Denial of Records:

Denial is based on the following provision(s) of the Freedom of Information Act, MCL 15.243, Sec. 13(1). Exemptions that apply are displayed below.

(a) Information of a personal nature where the public disclosure of the information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of an individual's privacy:

- address(es)
- date(s) of birth
- driver license number(s)
- other
- physical characteristics
- telephone number(s)
- name(s)
- Personal Details

(b) Investigating records compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that disclosure would do any of the following:

- Disclose law enforcement investigative techniques or procedures.
- Constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

(d) Records or information specifically described and exempted from disclosure by statute:

- MCL 28.214 C.J.I.S. Policy Council Act (LEIN information)
- MCL 338.1728 Forensic Polygraph Examiners Act 295 of 1972

(w) Information or records that would disclose the social security number of any individual.
