15. Any statements given by any relative, neighbor, acquaintance, or employer of Christopher Busch during the time period 1976 to 1978.
16. Any information concerning the participation of Christopher Busch in the Fox Island pedophile incident.
17. The transcript of the recording and the recording itself of the interview conducted by the FBI of Charles and Nancy Busch in 2008.
18. Notes and transcripts of any interviews of any other relatives of Christopher Busch.
19. Any information indicating that Christopher Busch's suicide may have been a homicide.
20. Any reports, notes, or transcripts of any interviews of the retired Flint detective who was involved in the Genesee County case, including those taken in 2009 or 2010.
21. Any information involving Jane Burgess, the attorney for Christopher Busch, in his CSC criminal cases (see Paragraphs 3, 4, and 5 above).
22. Any notes concerning a telephone conversation between Detective Sergeant Garry Gray and Patrick Coffey in November or December, 2009.
23. The medical examiner's report, autopsy findings, and any crime lab report concerning evidence collected from the body of Timothy King.
24. The three notebooks shown to Erica McAvoy when her mother and she visited the Michigan State Police Post on or about October 19, 2009.
25. The names of the persons who participated in the decision to terminate the original Task Force on December 15, 1978.
26. The transcript of the testimony given by Patrick Coffey in November 2007 regarding the initial investigation of Lawrence Wasser.
27. Any notes or other information concerning Lawrence Wasser, including, but not limited to, a meeting on approximately November 30, 2007 between law enforcement representatives and Lawrence Wasser.
28. All notes or other documents related to the individual or individuals examined in Georgia or Alabama in 2009.
