Williams: Did you talk about k...about kids that you'd had in the past?

Chad Nichol: Oh, I had, he was in the same group I was in. The, I had to go to this class, the, for sex offenders.

Cory Williams: Um, hmm.

Chad Nichol: And L...and Lapeer has, I've got the, the instructors name off hand. He had us do like, how, how you feel about what you did and all that stuff tuh kids, and uh...had to do like a b...a book, a book like this, 'bout this thick, tuh...UNCLEAR I know every...everywhere I went I had to go to c...tuh uh classes for, tuh...new joint I had to do the same thing all...all over again when I was, when I was there. And I forgot the uh...one...the...guys name that's holdin'...hold...that hold the class. He, his wife used to be a correction officer at Lapeer. And he was the one that hold, was holdin' the classes for uh sex offenders.

Cory Williams: Um, hmm.

Chad Nichol: And I forgot his name off hand so we had tuh, write d...write somethin' down...how did you feel this day, and stuff like that; and...

Cory Williams: Okay, I'm not, I'm not exactly talkin' about what you guys did at classes.

Chad Nichol: Oh.

Cory Williams: I'm talkin' about conversations that you had in the cell with Greg about things you guys have, I mean...we're not, like I said, w...a

lot of things that, that we're asking we already know the answers to.

Chad Nichol: Yea.

Cory Williams: I wanna see if you're gonna be straight with me today. I know you're a registered sex offender.

Chad Nichol: Yep.

Cory Williams: Are you taking care of that all the time?

Chad Nichol: Yes indeed.

Cory Williams: Registerin' when you're supposed to?

Chad Nichol: Yep. I do that next month.

Cory Williams: Okay. Make sure you do that on time, okay? UNCLEAR

Chad Nichol: Oh yea, I do that uh...the second day of...well I ain't do it on the first. I do it on the second.

Cory Williams: Um, hmm. And you're registerin' at this address, correct?

Chad Nichol: Yep.

Cory Williams: Okay. What I'm askin' ya, Chad, is conversations that you and Greg had over, when you were alone talkin' about things, and...I'm sure you got into some conversations about things you've done in the past. And...I mean, everybody does. That's what you're doin', that's what you're doin' there, you're killin' time, right?

Chad Nichol: Yea.

Cory Williams: UNCLEAR shit. Um...so I don't wanna, I don't wanna catch you t...not tellin' me the truth, is what I'm sayin' to ya, okay?

Chad Nichol: Yea.

Cory Williams: Um...did you have conversations about that kind of stuff? What you did in the past? With Greg?

Gary Gray: Okay, before you, before you answer that...we've done our homework, okay? Yea, so, just make sure you're, you're just

straight up. No we're not, we're not lookin' tuh jam you up at all; but it's not completely out of the question. Okay, not for anything that you've done recently, or anything like that. We don't want to get you in trouble in lying to us and things of that sort. Alright, and that's a serious thing, especially with your status. And then we, we, we register, the, you know, we, we work it all the time with the state police. We've checked on it and that, that's no, that's, and you're, and you're fine, we checked. You're no problem! Made sure of that, you know. What we, what we don't wanna do is have to jam you up with anything that...you know, with, if you're UNCLEAR, 'cause we've talked to a lot of people; even guys that you used to bunk with; back in the, back in the, uh, in the places, so we're seein' you for last, just to see if you're gonna give us the straight skinny some.

Chad Nichol:

Right.

Cory Williams:

Just make sure, when you're answerin' questions, just be truthful, so, you're, you're not in any trouble. I'll tell you right now, let's not take, you're not in any trouble. Alright?

Cory Williams:

Now we're, I want you to consider, the seriousness of what we're talkin' about here. These were kids that were not only molested, but they were killed, and it's been thirty years. These families, these families are lookin' at us. We've been workin' on this three and a half years. We've been all over the country interviewing. Greg came up as a, as a serious suspect in this thing and if he said something to you, we need your help.

Chad Nichol:

See one thing is, he, he never talked to me about his case or anything like that.

Cory Williams:

What did he talk to you about?

Chad Nichol:

Talked about how, he was like, how his, how his dad was livin'. A...s...His dad like, his d...I think his...member...remember how his dad had passed away...and, other than that I just...I ain't try and say anything, but, that's the only thing we was really talkin' about.

Cory Williams:

(Cough) How long were you in the cell with 'em?

Chad Nichol:

Uh...

Gary Gray: I got the exact dates. I can give you, I can give you from what day to what day. So, I wanna hear it from you, how long were you with 'em?

Chad Nichol: Uh...I can't remember off hand. It's been a w...

Gary Gray: Okay, well, approximately. I know it's been a while. It's been a UNCLEAR of a while.

Chad Nichol: Now, for three years.

Gary Gray: Alright. How many years did you do altogether?

Chad Nichol: I did uh...I got eight to twenty and I did ele...eleven years.

Gary Gray: Okay, that, that's a good stretch there. That's a lot of time.

Cory Williams: Was Greg an artist? Was he into drawing and stuff like that, or no?

Chad Nichol: Not that I know of, no.

Cory Williams: No? Okay, alright. What I'm asking you Chad, is, you were in a cell with him, for approximately a couple a years with the guy.

Chad Nichol: Okay.

Cory Williams: And you're tellin' me, you had no conversations about anything other than his dad died?

Chad Nichol: Naw, I mean that's, that's a, I mean, about it.

Cory Williams: Okay.

Chad Nichol: I mean, yea I would talk...

Cory Williams: Are you on p...are you on parole now?

Chad Nichol: No, I'm off of it.

Cory Williams: It's off, okay.

Chad Nichol: Been off for three years now.

Cory Williams: Okay. Okay, never gave you any hint...did you, did you not discuss...

Gary Gray: Did he say to you, once again I'll go back, did he say to you, when you guys were in the cell together, that I killed four kids? Yes or no he said that?

Chad Nichol: Yea he said that!

Gary Gray: Okay. And he, and you said earlier that he got away with it?

Chad Nichol: He said he got away with it.

Gary Gray: Okay, but he was in prison for doing other sex crimes with kids, but he got away with killin' four kids, was he like jokin' about it, like, huh, hell I did four k...I killed four kids and got away with it, an...I don't know; tell me.

Chad Nichol: Yea he said he killed four kids, an...he was, besides doin' that, he molested some other kids.

Gary Gay: Um, hmm. Which caused him to go to the joint anyway, right?

Chad Nichol: Yea, UNCLEAR...

Cory Williams: Did he say anything about when he molested kids in other states? Did he mention anything about bein' in prison in another state, or anything like that? Does that ring a bell with ya?

Chad Nichol: Umm...naw, no.

Cory Williams: No?

Chad Nichol: No it don't.

Cory Williams: Okay.

Gary Gray: Chad how far, how far did you go in school?

Chad Nichol: Eleventh grade.

Gary Gray: Okay. Well...

Chad Nichol: Well, I might say ninth grade I, I was in special ed. They passed me.

Gary Gray: Okay so you were uh, they let you go, and, or you quit in the eleventh grade?

Chad Nichol: Yea they had, I was in like special ed class.

Gary Gray: Okay. What umm, all through school when you were little all the way up through? Alright, well we're not tryin' tuh, we're not tryin' tuh confuse you at all. We just want the truth from you as much as you can remember. Has this been bothering you for a while? Does it ever come, does it ever bother you that he told you that?

Chad Nichol: Every once in a while it does. I been...I read stuff backward 'cause I got uh...dyslexius.

Gary Gray: Okay.

Chad Nichol: Well, my ma, she said I don't but I know I do.

Cory Williams: But that's, that's, over the years did, did you ever think uh, man I should, I should tell somebody about this? I should've told somebody about that?

Chad Nichol: It came across, yea I should've.

Gary Gray: Okay, what I wanna do is this, and Cory and I we've discussed this. We've been workin' on this case for, eh, quite a long time. Tell you what, what I wanna do is this; now I'll pick you up, and w...we'll pick you up.

Cory Williams: Yep.

Gary Gray: That's all we wanna know. That's all I wanna know. I, I mean, I'm not gonna, you're not in trouble, Let me tell you somethin' right now...

Chad Nichol:

Gary Gray:

Chad Nichol: Okay.

Gary Gray: How can that get you in trouble, unless you know, but don't, don't lie to me, though.

I think you're being honest with us, I mean why would you cry like that? I mean we got you out of the house, I mean outta your mom's ear shot and get a little more comfortable.

Cory Williams: Yea.

Gary Gray: You dropped this on us and we're all excited.

Cory Williams: Yea.

Gary Gray: I'm 'bout ready to jump outta my skin right now.

Cory Williams: But you don't wanna make us jump through hoops.

Gary Gray: Yea.

Cory Williams: If, if it, if it's not the truth, but if he did tell you that and that's the truth, then like I said, stick to that, if that's the truth.

Gary Gray: We're not done investigating it, we're gonna keep doin' it. We gotta do that. But you're a integral part of this. So why don't we as...um gonna ask you this right now, and it's a free, its' a freebie. I...If you're making this up just tuh, to appease us, please don't. But if you know, an...an...an...that's okay, but if you're not, the...then we're, we're gonna go forward.

So, I'm gonna ask ya about the third or fourth time, did Greg Greene say to you, when you guys were bunkin' together, that he killed four kids?

Chad Nichol: He, yes he told me that.

Gary Gray: Okay, that's, that's all I wanna know. Alright, hey, l...let me do this. I know you gotta get to work right now.

Cory Williams: Do you need a ride to work?

Chad Nichol: No, UNCLEAR right down the street.

Gary Gray: Okay, l...let's do this. You're not gonna get in trouble are ya?

Chad Nichol: No.

Gary Gray: You missin' work 'cause if you did, I don't want you to do that.

Cory Williams: Where do you work? Tell me...

Chad Nichol: Party store.

Cory Williams: On the corner here?

Chad Nichol: Yea.

Cory Williams: Okay.

Gary Gray: Alright, let's do this, and we're gonna give you our card.

Chad Nichol: UNCLEAR

Gary Gray: What's that?

Chad Nichol: UNCLEAR cards.

Gary Gray: UNCLEAR

Cory Williams: I wanna, uh, uh, you know, while Sergeant Gray is gettin' the card for ya, I wanna reassure you that you don't have to worry, okay? I don't want you tuh worry, but we're gonna need, at some point here Chad, we're gonna, and I want you tuh really think about it, we're gonna need the details about what he said to you, okay? Chad, you listenin'?

Chad Nichol: Yea, I'm listenin'.

Cory Williams: Okay, alright.

Gary Gray: Chad, do you, do you, uh, ever do any writing or anything of that sort? I mean, do you ever write notes, or...do you uh, i...is your...

Chad Nichol: Naw, I can't spell that good.

Gary Gray: Well, I can't either. That's why I'm glad we got spell check. Let me ask you this, c...would it be okay if I were to ask you tuh, tonight when you get home from work or whatever, tomorrow, or Saturday if you have time, write out on paper what you remember. Can you do that for us?

Chad Nichol: Yea, if I can spell.

Gary Gray: Aww, shit, I, I'm not gonna s...I'm not gonna grade it (laughing)! So do that alright? Can you do that for me?

Chad Nichol: I can...

Gary Gray: Try to do that, or you know, if you have a lot of trouble with a word you can't spell ask your mom or whate...or when we come again we get together, we'll, we'll correct, don't worry about it. This is just something you can put on paper, that you remember. A lot of, a lot of times you can remember a lot when you're writing.

Cory Williams: UNCLEAR

Gary Gray: That's it. You go back and just scratch off and do that, umm, but let's do that 'cause we're gonna come back,
W...what's your phone number where we can reach you at? What's your cell number? Give me your cell number.

County man faces sex charge

A Birmingham man, who this week was released on bond after being charged with criminal sexual conduct in Oakland County, has been charged on a similar offense in northern Michigan.

Authorities said Christopher Busch, 25, of 3310 Morningview, is in the Montmorency County Jail in Atlanta on a charge stemming from a homosexual act involving a 14-year-old boy at a cabin north of Hillman. Police would not say when the offense occurred.

He was returned to Atlanta for arraignment following his arrest in Oakland County Wednesday.

On Tuesday, Busch had been released on \$12,000 bond, and ordered to obey a 7

p.m. curfew imposed at his arraignment before District Judge Gerald McNally on charges of having sexual relations with a 12-year-old boy in Groveland Township.

Busch is scheduled to have a preliminary court hearing in that case Thursday before McNally.

In addition to the charges in Oakland and Montmorency counties, Busch and two other men were charged last month with having sexual relations with young boys in Flint.

The three men allegedly used gifts, threats and physical force to persuade 12- to-14-year-old boys to engage in sexual acts and lewd photography sessions, according to Flint authorities.
