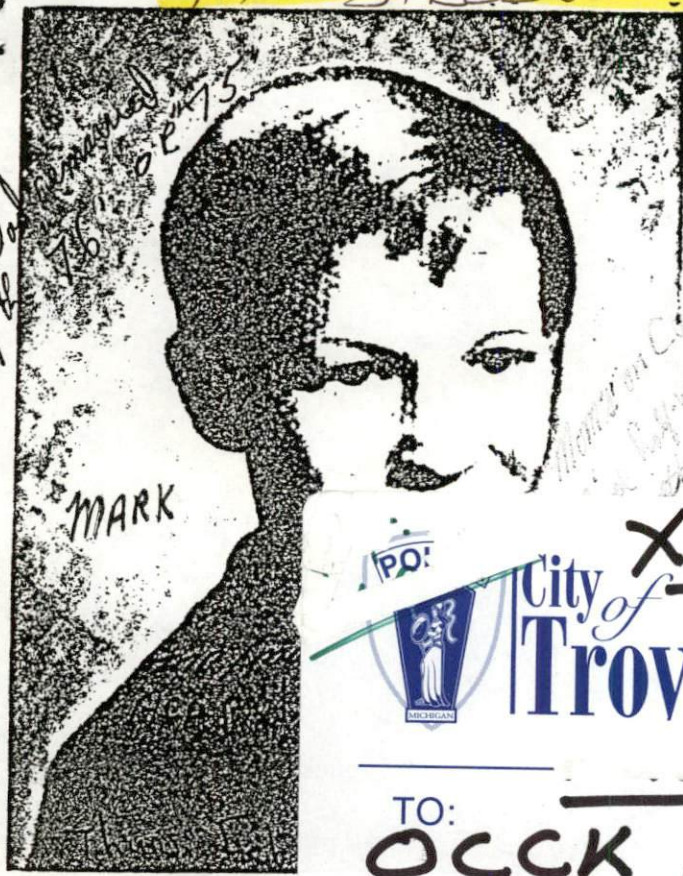

ON FEBRUARY 19, 1976, A WITNESS OBSERVED A CAR NEAR THE SCENE WHERE MARK STEBBINS' BODY WAS FOUND. THE CAR WAS DESCRIBED AS A SMALL PONTIAC OR BUICK. NO COLOR COULD BE GIVEN, BUT IT WAS A SHINY CAR.

ON DECEMBER 26, 1976, AT ABOUT 3:30 A. M., A WITNESS SAW A LIGHT BLUE 1967 PONTIAC TEMPEST WITH PRIMER SPOTS ON THE LEFT SIDE ON THE SHOULDER OF N.B. 1-75, NEAR THE SCENE WHERE JILL ROBINSON'S BODY WAS FOUND.

ON JANUARY 21, 1977, NEAR THE SCENE WHERE KRISTINE MIHELICH'S BODY WAS FOUND, OFFICERS FOUND MARKS IN THE SNOW BANKS WHERE A VEHICLE HAD RECENTLY TURNED AROUND. AFTER HUNDREDS OF HOURS OF RESEARCH, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT THE MARKS IN THE SNOW WERE MADE BY A 1964-1967 PONTIAC TEMPEST OR BUICK SKYLARK.

ON MARCH 16, 1977, AT THE SCENE OF TIMMY KING'S ABDUCTION, A BLUE WITH A WHITE HOCKEY STRIPE GREMLIN WAS SEEN.

IT IS REASONABLE TO BELIEVE THAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR A PERSON THAT HAS INTERMEDIATE SIZE CARS AVAILABLE TO HIM AND PROBABLY A BLUE PONTIAC TEMPEST DURING THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY, 1976, TO JANUARY, 1977; BUT IN MARCH OF 1977, HE HAD A BLUE GREMLIN AVAILABLE TO HIM.

COINCIDENCE

What are the odds that the following
is all coincidence?

1. The killing starts right after Paul Johnson's Mom and Dad are remarried. Feb. 11th. 76
2. Mark Stebbins body would be found less than $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from where Paul's good friend and x-lover worked. This was not long after they broke up. (Roger)
3. That all the kids are killed during the winter. By all available information, Family - friends and medical records, Paul can't function in the winter.
4. Jill Robinson is grabbed on Dec. 22.
Paul goes to school at Law. Tech.
Christmas break starts on Dec. 23.
Jill's dad teaches English at O.C.C.
Royal Oak. 73-74-75 Paul attends
O.C.C. Royal Oak 74-75-76?
5. Paul's friend (Mr. Govern) says Paul asks a girl by the ^{name} of Jill to the Prom. She turned him down and he was devastated.

6. That unknown fill is shot on I-75,
12 Truck Driver sees the car pulled
off on I-75 3 of 16 mi. This location was
right in front of Paul's Mom and Dad's
apt., which faces I-75.
7. fill is shot in the head. In
subsequent conversations with Taylor
and Mr. Goveen Paul refuses to say the
name fill Robinson. He gets very
upset and refers to fill as (the other one)
8. Kristine Michelich is last seen at
a 7/11 store on 12 mile and Oakshire
in Berkeley. In a letter from Clinton
Valley, Paul is referred to Oakland County
after-care services at 2351 12 mile, Berkeley.
This is several blocks east of where
K.M. was grabbed. The pharmacy serving
this care center is about $\frac{1}{2}$ mi. west.
Mrs. Johnson (Paul's mom) stated during
an interview, that she sometimes
got upset with Paul, because he
would go to a 7/11 store and buy food
instead of eating what she had
purchased for him.

9. Kristine's body is found on Bruce Lane near 13 mile, Franklin Village.
One of four people listed as Paul's good friends in high school is Bruce Wood.
10. Per. Roger and McGovern, Paul liked to roost kids parking in this area.
11. When Watson and Taylor drove Paul down Bruce Lane, (it was at night and there was no street sign) Paul sit up in the back seat, his head bumped the windows, tears were in his eyes and ran down his cheeks. When asked what was wrong, he stated he was looking for Timmy's body. This happened right where Kristine's body had been found three years earlier.
This was the only time we ever saw Paul cry.
12. a copy of Paul's grades for Lawrence Tech. showed his worst marking period in over a year was Jan. 77 when Kristine was held.

13. Shortly after it comes out in the news that the tire tracks left at Kristine's drop site are being examined by experts, Paul gets his dad to pay for new tires for his car. Shortly after, Paul junks the car out. Paul's dad says he wasn't happy about Paul scrapping out the car. Paul's dad buys Paul a 73 buick \checkmark on Mar. 1st. 77.

14. according to Mr. Vernier (S.O.D.) Paul did not transfer the plates from the Tempest to the buick. The plates still had 10 months on them.

15. Timmy King is taken Mar. 16 77 (Wed) 8:30pm from the rear area of the Hunter Maple Pharmacy. Paul twice draws this area in detail upon request by Watson? Taylor. He states he would stop there after class to buy stationary.

16. Paul was scheduled for class on this Wednesday evening. One of Paul's Professors states Paul often wore a sport coat to school. Witness, Mrs. Hoffman

states the young man talking to Timmy was wearing a rust colored sport coat. Mike McHovern states Paul often wore a brown sport coat. McHovern said it was Paul's favorite and it had a strange odor to it.

17. Witness Mrs. Hoffman states the man talked in an even and soft manner. He sounded like a clean cut college student, educated. Paul is a soft spoken clean cut, educated college student.
18. Hoffman says the man has no visible jewelry. Paul doesn't wear or own any jewelry.
19. Mrs. Hoffman describes in great detail suspects hair (shag cut) and long sideburns. This along with her total description fits Paul perfectly.
20. The composite looks just like Paul.

24. all the kids had been washed with Phisohex soap. This is a surgical scrub, bacteriostatic skin cleanser. This soap is used primarily in hospitals and Doctors offices. Paul's mother worked for Dr. Barton at Beaumont Medical Building in Royal Oak.

25. It was believed that these children must have been sedated part of the time, as it would have been nearly impossible to watch them 24/7.

Paul was taking the following drugs.

Navine - side effect - high incidence of sedation.
Stelazine - side effect - high incidence of sedation.
Serentil - side effect - low incidence of sedation.
Tofranil - side effect - drowsiness

26. Both boys had been sodomized. There was no sperm found anywhere.
a side effect of three of the drugs listed above, (25) is inhibited ejaculation.

27. When first advised of why we were talking to Paul, (the child killings) Mrs. Johnson nearly collapsed, Mr. Johnson who remained calm, turned to Taylor and said "Prove it, if you can".
28. After many hours of research and witness information, it was determined that the car used in the first three cases was a 1964 to 67 Lt. Blue Pontiac Tempest. Paul had a Lt. Blue 64 Pontiac Tempest during the first three cases.
29. Paul Johnson is the only person who has told Police that he killed these kids. That's because, he killed them.

1. Paul is the only man who has told police that he killed these kids. He said it in 1980 and again in 1992. He refuses to say the name "Jill Robinson" not only while talking to Police, but also with his friend Mike Mc Govern. He gets very upset when asked about her. Of the four children, Jill Robinson's death was the most violent. She was shot in the head with a shotgun.

2. Paul very much looks like the composite. witness discript. fits Paul perfectly.

according to Mc Govern Paul's favorite sport coat was brown colored. Mc Govern remembered this sport coat because it had an unusual order to it.

no visible jewelry

Paul has no jewelry. (Source, Photo's & Contacts)

Speech: even and soft spoken, college type, educated.

Paul speaks very soft. He's very intelligent IQ. 150 Engineering student Lawrence Tech.

3. Of the 13 suspect characteristics set forth by the task force April 4, 1977, all but 3 fit Paul.
7. Compulsion for Cleanliness 8. no Substance abuse 10. white collar worker

4. Paul was turned into the task force 3-26-77 as a look-alike for the composite by Matt Welch. Paul's friends Mc Govern and Calagan both said the composite looked like Paul.

5. The victims had been cleaned with a soap commonly used as a surgical scrub. (Phisohex)
Paul's mother is a nurse and works at Beaumont Medical building in Royal Oak.
Mrs. Johnson ^{said} she purchased a lot of Paul's food and necessities, but denied giving him soap.
6. In Sept. 1978 the task force put out a memo stating they believe that the suspect had available to him a blue Pontiac Tempest during the period Feb. 76 to Jan. 77. Experts from G.M. ~~so~~ states 64 to 67 Pontiac Tempest or Buick. Paul has a 64 blue Pontiac Tempest. (Damage 6/8) Paul says from acc. in Flint. Dad was not happy when Paul junked the Tempest. Dad had recently paid for new tires, and new pinion gear.
7. Paul, by everyone's account goes nuts in the winter. Medical records support this. Mc Govern says Paul told him, he (Paul) likes to commit crimes in the winter, the snow covers his tracks and deadens to sound.

8. Paul's Mom and Dad are re-married Feb. 11th. 1976. Mr. Johnson first states they went to Acapulco from 15 to 22 Feb. Mrs. Johnson said they didn't go anywhere. (Copy of Lic. in main file)

9. Mark Stebbins is grabbed Feb. 15, 76
Body found. Feb. 19, 76

Mr. Johnson states he moved in with Mrs. Johnson (on Coachman) on Feb. 11th. 76.

Paul's sister Haile had already moved out of the apt. on Halfview. Now this apt. is vacant.

Paul had lived there and would have a key.

Where Mark's body is found is $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Paul's lover's ^(Roger) place of employment, Paul and Roger had broke up, according to Roger.

Paul directs Watson and Taylor to a Burger King at 10 mile and Greenfield and said he bought Tim a burger hear. This is across the street from where Mark's body was found. Paul would later state that he pushed Mark out of the car in Cinkster and there was a car coming. He also admitted he killed Mark.

10. Jill Robinson last seen Dec. 22, 76 (Royal Oak)
Body found Dec. 26, 76 on I-75 just
north of 16 Mi. Troy.

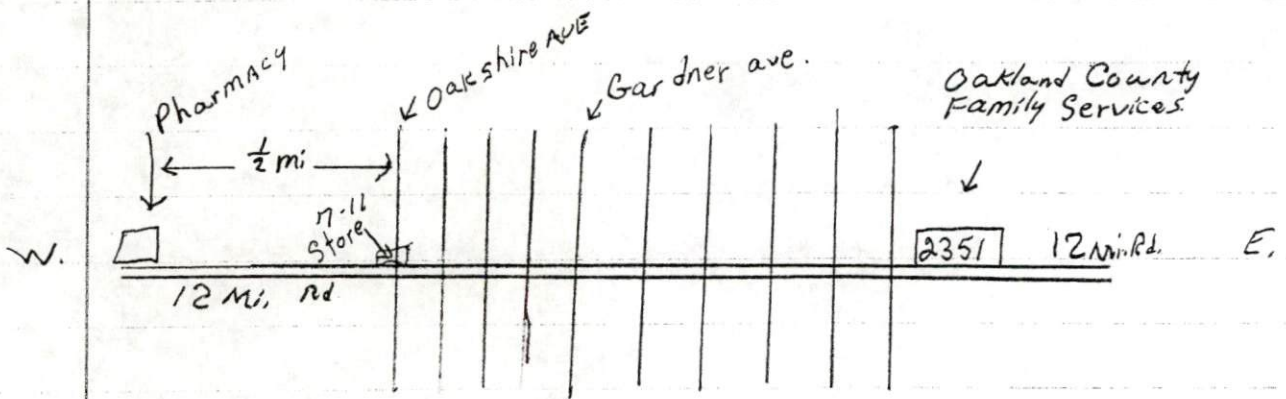
3:30 am 12/26 Truck driver is N/B on I-75.
Just 3/4 of 16 mi. before the curve, he observes
what he believes is a 67 Lt. Blue Pontiac G.T.O.
pulled off the road on N/B side. Two people
driver med. size, passenger smaller. as he
approaches brake lights come on. Believes
car has slight damage 4 rear. (Note: the car
at this time is directly in front of Paul's
Mom's Dad's apt. which faces I-75) as the

Paul will later admit to killing
Jill but will not say the name "Jill Robinson"
and gets upset and angry when questioned
about her. According to Mc Govern, Paul

Mc Govern said he warned Paul not to ask
Jill because she was a cut above him. She
turned him down, and per. Mc Govern

This really devastated Paul. It should be noted that J. R.'s dad taught at O.C.C. Royal Oak, while Paul was a student there. Paul said he got the shotgun from a friend, would not say who. Mom says Paul was at her apt. on Coachman on X-MAS day. She produced a number of pictures to prove it. (Paul had on three different outfits X-MAS day)

- 11. Kristine Mihelich last seen 7-11 party store Oaks-Ride and 12 mile, Berkley Jan. 2, 77
 In a letter dated April 30, 1976 from Clinton Valley Center Paul is sent to after-care services at 2351 12 Mi. rd., Berkley. This is several blocks east of where K.M. was grabbed. The Pharmacy serving this County Care Center was about 1/2 mile west on 12 mile. It should be noted that during an interview with Mrs. Johnson, she stated she would get upset with Paul, as she would provide him with food and he would often go to a 7-11 store and purchase food rather than open a can of food.
 K.M. body was found Jan. 21, 77 Fri.

on Bruce Lane, near 13 mile, Franklin Village. (No school, ^{Jan. 21} between terms) It is worth noting that upon checking Paul's grades for 4 years at Lawrence Tech. he had all A's Except during the time that K.M. was held, he had 1-A 2-B's.

When Watson and Taylor took Paul for a ride down Bruce Lane (it was at night, there was no street sign and we said nothing about where we were going) Paul sit up in the seat as we approached the location where K.M.'s body was found. His head bumped against the side window, He had tears in his eyes and running down his cheeks. When ask what was wrong, He said "I'm looking for Timmy's body" This was the only time I (Taylor) ever saw him cry. After many hours of research experts concluded the tire tracks and bumper impressions left in the snow by the suspect vehicle were made by a 1964 to 67 Pontiac Tempest or Buick skylark.

Per. Mr. Johnson - cts around this time Paul gets him to pay for four new tires for his (Paul's) 64 Pontiac Tempest and shortly after Paul junks the Tempest. Mr. Johnson wasn't happy.

Per. Mr. Vernier at Michigan S.O.S. when Paul got rid of the 64 Tempest he didn't transfer the lic. plates to the 73 Buick even though there was still 10 months left on them.

Paul rarely showed emotion. The only time I saw him laugh was once when he was talking about K.M. He said he had people at his apt. on Monroe. K.M. was tied up in the bedroom and no one knew it. He laughed about it. He said K.M. got burned when he had her tied to the heat radiator and he might have burned her once with a Cig. but he didn't mean to.

According to McGovern and Roger, Paul knew the area quite well where K.M. was found as he liked to roost kids parking on old Orchard trail.

Per. McGovern Paul's best friends in school were 1. Himself 2. Joe Calaghan
3. Tim Hearsley 4. Bruce Wood

Paul states he stayed with K.M. for 2 or 3 weeks and admitted killing her. Paul says he and Jimmy Carter were on the news alot. Paul stated "They'll kill me in prison for this".

12. Timmy King is last seen Mar. 16, '77 (Wed.) 8:30 pm in the parking lot at the Hunter Maple Pharmacy in Birmingham.

His body is found Mar. 22, '77 (Tues) 11¹⁰ pm on Hill rd. 3/4 of 8 mile in Livonia.

at this time Paul is living alone at 3216 Bermuda st. in Ferndale. This is where Paul says Timmy was held. Paul seemed to enjoy talking about Timmy. He said Timmy liked to read, cried alot and played with the cat. (it's worth noting that there was alot of cat hair found on Timmy's clothes) Paul says he nick-named Timmy "Teddy Bear" and when he would call him that, Timmy would get mad and say "My name is Tim and My dad will kill you for this"

Paul states he would stop at the Hunter Maple Pharmacy and purchase things for class at Lawrence Institute of Technology from the stationary store. Paul says he went to school in Birmingham, worked there and played in the same park Timmy did.

Paul denies sexually molesting Timmy. He said he just kissed, hugged and fondled him. (It's worth noting, that in a letter mailed

to the Oakland County jail in 1982 addressed to an inmate that wasn't and never had been in the jail, Paul admitted to sexually molesting Timmy. He also wrote, "My Mother is turning on me, They try me in 83, I win".

During an interview with Paul (conducted by Taylor at Clinton Valley in 1992) I ask Paul if he would draw me a sketch of the area out the rear door of the Hunter Maple Pharmacy where Timmy was taken from. He said, "I did that for you in 1980." I said, "yes I know, but would you do it again?" He drew it again and put in twelve large cement columns that held the roof over the immediate parking area. The drawing was quite accurate, except there were actually fourteen columns, not twelve.

During this interview Paul said he held a pillow over Timmy's head. He said that didn't kill him, but he had a dead kid on his hands. I asked why he dumped Timmy's body in Wayne Co. knowing this would bring more police into the investigation?

Paul said he was going to show Timmy to his good friend Michael Mr. Goven, who lives on Averhill, Farmington, just off eight mile.

He states he drove down Averhill and changed his mind at the last minute. It asked if he had Timmy in The Trunk and he said "no, he was in the car with me". Paul said he then drove to a gravel rd. and dumped Timmy out. Paul said he had given Timmy one of his anti-depressants (Tofrani) and Timmy didn't like it.

It ask Paul if he had ever called Timmy Kings Dad. He said, yes, that he got the number from the phone book.

Mr. King states he received four calls he feels was from the same man. The person mentioned Timmy in the calls, but didn't make much sense. It sounded like a w/m with a soft, low voice, seemed spaced out on something other than alcohol.

13. During an interview in 1992 (Taylor w/Johnson) I asked Paul if he had killed Jane Allen.

He said "no". I pressed him and ask, "are you sure you didn't take her to Ohio?"

He said "no, I didn't". I ask him if he was responsible for Cynthia Cadieux.

He said "no". (He was irritated.)

He held up one hand, using his fingers, he held one (1) finger out and said,

"I'm responsible for Kristine Mihelich"

He raised a second finger and said,

"Mark Stebbins" He raised a third finger and

said "Timmy King" He raised a fourth finger and said "The other one".

I ask, what other one? He was clearly angry and upset. He again held out

four fingers and said "the other one".

I asked Jill Robinson? and he said "Yeah".

I ask Paul if he had ever told his mother that he had killed these kids.

He said he tried, but she would get mad and say she didn't want to hear

it, and then he would be committed again.

I ask if he had ever told his dad. He said he tried once, but he didn't want to

listen.

During my contacts with Mr. and Mrs. Johnson I felt they both suspected Paul had killed the kids. Mr. Johnson stated from the start, "Prove it if you can." That was indicative of his attitude, most of the time. Mrs. Johnson was very defensive of Paul. On one occasion, she threatened to sue me (Taylor) if I didn't cease my investigation. She was the matriarch of the family.

She made it clear that she didn't like Roger. (Rajesh Kothawala) saying she had told Roger to stay away from Paul.

These few hand-written pages are in no way offered as a complete inventory of the relevant information on this case. It is presented only as a brief outline and supported by many pages of reports.

During my 25 years on the Sheriff Department, I had 17 years in investigations. I have never felt more certain of any case, than I am of this one.

Paul Johnson said he killed those kids, and he did.

said he tried, but she would get mad and say she didn't want to hear, and that he would be committed again. I asked him if he had told his dad, and he said he tried once, but his dad didn't listen.

I asked him if he had a Pontiac back when all this was happening. He said he had a '67 light blue Tempest. He stated it had a 289 engine and that he had an accident with it in '74 or '75 in Flint and the car had left rear damage. He said the car fell apart, so he scrapped it out somewhere on Dixie Highway. He said he bought the car from DR. PRAHKABARAN (he spelled the name). PAUL said he felt better after talking about the child killings.

He asked if I would come back and bring him a Pepsi next time.

NOTE: During these conversations PAUL would fade-out and often start talking about unrelated matters; example, "Trucks with his name on them 'JOHNSON.'" He didn't like that.

PAUL also stated that he had taken baths with the kids.

He said he was molested when he was very young by a guy name MOSEN RATMI (he spelled it).

During the conversation, at one time, he said CAROL GORDON lived with him for three (3) weeks at the Monroe Street address.

I asked during the conversation if he had ever called TIMMY KING'S dad. He said, "yes, that he got the number from the phone book." CONCLUSION

PAUL told MIKE MCGOVERN he liked to do things at night when it snowed because the snow would cover his tracks and sound didn't travel as well when it was snowing. MR. MCGOVERN states PAUL liked to frequent the Caseville area. PAUL also liked to roust parkers on Old Orchard Trail in Bingham Farms (this is less than 1 mile from where Christine's body was found). MCGOVERN states PAUL would frequently purchase drugs at Thirteen Mile and Woodward at Royal Oak Memorial Park.

I asked MCGOVERN who PAUL'S best friends were in school. He listed the following:

MIKE MCGOVERN

JOE CALAGHAN

TIM HERSLEY

BRUCE WOOD

MR. MCGOVERN states PAUL didn't seem to like girls. The only girl he ever knew PAUL ask out was a girl named JILL. He asked JILL out to a dance, he believes the prom. JILL turned him down. MIKE had told PAUL not to ask JILL, as JILL was a step-above him and would probably turn him down. MIKE states PAUL'S father was a heavy drinker; that sometimes MIKE and PAUL would

Paul said that Taylor was a cop out to get him for the Oakland County Child Killings in the mid 70's. Paul named Timmy King, Mark Stebbins and Christine Mihalitch.

I asked him if he knew these kids.

Paul said he did.

I asked him how he knew them.

He told me he was at Hunter-Maple Pharmacy when Timmy King was kidnapped and that he witnessed the kidnapping. He told me a man named "Brad" or "Mr. Walker" pushed Tim's head down and forced him into a car and drove off with him. I asked him if he knew Tim King. Paul said that he did. I asked Paul how did he know him. He told me he had tried to help him.

I asked Paul how he got identified as a suspect. He told me the pharmacist was out to get him and turned him in with a description of his car. Paul said he was in the area because he used to steal goods from Griswold Sporting Goods Store. Paul also said that he was the one who reported the kidnapping to authorities and was trying to help.

I asked Paul if Timmy King had ever been in his car. He said that it was concluded that all 4 kids had been in his car.

I asked him who else had been in his car. He said Mark Stebbins was in his car. He said he picked him up hitchhiking and was trying to help him.

03 I asked Paul what happened. He said Mark Stebbins ended up dead. But

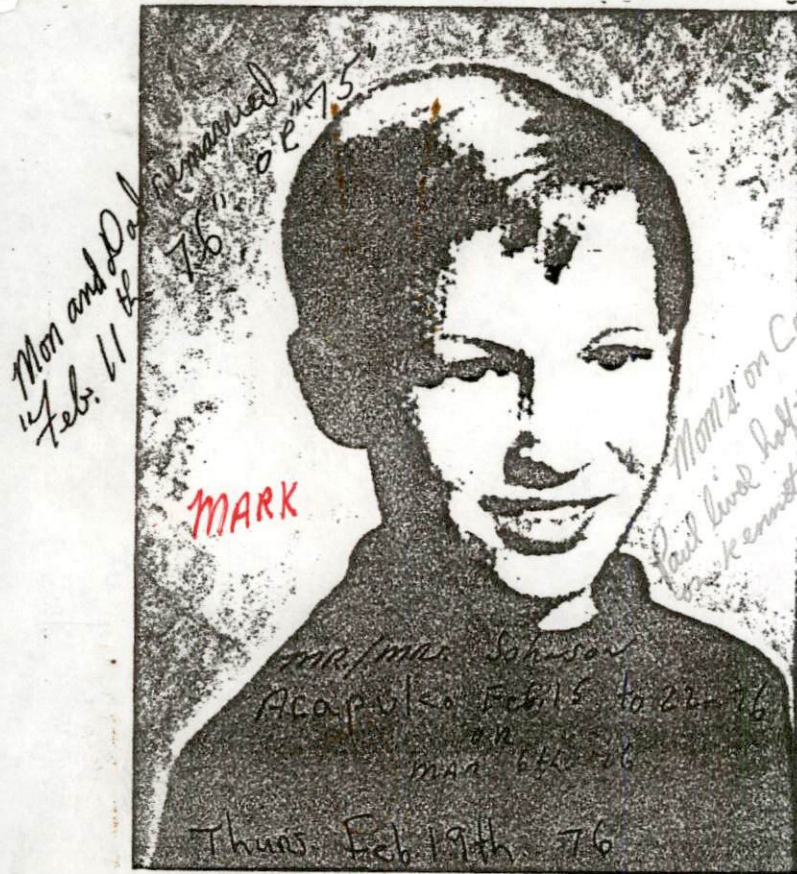

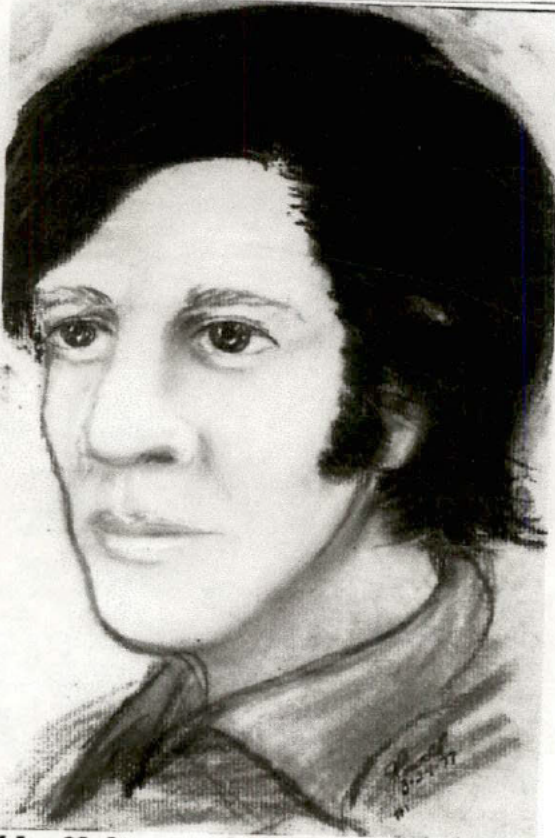

ON JANUARY 21, 1977, NEAR THE SCENE WHERE KRISTINE MIHELICH'S BODY WAS FOUND, OFFICERS FOUND MARKS IN THE SNOW BANKS WHERE A VEHICLE HAD RECENTLY TURNED AROUND. AFTER HUNDREDS OF HOURS OF RESEARCH, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT THE MARKS IN THE SNOW WERE MADE BY A 1964-1967 PONTIAC TEMPEST OR BUICK SKYLARK.

ON MARCH 16, 1977, AT THE SCENE OF TIMMY KING'S ABDUCTION, A BLUE WITH A WHITE HOCKEY STRIPE GREMLIN WAS SEEN.

What are the odds that the following is all coincidence?

1. The killing starts right after Paul Johnson's Mom and Dad are remarried. Feb. 11th. 76
2. Mark Stebbins' body would be found less than $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from where Paul's good friend and x-lover worked. This was not long after they broke up. (Roger)
3. That all the kids are killed during the winter. By all available information, family-friends and medical records, Paul can't function in the winter.
4. Jill Robinson is grabbed on Dec. 22.
Paul goes to school at Law. Tech.
Christmas break starts on Dec. 22.
Jill's dad teaches English at O.C.C.
Royal Oak. 73-74-75 Paul attends
O.C.C. Royal Oak 74-75-76?
5. Paul's friend (Mr. Govern) says Paul asks a girl by the ^{name} of Jill to the Prom. She turned him down and he was devastated.

6. That when Jill is shot on I-75, a truck driver sees the car pulled off on I-75 3 of 16 mi. This location was right in front of Paul's Mom and Dad's apt., which faces I-75.
7. Jill is shot in the head. In subsequent conversations with Taylor and Mr. Govern Paul refuses to say the name Jill Robinson. He gets very upset and refers to Jill as (the other one)
8. Kristine Michelich is last seen at a 7/11 store on 12 mile and Oakshire in Berkeley. In a letter from Clinton Valley, Paul is referred to Oakland County after-care services at 2351 12 mile, Berkeley. This is several blocks east of where K.M. was grabbed. The pharmacy serving this care center is about $\frac{1}{2}$ mi. west. Mrs. Johnson (Paul's mom) stated during an interview, that she sometimes got upset with Paul, because he would go to a 7/11 store and buy food instead of eating what she had purchased for him.

9. Kristine's body is found on Bruce Lane near 13 mile, Franklin Village.
One of four people listed as Paul's good friends in high school is Bruce Wood.
10. Per. Roger and McHovern, Paul liked to roost kids parking in this area.
11. When Watson and Taylor drove Paul down Bruce Lane, (it was at night and there was no street sign) Paul sit up in the back seat, his head bumped the windows, tears were in his eyes and ran down his cheeks. When asked what was wrong, he stated he was looking for Timmy's body. This happened right where Kristine's body had been found three years earlier.
This was the only time we ever saw Paul cry.
12. a copy of Paul's grades for Lawrence Tech. showed his worst marking period in over a year was Jan. 77 when Kristine was held.

13. Shortly after it comes out in the news that the tire tracks left at Kristine's drop site are being examined by experts, Paul gets his dad to pay for new tires for his car. Shortly after, Paul junks the car out. Paul's dad says he wasn't happy about Paul scrapping out the car. Paul's dad buys Paul a 73 Buick ^{DK Brown OR wht/DK. Brown} on Mar. 1st. 77.

14. according to Mr. Vernier (S.O.S.) ^{Sec. of State} Paul did not transfer the plates from the Tempest to the Buick. The plates still had 10 months on them.

15. Timmy King is taken Mar. 16 77 ^{8:30pm} (Wed) from the rear area of the Hunter Maple Pharmacy. Paul twice draws this area in detail upon request by Watson & Taylor. He states he would stop there after class to buy stationary.

16. Paul was scheduled for class on this Wednesday evening. One of Paul's Professors states Paul often wore a sport coat to school. Witness, Mrs. Hoffman

states the young man talking to Timmy was wearing a rust colored sport coat. Mike McHovern states Paul often wore a brown sport coat. McHovern said it was Paul's favorite and it had a strange odor to it.

17. Witness Mrs. Hoffman states the man talked in an even and soft manner. He sounded like a clean cut college student, educated. Paul is a soft spoken clean cut, educated college student.
18. Hoffman says the man has no visible jewelry. Paul doesn't wear or own any jewelry.
19. Mrs. Hoffman describes in great detail suspects hair (shag cut) and long sideburns. This along with her total description fits Paul perfectly.
20. The composite looks just like Paul.

21. Timmy's body is found March 22, 77 (Tues. 11pm)
on Hill rd. just $\frac{3}{4}$ of 8 mile.

This is about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles from Paul's good
friend's house, (Michael McHovern)

Paul said he was going to show McHovern
Timmy, and changed his mind at the last
minute. He said he drove Timmy down
a gravel road and dumped his body.

22. When asked if he had Timmy's body in
the trunk, Paul said, No, he was in the
car with me. The body was still warm
when discovered.

23. There was a lot of cat hair found on
Timmy's clothes.

Family and friends would say Paul
loved cats. A picture would show a
kitten on the couch at Bermuda st.
in Ferndale. This is where Paul lived
when Timmy was taken. Paul stated
Timmy mostly played with the cat, read,
and cried alot.

24. all the kids had been washed with PhisoHex soap. This is a surgical scrub, bacteriostatic skin cleanser. This soap is used primarily in hospitals and Doctors offices. Paul's mother worked for Dr. Barton at Beaumont Medical Building in Royal Oak.

25. It was believed that these children must have been sedated part of the time, as it would have been nearly impossible to watch them 24/7.

Paul was taking the following drugs.

- Narine - side effect - high incidence of sedation.
- Stelazine - side effect - high incidence of sedation.
- Serentil - side effect - low incidence of sedation.
- Tofranil - side effect - drowsiness

26. Both boys had been sodomized. There was no sperm found anywhere. a side effect of three of the drugs listed above, (25) is inhibited ejaculation.

1. Paul is the only man who has told police that he killed these kids. He said it in 1980 and again in 1992. He refuses to say the name "Jill Robinson" not only while talking to Police, but also with his friend Mike Mc Govern. He gets very upset when asked about her. Of the four children, Jill Robinson's death was the most violent. She was shot in the head with a shotgun.

2. Paul very much looks like the composite. witness discript. fits Paul perfectly.

3. Of the 13 suspect characteristics set forth by the task force April 4, 1977, all but 3 fit Paul.
7. Compulsion for Cleanliness 8. no Substance abuse 10. white collar worker

4. Paul was turned into the task force 3-26-77 as a look-alike for the composite by Matt Welch. Paul's friends Mc Govern and Calagan both said the composite looked like Paul.

5. The victims had been cleaned with a soap commonly used as a surgical scrub. (Phisohex)
Paul's mother is a nurse and works at Beaumont Medical building in Royal Oak.
Mrs. Johnson ^{said} she purchased a lot of Paul's food and necessities, but denied giving him soap.
6. In Sept. 1978 the task force put out a memo stating they believe that the suspect had available to him a blue Pontiac Tempest during the period Feb. 76 to Jan. 77. Experts from G.M. ~~so~~ states 64 to 67 Pontiac Tempest or Buick. Paul has a 64 blue Pontiac Tempest. (damage 6/R) Paul says from acc. in Flint. Dad was not happy when Paul junked the Tempest. Dad had recently paid for new tires, and new pinion gear.
7. Paul, by everyone's account goes nuts in the winter. Medical records support this. Mc Govern says Paul told him, he (Paul) likes to commit crimes in the winter, the snow covers his tracks and deadens to sound.

8. Paul's Mom and Dad are re-married
 Feb. 11th. 1976. Mr. Johnson first states

Mom says Paul was at her apt. on Coachman on X-MAS day. She produced a number of pictures to prove it. (Paul had on three different outfits X-MAS day)

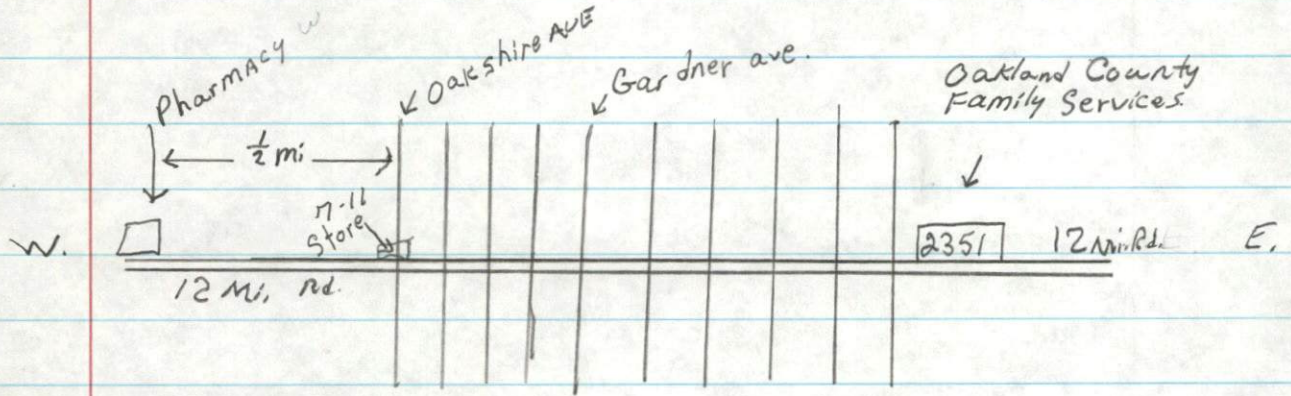

In a letter dated April 30, 1976 from Clinton Valley Center Paul is sent to after-care services at 2351 12 mi. rd., Berkley. This is several blocks east of where K.M. was grabbed. The Pharmacy serving this County Care Center was about 1/2 mile west on 12 mile. It should be noted that during an interview with Mrs. Johnson, she stated she would get upset with Paul, as she would provide him with food and he would often go to a 7-11 store and purchase food rather than open a can of food.

on Bruce Lane, near 13 mile, Franklin Village. (No school, ^{Jan. 21} between terms) It is worth noting that upon checking Paul's grades for 1 1/2 years at Lawrence Tech, he had all A's Except during the time that K.M. was held, he had 1-A 2-B's.

When Watson and Taylor took Paul for a ride down Bruce Lane (it was at night, there was no street sign and we said nothing about where we were going) Paul sat up in the seat as we approached the location where K.M.'s body was found. His head bumped against the side window, He had tears in his eyes and running down his cheeks. When ask what was wrong, He said "I'm looking for Timmy's body" This was the only time I (Taylor) ever saw him cry. After many hours of research experts concluded the tire tracks and bumper impressions left in the snow by the suspect vehicle were made by a 1964 to 67 Pontiac Tempest or Buick skylark.

Per. Mr. Johnson - It's around this time Paul gets him to pay for four new tires for his (Paul's) 64 Pontiac Tempest and shortly after Paul junks the Tempest. Mr. Johnson wasn't happy.

Per. Mr. Vernier at Michigan S.O.S. when Paul got rid of the 64 Tempest he didn't transfer the lic. plates to the 73 Buick even though there was still 10 months left on them.

Paul rarely showed emotion. The only time I saw him laugh was once when he was talking about K.M. He said he had people at his apt. on Monroe. K.M. was tied up in the bedroom and no one knew it. He laughed about it. He said K.M. got burned when he had her tied to the heat radiator and he might have burned her once with a Cig. but he didn't mean to.

According to McGovern and Roger, Paul knew the area quite well where K.M. was found as he liked to roost kids parking on old Orchard trail.

Per. McGovern Paul's best friends in school were 1. Himself 2. Joe Calaghan 3. Tim Hearsley 4. Bruce Wood

Paul states he stayed with K.M. for 2 or 3 weeks and admitted killing her. Paul says he and Jimmy Carter were on the news alot. Paul stated "They'll kill me in prison for this".

12. Timmy King is last seen Mar. 16, 77 (Wed.) 8:30 pm in the parking lot at the Hunter Maple Pharmacy in Birmingham.

His body is found Mar. 22, 77 (Tues) 11¹⁰ pm on Hill rd. 3/4 of 8 mile in Livonia.

at this time Paul is living alone at 3216 Bermuda st. in Ferndale. This is where Paul says Timmy was held. Paul seemed to enjoy talking about Timmy. He said Timmy liked to read, cried alot and played with the cat. (it's worth noting that there was alot of cat hair found on Timmy's clothes) Paul says he nick-named Timmy "Teddy Bear" and when he would call him that, Timmy would get mad and say "My name is Tim and My dad will kill you for this"

Paul states he would stop at the Hunter Maple Pharmacy and purchase things for class at Lawrence Institute of Technology from the stationary store. Paul says he went to school in Birmingham, worked there and played in the same park Timmy did.

Paul denies sexually molesting Timmy. He said he just kissed, hugged and fondled him. (It's worth noting, that in a letter mailed

to the Oakland County jail in 1982 addressed to an inmate that wasn't and never had been in the jail, Paul admitted to sexually molesting Timmy. He also wrote, "My Mother is turning on me, They try me in 83, I win".

During an interview with Paul (conducted by Taylor at Clinton Valley in 1992) I ask Paul if he would draw me a sketch of the area out the rear door of the Hunter Maple Pharmacy where Timmy was taken from. He said, "I did that for you in 1980." I said, "yes I know, but would you do it again?" He drew it again and put in twelve large cement columns that held the roof over the immediate parking area. The drawing was quite accurate, except there were actually fourteen columns, not twelve.

During this interview Paul said he held a pillow over Timmy's head. He said that didn't kill him, but he had a dead kid on his hands. I asked why he dumped Timmy's body in Wayne Co. knowing this would bring more police into the investigation?

Paul said he was going to show Timmy to his good friend Michael Mr Goven, who lives on Averhill, Farmington, just off eight mile.

Witness statement?
Car wasn't a blue granini?

He states he drove down Avechill and changed his mind at the last minute. It asked if he had Timmy in the trunk and he said "no, he was in the car with me". Paul said he then drove to a gravel rd. and dumped Timmy out. Paul said he had given Timmy one of his anti-depressants (Tofrani) and Timmy didn't like it.

It ask Paul if he had ever called Timmy Kings Dad. He said, yes, that he got the number from the phone book.

Mr. King states he received four calls he feels was from the same man. The person mentioned Timmy in the calls, but didn't make much sence. It sounded like a w/m with a soft, low voice, seemed spaced out on something other than alcohol.

13. During an interview in 1992 (Taylor w/Johnson) I asked Paul if he had killed Jane Allen.

He said "no". I pressed him and ask, "are you sure you didn't take her to Ohio?"

He said "no, I didn't". I ask him if he was responsible for Cynthia Cadieux.

He said "no". (He was irritated.)

He held up one hand, using his fingers, he held one (1) finger out and said,

"I'm responsible for Kristine Mihelich"

He raised a second finger and said,

"Mark Stebbins" He raised a third finger and

said "Timmy King" He raised a fourth

finger and said "The other one". I

ask, what other one? He was clearly

angry and upset. He again held out

four fingers and said "the other one".

I asked Jill Robinson? and he said "Yeah".

I ask Paul if he had ever told his mother that he had killed these kids.

He said he tried, but she would get

mad and say she didn't want to hear

it, and then he would be committed again.

I ask if he had ever told his dad. He

said he tried once, but he didn't want to

listen.

During my contacts with Mr. and Mrs. Johnson I felt they both suspected Paul had killed the kids. Mr. Johnson stated from the start, "Prove it if you can." That was indicative of his attitude, most of the time.

Mrs. Johnson was very defensive of Paul. On one occasion, she threatened to sue me (Taylor) if I didn't cease my investigation. She was the matriarch of the family.

She made it clear that she didn't like Roger. (Rajesh Kothawala) saying she had told Roger to stay away from Paul.

These few hand-written pages are in no way offered as a complete inventory of the relevant information on this case. It is presented only as a brief outline and supported by many pages of reports.

During my 25 years on the Sheriff Department, I had 17 years in investigations. I have never felt more certain of any case, than I am of this one.

Paul Johnson said he killed those kids, and he did.

22 pharmacist was out to get him and turned him in with a description of his
23 car. Paul said he was in the area because he used to steal goods from
24 Griswold Sporting Goods Store. Paul also said that he was the one who

03 I asked Paul what happened. He said Mark Stebbins ended up dead. But
 04 that he didn't want that to happen. He said he didn't do it. He said that



ON DECEMBER 26, 1976, AT ABOUT 3:30 A. M., A WITNESS SAW A LIGHT BLUE 1967 PONTIAC TEMPEST WITH PRIMER SPOTS ON THE LEFT SIDE ON THE SHOULDER OF N.B. 1-75, NEAR THE SCENE WHERE JILL ROBINSON'S BODY WAS FOUND.

ON JANUARY 21, 1977, NEAR THE SCENE WHERE KRISTINE MIHELICH'S BODY WAS FOUND, OFFICERS FOUND MARKS IN THE SNOW BANKS WHERE A VEHICLE HAD RECENTLY TURNED AROUND. AFTER HUNDREDS OF HOURS OF RESEARCH, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT THE MARKS IN THE SNOW WERE MADE BY A 1964-1967 PONTIAC TEMPEST OR BUICK SKYLARK.

ON MARCH 16, 1977, AT THE SCENE OF TIMMY KING'S ABDUCTION, A BLUE WITH A WHITE HOCKEY STRIPE GREMLIN WAS SEEN.

IT IS REASONABLE TO BELIEVE THAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR A PERSON THAT HAS INTERMEDIATE SIZE CARS AVAILABLE TO HIM AND PROBABLY A BLUE PONTIAC TEMPEST DURING THE PERIOD OF FEBRUARY, 1976, TO JANUARY, 1977; BUT IN MARCH OF 1977, HE HAD A BLUE GREMLIN AVAILABLE TO HIM.

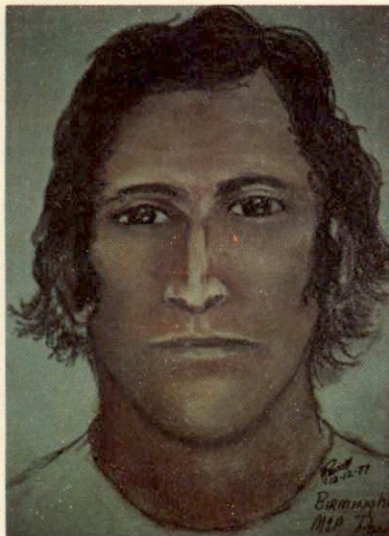
