Molesting case suspect arrested

Sheriff's deputies arrested a Tucson man yesterday after a two-week investigation into alleged child molesting.

Carl E. Schonebeck, 32, of 8650 S. Nogales Highway, is in Pima County Jail on suspicion of sexual assault, child molesting and kidnapping. He was arrested after going to the Sheriff's Department to talk about a complaint filed against him by three teen-aged boys, deputies said.

Deputy Donald J. Chavez, who worked the case along with sex crimes detectives, first questioned Schonebeck more than a week ago. When Schonebeck went to deputies yesterday, he brought a friend to corroborate his side of the case but deputies arrested him.

Schonebeck was arrested in connection with one reported assault, which allegedly occurred in his parked car in a desert area. But deputies said two other

complaints are pending.

The three boys apparently have worked on odd jobs with Schonebeck the past month, and all three said they were alone with him when the alleged molestings occurred.

Body found in desert

Authorities were trying to identify a man whose body was found today under desert brush off Interstate 10 near Orange Grove Road.

Sheriff's deputies said the man, who appeared to be middle-aged, may have died of exposure to the heat. There were no wounds on the body or other indications of foul play.

There was no identification on the body, which was found at about 9 a.m. by a hitchhiker.
