In the records from Father Buds Boys Camp it showed that MR. had made a monthly donation from March thru September 1976. These were always at the first month and in the amounts of \$10.00 other than May which was \$12.00. Also there was a notation of "principle".


On MR. there was no record of any donation for 1976 and just his name and address.

## CONTACT

Checks were made and it was learned that : is the principle of the Elementary School for . Subject was contacted at his office at the School. He advised that from what he recalls he first heard about the Boys Camp thru the mail and that it needed funds to keep going. This would have been about a year ago. States he has worked with kids for 30 yrs and the last 17 as principle of the school. He at first stated that he did receive some pictures in the mail of young boys in positions indicative of relations which he threw away. He gave no reason why he did not report or turn the pictures in. He related that after he got the pictures he debated if he should send further money but then did so once in a while but not on a monthly basis. He was not told of the fact that the record revealed a monthly donation. Later in the interview he stated that he got pictures 4 or 5 times but threw them away each time. He stopped sending money to the Camp when he noticed a piece in the newspaper of the goings on at the Camp. Since then he has had no correspondence what so ever from anyone or from any place. He further advised that he has never been to the camp. He advised that he could offer nothing further other than he thought the Camp was a legitimate place at first. Further he agreed to contact the undersigned if he gets any further information from any place in the Country.

## INTERVIEW

was contacted at his residence. He advised that his first contact with the "farm" came about while he was receiving mail at his home for a friend. He stated that had gone to Alaska and was using home as a mailing address.

Requests for donations and a bulletin would come from the farm and advised that he returned an inquiry to them about their function. He then became interested in the farm and made several donations himself. He advised that he never visited the farm nor had he ever received any material from them other than the bulletin.

Additional information learned during the interview with was that he was employed by the Wayne County Dept. of Social Services and that he was presently a foster parent to a male child. He is single and lives alone. He expressed shock and dismay at the homosexual implication of the farm. It should also be noted that is listed as one of the farm sponsors.

## INTERVIEW

was contacted at his residence. He advised that his first contact with the "farm" came about through a former associate who is now deceased. He stated that he had been expressing his dissatisfaction with various charitable organizations when he was told of the farm. He then wrote to them and received bulletins and began making small contributions.

He advised that he has never received any obscene material from the farm but that he did visit the farm last year. He stated that he was enroute to Florida with friends and they stayed near the farm. While his companions were visiting other people he went to the farm. He advised that he didn't see any illegal activity while at the farm and everything appeared normal.

## INTERVIEW

was contacted at Walled Lake where he is an officer of the company. He advised that his first contact with the "farm" came about when he received an unrequested bulletin through the mail. He stated that he makes many charitable contributions so he sent them some donations.

He advised that he has never received any material from the farm other than bulletins but that he did visit the farm around February of 1976. He stated that he didn't see any signs of homosexual activity at that time but that he did see some of the youths "smoking pot". He said that this made him uncomfortable about the organization so he quit making donations. He was then asked about the list of recorded



## INTERVIEW WITH GERALD RICHARDS:

GERALD RICHARDS (prison # 146598) was interviewed at Jackson Prison on 12 Jan 77. Subj  
believes that SHELDEN is at his family MANSION on ANTIGUA ISLAND. Supposed to have  
servants there & every conceivable luxury associated with wealth.

RICHARDS told officer about the way the Porno Business operates. It ends & starts  
at the porno shops where items are sold. The sponsor advertisements in each preference  
of sexual taste (In this case, PEDOPHILIC & PEDERASTY). The ads support & propagate  
business for Magazines of which the BOY LOVER'S MOVEMENT is an advocate. After the  
magazine a re-mailing business known as MAIL-O-MATIC Operations based in ROCKY MOUNT,  
North Carolina, receives & remails photos (after probably taking a copy for resale  
to a magazines publisher) to subscribing individuals who wish to meet others & exchange  
pictures & etc. MAIL-O-MATIC is operated by a MR. SMITH.

CHURCH OF THE NEW REVELATION: Richard's said he first heard of this Church thru lt's  
advertising in HARD CORE PORN such as "BETTER LIFE MONTHLY" (Boys Pedophilia magazine)  
He learned that they set up Boy's Homes, Camps gave legal assistance, acted as Incorporator's of Boy's Camps, etc. A person known as is one of the  
director's. After he wrote this Church, DYER GROSSMAN came to Port Huron to set up  
the Brother Paul's Mission Camp for him. GROSSMAN did not receive anything for this  
action, however it would appear that the Incorporator would later have legal claim on  
a successful lucrative boy's camp that was bringing in profit.

Beyond the stage of Mail-o-Matic, you get to the larger operator's who sell 8 MM MOTION  
PICTURES of Pedophilia (& other sex). This is put out by a Company known as F & S that  
uses a PO box in San Francisco, Calif. (could be a forwarding service)

INDIVIDUALS WHO CONTRIBUTE TO INDUSTRY according to Richards is SHELDEN who writes &  
has some say in Publishing. EDMONDS, Washington. (Who Richards originally  
got photos from that were sent to Tennessee) who is involved with PHOTOS/SWAPPING.  
a DONALD SANDBERG, Phoenix, Arizona who also is a Photo swapper & has connection with the  
boy's farm in Tennessee & a similar BOY'S RANCH in TEXAS, and a CHILDREN'S NUDIST CAMP  
IN VERMONT.

Ricahards went on to state that many boys in the Boy's Farm's Brochures he has seen also appeared as models in Pornographic Magazines in Adult Book Stores.

BETTER LIFE MONTHLY - - - - - is published by a subi (alias) known as - - - - - at - - - - - Richards believes this magazine is printed in MILLIKIN or BOULDER, COLORADO.

## CHECKS FOR SHELDEN:

Sgt. MOYES of Comm. Serv. Div. received info from BOY's REPUBLIC that SHELDEN recently sent in a resignation. Envelope was from BURL BLDG in Detroit & Postmarked Detroit.

Officer called the BURL BLDG office & talked to SHELDEN's secretary. She advised she has no knowledge where he may be & for any further info to call the Family Attorney.

## INFO FROM SP11:

D/Sgt. Welton contacted a - - - - - and also a - - - - - of young males involved in sodomy & also a copy of cancelled checks indicating contributions to the Tennessee BOY's FARM. The photos are in an envelope postmarked in Chattanooga, Tenn.

UD-14s are being submitted on the above 2 items. (Item #3 -photos & #4- Checks).

## FIRERAL TO COMMUNITY SERVICES DIV.:

Officer talked to S. t. MOYES by tx and it was agreed to do the following.

#1- Items #3 & #4 listed above are being referred to Sgt. MOYES for referral to Investigator J.T. BOLDEN in Tennessee for possible use by him in investigation of Boy's Farm. UD-14s also being submitted with instructions for BOLDEN's signature.

#2- Gerald Richards advised that besides the Boy's Ranch in Texas & Vermont, there were 2 that he heard of in California. Both are supposed to be INCORPORATED & possibly have IRS clearance, they are RENE-GUYON SOCIETY and CHILD SEXUALITY CIRCLE INC. He believes both these places would be similar to the Tennessee Boy's farm.

#3- For attention of Tennessee investigator, officer also suggests that supp reports submitted from SP20, SP11 & SP51 reporting interviews with Persons whos names appear at the Tennessee Boy's Farm be referred to J. T. BOLDEN. These reports all are dated after 12-28-76.
