### TELEPHONIC INTERVIEW WITH

On Monday, August 3, 2009, at approximately 1 PM, the undersigned received a call from the below listed subject, [redacted] advised that he was contacted by D/Sgt. Scott Rios of the Newaygo post regarding his availability for yet another interview by task force investigators, and the Oakland County Child Killer Investigation. [redacted] advised that both he and his brother would be available to be interviewed, however they would only need a days notice. [redacted] stated that both he and his brother, [redacted] are on disability and pretty much are available any time.

[redacted] it stated that the last time "He", was interviewed by Detectives Gray and Williams, his brother [redacted] waited for him in a car in the Newaygo post parking lot. [redacted] stated [redacted] should have been interviewed also because of what he had just recently learned. [redacted] stated that [redacted] told him that [redacted] Chris, (Christopher Busch), made statements to him when he was about ten years old about the case we are investigating. [redacted] stated that [redacted] told him that while he was with [redacted] Chris back in the 70's, they were in the Detroit area driving around when [redacted] Chris pointed to a spot along the roadway and said, "One of the kids got picked up right there". (Referring to one of the victims of the child killing investigation). [redacted] told the undersigned, when he heard this, he asked his brother how he could remember something like that from that long ago, he said his brothers answer was: "You don't forget sh-t like that". [redacted] stated that this comment from [redacted] Chris had bothered him for a very long time and that he even told his mother about what Chris said to him back when it happened. Mom told him, "Chris wouldn't do something like that."

[redacted] stated he would very much like to meet with the investigator's because this has been bothering him for a very long time.

[redacted] was asked again what [redacted] told him about [redacted] Chris, and what Chris said about pointing to a location, [redacted] said, [redacted] said that he was with [redacted] Chris and they were driving somewhere in the Detroit area, when Chris pointed to spot near the roadway, and said, "This is where one of the kids was picked up". [redacted] advised that [redacted] then said, "How would he, [redacted] know that, unless he was the one who took the kid?"

[redacted] stated again that he and his brother will cooperated with what ever is requested and will meet with the officers when available.

### OFFICERS ACTIONS:

Attempts are being made to re-schedule and interview date with [redacted] at the Newaygo post within the next couple of days.
